This sheet was said to have been received in the hand-printed envelope postmarked St. Petersburg, Fla., 4/23/68, P.M., addressed to Rev. ADAM CLAYTON POWELL, Patient at Jackson Memorial Hospital, Miami, Florida."

The second letter, which may or may not relate to this matter, was postmarked Niami, Fla., 4/24/68, and was received in a hand-printed envelope addressed to "ADAM C. POWELL, Jackson Memorial Hospital, Niami, Fla." This envelope bore the return address of J. JONES, 1416 N.W. 5th Avenue, Miami, Fla. Neither this name nor address is reflected in the Miami Cross-Reference Telephone Directory or City Directories. Found in this envelope was a sheet of paper containing the message "I hope you have cancer you mixed bread bastard."

The FBI Laboratory is requested to search the enclosed materials through the Anonymous Letter File to identify writer. The FBI Laboratory is also requested to compare the enclosed materials with each other to determine if they were prepared by the same writer. A latent fingerprinf examination is also requested of enclosed materials. If latents are developed, the Identification Division is requested to compare such latents with any found on the materials transmitted by referenced Miami airtel and against those suspects set out by FBI # in referenced airtel.

Ocean Blwd., Pompano Beach, Fla., an establishment operated by former FBI Agent, they chanced to deal with a bellboy of the motel who apparently left the motel shortly after 3/28/68, to travel to Tennessee to accept work as an electrician in an unknown city in Tennessee, at a salary of \$500 per week. KELLY thought the salary sounded absurd, and later viewing photographs of JAMES EARL RAY, both he and his wife felt the bellboy resembled RAY's description and photograph.

individual referred to would probably be EARL B. SHIELDS of 15 Almond Dr., Randolph, Mass., Social Security Number SHIELDS was employed from 3/28/68 to 4/1/68, as a bellboy. Talking to SHIELDS, BLONSTROM harned that he was divorced and was contemplating re-marriage. He reportedly had several children. He seems to recall SHIELDS mentioned sometime about going to Tennessee, but the name of the city is unknown.

BLONSTROM was unable to locate the employment application for SHIELDS and admitted his records were extremely disorganized. His motel has highly transient help and in fact the supervisor for SHIELDS at the time has since departed. BLONSTROM viewed a photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT and said he did not believe this photograph was identical to SHIELDS. He indicated SHIELDS has more hollow cheeks and a wider nose, although the hairline and eyes are similar. BLONSTROM is continuing efforts to locate SHIELDS application and to identify individuals at the motel who would have known SHIELDS.

Records of the Pompano Beach and Ft. Lauderdale Police Departments and Broward County Sheriff's Office are negative regarding SHIELDS.

Mystery Grows In King Case Manhunt

WASHINGTON — (AP) — FBI officials are quietly trying to play down contradictory descriptions of the appearance and habits of James Earl Ray, alias Eric Starvo Galt, the elusive escaped convict charged with the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

The discrepancies have fueled speculation that perhaps Ray and Galt actually are two persons, or hat two or more persons used the name Galt.

No official statement has been issued to rebut this theory. But as the massive search for King's killer entered its fourth week, FBI sources who had refused to discuss any aspect of the investigation insisted that Ray and Galt are the same person.

"We know there's only one person involved here," said one official. "We've got his fingerprints and we know who he is."

This "one person" contention in itself seems to clash with the FBI's formal stance that Galt conspired with "an individual he alleged to be his brother" to violate King's civil rights.

The FBI filed the conspiracy complaint against Galt in Birningham, Ala... 13 days after King was shot by a sniger in Memphis, Tenn., April 4. Tennessee officials quickly filed a murder charge against Galt.

Two days later, the FBI said a check of fingerprints showed, Ray was the man sought, and he had used Galt as an alias. Ray escaped April 23, 1967, from the Missouri state penitentiary where he was serving a 20-year sentence for a \$190 supermarket robbery.

The FBI has not amended its conspiracy complaint to name Ray instead of Galt, although Tennessee officials made such a name change in the Memphis murder charge.

In enlisting the public's help in the manhunt, the FBI has distributed thousands of flyers. The first set bears Galt's name, the second Ray's.

Puzzling aspects of the case continue to pop up. The newest involves Ray's, or Galt's, smoking habits.

Atlanta residenets said cigaret or cigar ashes were scattered on the carpeted floor of a white 1966 Mustang that FBI agents impounded there a week after King was slain. They also said a cigar butt fell out of the car when agents opened the door. The FBI has said the car was owned by Galt.

In Missouri, it was reported that an FBI bulletin issued last year after Ray's prison escape said Ray "does not smoke."

In California, where the FBI said a man named Galt took dancing lessons from December 1967 through February 1968, an official of the dancing school, Rod Arbidson, said: "I never saw him smoke any kind of tobacco."

In Alabama, where a man named Galt lived in a Birmingham rooming house from August through October 1967, both the manager and the cook said Galt didn't smoke.

