The complete manifest for the flight taken by the subject from Toronto to London has been obtained. Efforts are being made to obtain from Lisbon the manifest for the flight from Lisbon to London and Scotland Yard has access to the microfilm manifest of subject's flight from London to Lisbon. The three manifests will be cross-checked in a search for common passengers.

Written apparently by RAY on a South Africa Air Line schedule found in his luggage are the words "Cinco tres cinco zero quatra una," This is Portuguese for the number 535041, Legat, Paris, has instituted inquiries to determine if this is a Lisbon telephone number and, if so, to identify the subscriber and determine if the subscriber has any connection with the subject.

Scotland Yard is interviewing flight crews on the flights taken by RAY from Toronto to London and from London to Lisbon. This has been substantially completed with negative results, and will be concluded as soon as personnel on overseas runs are available for interview. Legat, Paris, has previously arranged for interview of the flight crew on RAY's flight from Lisbon to London.

Scotland Yard's investigation to date has not developed any indication of RAY's having had any associate or significant contact in London.

Exhaustive checks have been made of immigration and airline records. No record has been found to indicate RAY left England between 5/17/68 and 6/8/68.

The statement in the first paragraph of this airtel regarding reports received on an unofficial and confidential basis refers only to items numbered 1, 5, 7 and 8.

things to be done here and at point of destination. This would be an all-encompassing list with the time each item is to be done, when done and the individual doing it.

- (5) The restraining kit has arrived and is in Legat Office and if ZEISS and BOUNDS depart London June 19 next, they will leave two guns with Legat and bring two guns with them on return.
- (6) It would appear that one of the most important decisions to be made would pertain to the attitude to be displayed to RAY by the escorting agents. In other words, should he be appropriately warned of all his rights and thereafter an attempt made to interview him? In answering this question it should be borne in mind that he will be under restraint, which will probably consist of handcuffs, leg irons and lead chains. If after appropriately warned of his rights he shows an inclination to engage in petty conversation of any type, should the escorting agents engage him in such conversation or should absolute silence be maintained by escorting agents with regard to RAY during the entire trip? If he is to be warned of his rights, etc., appropriate forms should be given to ZEISS and BOUNDS upon their return trip.
- (7) Whether military or commercial craft is used, it is suggested that the door to the toilet facilities be removed and that all mirrors or glassware and sharp appurtenances be removed.
- (8) Four flashlights with new batteries and bulbs should be furnished for emergency lighting use within the aircraft in the event the lighting equipment fails.
- (9) Suggest consideration be given for arrangements to be made at final destination for RAY to be stripped, photographed and medically examined as proof that he was delivered to local authorities in good condition.
- (10) It is contemplated that all property in his possession at the time of his apprehension will be turned over to this office by New Scotland Yard. It is contemplated this property will be taken aboard the aircraft and instead of being left at Memphis, escorting agents will take the property to Washington, D.C. for any further laboratory examinations desired.



Enclosed are two copies of photograph of laundry mark in the neckband of subject's shirt, and two copies of photograph of a different laundry mark appearing on a pair of shorts.

Scotland Yard is continuing intensive investigation to account for the subject's whereabouts in London between May 17 and 28, 1968. It is noted that at the time of his arrest his only identification papers were in the name of RAMON GEORGE SNEYD and his Canadian passport does not show any exit from England after his arrival 5/17/68. To have left England he would have needed a passport and the passport would have been stamped at the time of his departure, and again at the time of his return, as well as at the time of his arrival and departure from any other country he visited.

Chief Inspector KENNETH THOMPSON; Scotland Yard, has advised in confidence that he interviewed Major ALISTAIR WICKS. WICKS has been a leader in mercenary forces for a number of years and is considered to be an established liaison man and go-between for the hiring of mercenaries. WICKS stated that he had reason to believe RAY had contacted the Biafra Mission in Lisbon and made application to go to Biafra as a mercenary, but that Biafra does not want any outsiders to enter the country at this time.

The transistor radio in subject's possession at the time of his arrest is labeled on the outside "Deluxe Hi Fi" and "Merc-Radio." On the inside of the plastic cover which removes to provide access to the batteries, there is attached a paper bearing a schematic diagram of the set, and on this paper are two stamped numbers, "Model HT-6043" and Model HT-6082." No other pertinent information could be found on the outside or inside of the radio. The radio was equipped with an Ever-Ready 9 volt battery, Model PP3.

As the Bureau has been advised, ads have been placed in London newspapers on behalf of the Washington Post to solicit information from the public regarding RAY's activities between May 17 and 28, 1968. Scotland Yard had previously considered a public appeal for such information and attempted to arrange such publicity on 6/18/68, but permission was denied by the Home Office.

Scotland Yard has done a tremendous amount of work in attempting to completely trace RAY's movements and is continuing to expend a great deal of manpower. This is being closely followed with the Yard and the Bureau will be kept currently advised of pertinent developments.
