FREDERICK JOHN SCHWARTZ

The files of the Passport Office, Department of State, reviewed by a Special Agent of the FBI on June 13, 1968, disclosed that Frederick John Schwartz was last issued Passport M-1216768 at Los Angeles, California, on October 23, 1967, for proposed business travel of unstated duration to Britain, France, Italy, Germany, Austria, Switzerland, Holland, Denmark, and Spain. In his application dated October 23, 1967, at Los Angeles, he stated his intention to depart from Los Angeles by unnamed airline about October, 1967, not by organized tour. He stated that he expected to take another trip abroad within the year. According to a notice published in the Federal Register on March 16, 1967, this passport was valid for three years' travel to all countries except Cuba, North Korea, Mainland China, and North Vietnam.

This individual stated that he was born on [redacted] at Detroit, Michigan. The file shows that he was previously issued Passport C-213253 on May 21, 1962, but the previous portion of his file was not available for review at this time. He gave his permanent residence as 2754 Woodshire Drive, Los Angeles, California, and arranged to pickup his passport in Los Angeles. He listed his father as Frederick Irwin Schwartz, born in Colorado in [redacted] and his mother as Dorothy Kiefer, born in Detroit, Michigan, [redacted].

He stated he was last married on February 1, 1963, to Hennajean Marie Shibel Schwartz, who was born in Los Angeles, California, on [redacted] marriage not terminated. In the event of accident, he requested that Mrs. Dorothy Graves, his mother be notified at 10330 Monte Mar Drive, Los Angeles. He left a telephone contact number of 204-9171.

"Marshals or FBI personel. They anticipate a large protective force but will not be stopped and expect to lose several in the attempt but there will be martyrs. They have anticipated his surprise return and have placed watchers at every conceivable airport including Air Force landing areas.

"Because of possible reprisals I must abstain from signing this note to you. I am deeply concerned and hope that no one is hurt."

Enclosed for Legal, London are two copies of extracts from Missouri City report of May 15, 1968, concerning records obtained from the Missouri State Penitentiary in specific reference to subject Ray's incarceration. Included in this document will be a physical report, background, and an examination by the psychiatrist.

These records were furnished to the Bureau by officials of Missouri State Penitentiary with the understanding that they will be a matter of strict confidence. If a copy of these records is furnished to the Honorable W. J. Bennett, Director of Prison Security, it should be with specific understanding that these records are furnished for his use and should not be disclosed to outside sources.

It is to be noted that subject, since his escape from Missouri State Penitentiary on April 22, 1967, was a housepainting contractor from a company in Little Falls, New Jersey. He was sent eight letters and the degree of his proficiency or his progress are not known. It is, therefore, not possible to evaluate his house-painting ability.

It has been reported by several individuals, particularly prison associates of Ray, that he was a user of amphetamine type drugs. The method of obtaining a kick with amphetamine type drugs, method of

recovering such drugs after the cloth has dried, and how Ray's clothes could be cleaned to insure any drugs in cloth are removed. This is not positively known. The possibility exist that amphetamine drugs can be placed in a solution of alcohol or ether, the cloth completely saturated with solution, and this would result in quick drying, and the drugs then adhere to cloth. This could then possibly be recovered by the cloth being placed in another solution of possibly alcohol. It appears there is no positive means of insuring that the clothes could be cleaned to remove the amphetamine drugs due to the variance in chemicals used and different methods. If a problem presents its concerning Ray having drugs in his clothing, the possibility exist that he could be issued a new suit of clothing. This way, it would insure that he would not carry drugs outside of England.

He was advised that he should make his own arrangements directly with Mr. CLARK and that the Bureau could not assist him in this matter.

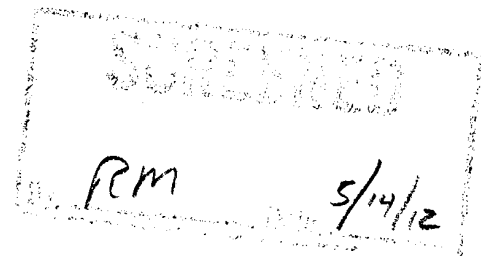

This is justified and if approved Minnich will be advised. They will return in ample time to perform any duties required depending upon developments in London. Recommendations concerning security measures re transportation of subject, in the event this duty delegated to FBI, will be discussed with Agents upon their return. Contingencies will be thoroughly explored and recommendations submitted dependent upon responsibilities delegated to the FBI.
