

On 5/1/68, SA GENE L. STEPHENS and SA RALPH D. PERRIGO interviewed ROMAN BLENSKI, 2919 W. Oklahoma at his residence in reference to the activities of HARRY BOCHEV. BLENSKI stated that the only connection he had ever had with BOCHEV was that he had given him some money and allowed him to eat at his house on several occasions. He stated that he had no particular connection with BOCHEV and assisted him only because he was broke and BLENSKI had felt sorry for him. BLENSKI had displayed two post cards which he stated he had received from BOCHEV, while BOCHEV was in Memphis, Tennessee, where BOCHEV has allegedly been for the last three months. It was noted that neither of the cards bore a stamp or a postmark. Both cards listed return address as HARRY BOCHEV, %ELVIS PRESLEY and PRISCILLA, 3764 Highway 51, South, Memphis, Tennessee

BLENSKI stated that he had not seen BOCHEV since approximately one week ago when he came by and ate lunch with him and stated that he was on his way to Hollywood, California, where he hoped to go into show business with the assistance of ELVIS PRESLEY. BLENSKI stated that he has no further knowledge concerning BOCHEV, but stated that he was not a violent type person and did not believe he would be capable of killing anyone and that he had never known BOCHEV to carry any firearms or weapons of any kind. BLENSKI described BOCHEV as follows:

Both JENNRICK and DORFMANN advised they do not know of any other departments that retain fingerprint records.

Milwaukee is continuing to canvass all police departments in the division in an effort to have latent fingerprints compared with Subject.

On 4/24/68, GARRETT VAN HORN, 2919 W. Oklahoma Avenue, (upper), telephonically advised that he had information concerning the above which may be of interest to the FBI in view of the investigation being conducted re MARTIN LUTHER KING.

VAN HORN said his downstairs neighbor is ROMAN BLENSKI, a past mayoral candidate, and he has a friend named HARRY who frequents his residence each day. He stated that the past activities of this friend are the cause for his telephoning the FBI, instant date.

VAN HORN said HARRY lived with BLENSKI about four or five months ago. During this time HARRY made a long distance call to Bulgaria and to Russia without BLENSKI's consent and charged it to BLENSKI's bill. BLENSKI quarreled with HARRY and the telephone company over this bill as a result. About three months ago, HARRY had said he had to go to Memphis to visit some friends and so BLENSKI provided him with enough money to get there.

VAN HORN further advised that to his knowledge HARRY was never employed and BLENSKI does not work at the present time, but seems to always have money.

VAN HORN stated that a couple of days ago HARRY returned to BLENSKI's apartment and now stops by daily between 10 AM and 11:30 AM to have lunch with BLENSKI.

Re Bureau teletype to all SAC's dated 4/29/68.

Bureau directs that all law enforcement agencies in division territories, which maintain unidentified latent fingerprints in connection with matters under their jurisdiction, should immediately ^{be} contacted ~~these agencies~~ and request that fingerprints of subject JAMES EARL RAY as set forth on the IO be compared with latents obtained since RAY's escape from the Missouri State Penitentiary on 4/23/67. Object is to possibly establish subject's past whereabouts and source of funds.

Only principal law enforcement agencies need be contacted with a determination made from them concerning any lesser agency in size which may maintain latent fingerprints. If ^{such} ~~subject~~ is developed, these additional agencies should also be contacted. A check of the Milwaukee PD and Milwaukee County SO has been negative in this regard.

Info has been developed in Atlanta that subject is a drug addict and involved in some unknown degree in illicit drug traffic. This should be borne in mind in connection with contacts with police agencies.

Bureau also points out that since subject was employed as a baker in the Missouri Penitentiary prior to his escape, a review should be made of records of Bakery and Confectionery Workers Unions against subject's name and all known aliases since his escape from prison in the event he may have sought employment requiring affiliation with the aforementioned union.

SCHOENECKER that on 4/16/68 he had received a letter from SAM HUGHES, Acting Director of the School for Boys, Okeechobee, Florida, a close personal friend of his, indicating that HUGHES had information concerning the KING case. HUGHES requested BROWN to have an FBI Agent contact him regarding this matter. BROWN did not desire to make the contact himself for security reasons.

BROWN directed a letter to SA LAWRENCE GETTINGS of the Birmingham Office with whom BROWN was personally acquainted requesting that GETTINGS handle the matter.

By letter dated 5/3/68, HUGHES advised Detective RALPH BROWN that no contact had as yet been made and pointed to the urgency of the matter.

On 5/6/68, The Milwaukee Office telephonically communicated the above information to the Miami Office, at which time SA HOMER NEWMAN advised that Miami was cognizant of the entire matter, and that it had been resolved.

No further action is being taken by the Milwaukee Office.



