On 5/1/68, SA GENE L. STEPHENS and SA RALPH D. PERRIGO interviewed ROMAN BLENSKI, 2919 W. Oklahoma at his residence in reference to the activities of HARRY BOCHEV. BLENSKI stated that the only connection he had ever had with BOCHEV was that he had given him some money and allowed him to eat at his house on several occasions. He stated that he had no particular connection with BOCHEV and assisted him only because he was broke and BLENSKI had felt sorry for him. BLENSKI had displayed two post cards which he stated he had received from BOCHEV, while BOCHEV was in Memphis, Tennessee, where BOCHEV has allegedly been for the last three months. It was noted that neither of the cards bore a stamp or a postmark. Both cards listed return address as HARRY BOCHEV, %ELVIS PRESLEY and PRISCILLA, 3764 Highway 51, South, Memphis, Tennessee

BLENSKI stated that he had not seen BOCHEV since approximately one week ago when he came by and ate lunch with him and stated that he was on his way to Hollywood, California, where he hoped to go into show business with the assistance of ELVIS PRESLEY. BLENSKI stated that he has no further knowledge concerning BOCHEV, but stated that he was not a violent type person and did not believe he would be capable of killing anyone and that he had never known BOCHEV to carry any firearms or weapons of any kind. BLENSKI described BOCHEV as follows:

VAN HORN said his downstairs neighbor is ROMAN BLENSKI, a past mayoral candidate, and he has a friend named HARRY who frequents his residence each day. He stated that the past activities of this friend are the cause for his telephoning the FBI, instant date.

VAN HORN said HARRY lived with BLENSKI about four or five months ago. During this time HARRY made a long distance call to Bulgaria and to Russia without BLENSKI's consent and charged it to BLENSKI's bill. BLENSKI quarreled with HARRY and the telephone company over this bill as a result. About three months ago, HARRY had said he had to go to Memphis to visit some friends and so BLENSKI provided him with enough money to get there.

VAN HORN further advised that to his knowledge HARRY was never employed and BLENSKI does not work at the present time, but seems to always have money.

VAN HORN stated that a couple of days ago HARRY returned to BLENSKI's apartment and now stops by daily between 10 AM and 11:30 AM to have lunch with BLENSKI.

Bureau directs that all law enforcement agencies in division territories, which maintain unidentified latent fingerprints in connection with matters under their jurisdiction, should immediately contact there agencies and request that fingerprints of subject JAMES EARL RAY as set forth on the IO be compared with latents obtained since RAY's escape from the Missouri State Penitentiary on 4/23/67. Object is to possibly establish subject's past whereabouts and source of funds.

Only principal law enforcement agencies need be contacted with a determination made from them concerning any lesser agency in size which may maintain latent fingerprints. If subject is developed, these additional agencies should also be contacted. A check of the Milwaukee PD and Milwaukee County SO has been negative in this regard.

Info has been developed in Atlanta that subject is a drug addict and involved in some unknown degree in illicit drug traffic. This should be borne in mind in connection with contacts with police agencies.

Bureau also points out that since subject was employed as a baker in the Missouri Penitentiary prior to his escape, a review should be made of records of Bakery and Confectionery Workers Unions against subject's name and all known aliases since his escape from prison in the event he may have sought employment requring affiliation with the aforementioned union.

On 5/6/68, The Milwaukee Office telephonically communicated the above information to the Miami Office, at which time SA HOMER NEWMAN advised that Miami was cognizant of the entire matter, and that it had been resolved.

SHIELDS furnished Social Security No. and a permanent address of 15 Almond Drive, Bandolph, Mass. Boston was requested to conduct investigation at this address to eliminate SHIELDS as the subject in this matter.

On 4-30-68, HERB BLONSTROM, Assistant Manager, Sun Castle Motel, 1380 South Ocean Boulevard, advised he had located an application for EARL B SHIELDS of Randolph, Mass., Social Security No. The application showed SHIELDS' previous employment as Plaza East, Fort Lauderdale, Florida, and previous residence at 1325 N. E. 5th Terrace, Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

Subject stated he was to receive \$80,000 for his part in the KING murder. Caller did not know where subject was staying or names of other persons. Subject described as W/M, brown hair with cowlicks, 5 ft. 10in., 170 lbs., spoke with Southern drawl, and had a small black cocker spaniel on a leash. Caller stated he would lead agents to the man if they came to his house to pick him up. Caller stated he would talk no longer and terminated the conversation.

In talking to MATHEWS, writer believes him to be a colored man, and one who was very intoxicated, becoming almost incoherant at times. Caller rambled on, repeated himself several times and stated he had been drinking but was completely sober.

Bureau, by teletype 5/7/68, advised two additional photographs of JAMES EARL RAY were released that day to the news media in Washington. Photograph of RAY in dark glasses and sportshirt is one taken 1967 in Mexico. Photograph of RAY in shirt, tie, and suit was taken either late January or early February 1968. Copies have been reproduced and are made available to each Senior Resident Agent to insure they receive wide-spread distribution through all media contacts.

It is noted that the major newspapers in Milwaukee have printed instant photographs, which obviously were obtained via the International News Wire Services.

Copies attached for SRAs should be made available to local TV outlets. It should also be noted that preprepared proof and newspaper mat, with photograph, has recently been distributed by this office to all newspaper outlets in the State.
