Re Bureau telephone call to Milwaukee, 4/6/68.

Mr. BERNARD FAUER, Dispatcher, Wisconsin State Highway Patrol, who is familiar with the Soundex System employed at the Operator's License Division. of the MVD, advised that he caused a search to be made of operator's license files under the name HARVEY LOWMEYER, W. J. LEHMEYER and various phonetic and spelling variations of these two names, without locating any operator's license or application for license in any similar names.

It is to be noted that there is no state-wide alphabetical list of registered car owners and therefore in the absence of a VIN or Post Office address from which a vehicle is registered it is not possible to make a car title check under a name.

Additional checking at MVD will continue and supervisor in charge of Operator's License Division will recheck for most thorough possible check under these names for variations.

At 3 PM, 4/6/68, SA REED received a call from Mr. EDWARD MC DOUNOUGH, Bureau Supervisor, who advised as follows:

The above captioned code word "Murkin" has been designated by the Bureau for titling communications concerning the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. on 4/4/68. This code word should be used in future communications of this case.

The best suspect in this case in an individual whose true identity has not been established to date. suspect used the name HARVEY LOWMEYER when he purchased a gun at a sporting goods store in Birmingham, Alabama, on 3/29/68. On 3/30/68, suspect LOWMEYER returned the gun to the sporting goods store and exchanged it for a second gun. The second gun has been identified as the gun which was found near the rooming house across from the motel in Memphis, Tenn., where Rev. KING was assassinated. suspect made a remark at the sporting goods store in Birmingham that he wanted the gun to do some shooting in Wiscons in. No Index Council

The Birmingham Office has determined that one W. J. LERMEYER, who might possibly be identical with the above-mentioned LOWMEYER, made an airline reservation with Southern Airlines at Birmingham, Alabama, to fly to Minneapolis, Minnesota, This travel, commencing at Birmingham, would have been via Memphis, Tenn., Chicago, Ill., with a transfer there to Northwest Airlines with an intermediate stop in Milwaukee enroute to Minneapolis, Minn. LEHMEYER did not, from best available information and investigation, constant supplies and make the flight in that name.

Regarding investigative leads in Wisconsin, Mr. MC DOUNOUGH pointed out that since LOWMEYER mentioned Wisconsin, and the other individual, LEHMEYER, made a plane reservation which would include a stop at Milwaukee, all logical leads should be convered in an effort to determine if the suspect in this case might be known or identified in the Milwaukee Division territory. This investigation should include any logical checking at the commercial airport in Milwaukee, check of city and telephone directories in Milwaukee, and Motor Vehicle Bureau-Auto Registration and Driver's License records in Madison.

SA REED advised Supervisor MC DOUNOUGH that this matter would be handled immediately and the Bureau would be kept advised of any developments or negative results as the case may be. Mr. MC DOUNOUGH pointed out that, of course, these leads had to be handled immediately.

SUBJECT: MURDER OF REV. MARTIN LOTHER KING,

At Madison, Wisconsin

On 4/5/68, Mr. PAUL BREITZKE, 556 State Street, Madison, Wisconsin, telephonically furnished the following information:

He is a student at the University of Wisconsin, Madison, Wisconsin, and at about 11:30 PM on Tuesday, 4/2/68, he was in the bar room of the Madison Inn, located at the corner of Langdon and North Henry Streets, Madison, Wisconsin.

While watching the election returns on television, he overheard an individual remark on several occasions that Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING had been killed. He thought nothing of this until the murder was in fact reported on the night of 4/4/68.

He described this individual as a white male, age 50-55, height 6'2", brown hair turning gray and wearing glasses. He could not further describe this individual and was not certain he would be able to recognize him should he see him again.

Mr. BREITZKE stated it was undoubtedly a coincidence that this individual had reported what in fact happened several days later, but he wished to make this matter a record in the event the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING is not solved.