Referenced Miami airtel set forth results of initial contacts at the Sun Castle Motel wherein it was noted that EARL B. SHIELDS was employed there through 4-1-68. SHIELDS furnished Social Security No. [redacted] and a permanent address of 15 Almond Drive, Randolph, Mass. Boston was requested to conduct investigation at this address to eliminate SHIELDS as the subject in this matter.

On 4-30-68, HERB BLONSTROM, Assistant Manager, Sun Castle Motel, 1380 South Ocean Boulevard, advised he had located an application for EARL B. SHIELDS of Randolph, Mass., Social Security No. [redacted]. The application showed SHIELDS' previous employment as Plaza East, Fort Lauderdale, Florida, and previous residence at 1325 N. E. 5th Terrace, Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

On 5-1-68, MARY BACHMAN, 1333 N. E. 5th Terrace, Fort Lauderdale, advised her records show that EARL SHIELDS resided in an apartment building managed by her for approximately a two-week period. She recalled SHIELDS and his roommate, DAVID WATTIER. WATTIER rented the room 3-16-68, and rent was paid through 4-6-68. After WATTIER moved in, BACHMAN met SHIELDS who informed her that he was staying with WATTIER. WATTIER is believed to have left on 3-30-68, and Mrs. BACHMAN cannot recall specifically which dates after WATTIER departed that SHIELDS remained. She believes SHIELDS stayed another day or two but the exact length of time is unknown.

When WATTIER left he was driving a dark blue automobile, make unknown, and believed to have Florida license plates. WATTIER indicated he was from Minneapolis and was en route Indiana. While at her residence, both WATTIER and SHIELDS drove in WATTIER's auto and were believed to be employed in the same motel.

Mrs. BACHMAN and her husband, ALBERT J. BACHMAN, viewed photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT and expressed the opinion that SHIELDS and GALT are not identical. Mrs.

BACHMAN described SHIELDS as 5' 10" and heavy set.

On 5-2-68, Mrs. IRA M. WOLFE, Personnel Office, Plaza East Condominium, 4300 North Ocean, Fort Lauderdale, made available her records which contained the following:

EARL B. SHIELDS, Social Security No. [REDACTED], of 1313 N. W. 14th Court, Fort Lauderdale, was employed at instant condominium as an outside guard from 3/5-15/68. He listed his date of birth as [REDACTED], height, 5' 10½"; weight, 170; brown hair, blue eyes, and marital status as divorced. SHIELDS listed previous employment at Dunworth Electric, Fort Lauderdale; Hotel Kenmore, Boston, Mass., as doorman; Yankee Fisherman, Boston, Mass., as bartender; and 1280 Beacon Street, Brooklyn, New York, as bartender. He indicated in case of emergency JOSEPHINE BUTLER, 15 Almond Drive, Randolph, Mass., should be contacted.

DAVID H. WATTIER, Social Security [REDACTED] who furnished his address as 1325 N. E. 5th Terrace, Fort Lauderdale, was employed at Plaza East Condominium at approximately the same time as SHIELDS, having apparently begun employment 2-13-68. WATTIER listed his DOB as [REDACTED] 6', 170 pounds, brown hair, blue eyes. He indicated he was from Randolph, Nebraska. He listed previous employment as December, 1967, Dunworth Electric.

On 5-2-68, JOE BLEIER, Head Doorman, Plaza East, advised both SHIELDS and WATTIER worked under his supervision. Both individuals reportedly resided together and definitely came to and departed work in WATTIER's 1966 Chevelle Super Sport, light blue in color.

Both BLEIER and Mrs. WOLFE viewed photographs of ERIC STARVO GALT and both stated in their opinion SHIELDS is not identical with GALT. SHIELDS was a trouble-maker and caused employee discontent over low wages and left after an argument with the management.

He was in contact with individual who killed KING, but would not furnish name. Subject came to Milwaukee with 5 other white males the evening of 4/26 from Detroit. Subject stated he was to receive \$80,000 for his part in the KING murder. Caller did not know where subject was staying or names of other persons. Subject described as W/M, brown hair with cowlicks, 5 ft. 10in., 170 lbs., spoke with Southern drawl, and had a small black cocker spaniel on a leash. Caller stated he would lead agents to the man if they came to his house to pick him up. Caller stated he would talk no longer and terminated the conversation.

In talking to MATHEWS, writer believes him to be a colored man, and one who was very intoxicated, becoming almost incoherent at times. Caller rambled on, repeated himself several times and stated he had been drinking but was completely sober.

This speculation is based on the fact that in the James Bond books by Ian Fleming there is a character named Ernst Stavro Blofield and in "Atlas Shrugged" there is a character named John Galt, as well as one named Eric Starnes. Ernst Stavro Blofield is a formidable person, John Galt is a "social drop out" and Eric Starnes is described in the book as a "whiner" from a low-class family.

In view of the above and in order that Agents handling this investigation can be alert to the possibility of Ray's utilizing an alias based on characters in Fleming's books, there is set out as an attachment to this airtel a list of various characters in those books for your assistance.
