

Police Clear 'Fat Man' in Ray Probe

From Press Dispatches

Toronto, Ontario - The notorious "fat man" of the James Earl Ray case, the subject of an intense police hunt here, has been found. He has no criminal connection with the case.

The "fat man" was said to have delivered a letter to Ray at a rooming house here four days before the accused slayer of the Rev. Martin Luther King, jr., left for London. He walked into police headquarters voluntarily Thursday.

Toronto police said Ray apparently had written a letter about a job and had accidentally dropped it in a pay phone booth near his rooming house. A Toronto man who works in the same area found the unsealed letter in the phone booth, read it and took it to the rooming house at 962 Dundas st. where Ray was living under the name Ramon George Sneyd.


Police said the "fat man," who is not fat but blg, asked to remain anonymous. He could not remember to whom the letter was addressed or very much about its contents.

In London, Ray's defense lawyers were expected to meet soon with Chief Magistrate Frank Militon and United States attorneys to set a date for a hearing on the case for Ray's extradition.