Reporters showed copies of the FBI-released picture of Gall to the Birmingham witnesses, and to residents of the Memphis rooming house from which the fatal shot was fired. Almost all said the photo didn't resemble the man they saw.

"Unless he was wearing a wig or had a face lift or something, it's not the man I saw," said Charles Stevens, who lives in the Memphis rooming house.


Varying ages have been given for the hunted man.

Memphis residents said the man they saw leave the rooming house appeared to be between 26 and 32. In Atlanta, a housewife who saw a man get out of the white Mustang estimated his age at 25 to 30. The FBI said Galt gave his age as 36. It said Ray is 40.

Estimates of the fugitive's height have ranged from 5-feet-8 to 6 feet, his weight from 160 to 175 pounds. His eyes have been described as either blue or hazel, his hair as either brown or sandy.

There are conflicts, too, in descriptions of Galt's habits.

The earliest possible utilization of this material should be encouraged and special attention should be given to publications aimed at minority groups.

Reference is made to the writer's previous memo submitted concerning information furnished by WALTER and MYRTLE SHULL at Boca Raton, Fla. on 4/20/68, and subsequent inquiry at Delray Beach, Fla. on 4/22/68.

Mr. AL DE CLERC, owner of Al's Welding Shop, State Road Seven, Delray Beach, Fla. was recontacted on 4/24/68, at his request.

DE CLERC advised that the previous employment dates hed had given for suspect DONALD MILLER, were in error, that MILLER was actually employed from March 6-14, 1968. However, his friend GILROY was employed here on April 4, 1968. DE CLERC added that his records further reflect that MILLER's true name is DONALD LEE MILLER, Social and that his W-2 form bears Security Number the address of Rural Route #3, Mendota, Illinois. DE CLERC stated that MILLER does bear some resemblance to subject RAY; however, MILLER was very heavy in the shoulders and in his opinion would run in excess of 190 pounds. DE CLERC stated that he is certain that MILLER could not be identical with subject RAY, but wanted to correct the information that he had previously furnished in error.

PAUL ALVIN LAIL was informed of the identities of the interviewing agents and the nature of this interview.

LAIL advised he is presently living at 34 Barbados Drive, Palm Springs, with his wife BETTY and five month old baby.

LAIL stated he had been an inmate in the Missouri State Penitentiary for three years and while confined there he had met and known JAMES EARL RAY. He stated he was not very close or friendly with RAY but he did eat with him a number of times when he was in the kitchen visiting with his friend, LEWIE "WHITEY" DOWDA. He said he also watched a number of ball games and television programs with RAY.

LAIL described RAY as being a guy who knew his way around but was not one of the wheels or leaders in prison; that RAY was a sharp intelligent guy who hung around with the boys who were always up to something and were in on all of the deals. LAIL advised RAY never seemed to have a lot of money but always seemed to have enough to get whatever he wanted.

LAIL said most of the guys (he cannot recall their names) that he, RAY, was with most of the time were on dope and were peddling it.

LAIL continued by saying that RAY's big buddy was NEAL ABBEY who was a "big wheel" and the guy who ran the prison kitchen with "an iron hand." LAIL stated ABBEY was the guy who got RAY into the kitchen which was a good deal (job).

LAIL advised that LEO BARNETT handled dope and peddled it in the Missouri State Penitentiary and he believes he is now in prison somewhere in Florida. He said that BARNETT would know for certain if RAY had been on dope and where and who he got the dope from.

LAIL further advised that FRED MILLER, "a cut and dried con," who worked in the tag plant of the prison, was one of the leaders and knew RAY well and he might be able to furnish information about him if he would talk to the FBI.

LAIL related that WHITEY DOWDA also knew RAY pretty well and would knew more about him than he did since they both worked in the kitchen together for quite a while. He said WHITEY had been living in Merietta, Georgia, and he recently heard that WHITEY is now in jail in Merietta on a robbery charge.

LAIL stated there had been trouble with some of the Negro prisoners in the Missouri State Penitentiary who were Black Muslims so some of the prisoners decided to teach them a lesson and three or four of the Negro leaders were killed. LAIL stated he did not know if RAY was in on the actual killing, but he was close with the ones that did it and therefore could have been in on the killing or at least he knew who did kill the Negroes.

LAIL would not make any further statements about the killing of the Negroes in the Missouri State Penitentiary and he stated he could not furnish any names or identities but he did say there were ten inmates who were in on the killing of the Negroes.

LAIL said he could not recall RAY saying too much about Negroes and he does not believe from his conversations with RAY that he, RAY, was a racist, however, all of the inmates in the Missouri State Penitentiary did not like the Negroes because of their belligerent attitude and animosity toward the white inmates.

LAIL stated RAY liked to wear his hair short in the summer months and long in the winter. He said RAY used to have a "butch" cut in the summer months.
