A white male, about 26 years of age, 5'10" to 6' tall, with dark brown hair and a dark complexion, wearing a brown suit and horn-rimmed glasses landed this aircraft at Blythe, California, later that same night and bought gas for cash. He said he was en route to Dallas, Texas, but filed no flight plan. He appeared to be an experienced pilot.

Insurance investigators, accompanied by a detective from the Rialto, California, Police Department on the weekend of 4/20/68 - 4/21/68 flew to Hermosillo, Mexico, and there consulted the judical police. With their assistance, this plane was found to have been burned and was recovered at about 60 miles west of Caborca, Sonora, Mexico, on a dry lake owned by one RALPH BLAND. Tracks showed the aircraft had been taxied to a field which was surrounded by shrubbery and was then burned. The plane had been repainted from its former blue and white to red and white and the FAA number on the fuselage changed to N2214X.
