A person identifying himself as WILLIE ASHBURN, 402 Madison Street, Franklin, Virginia (phone 562-4622), advised he is employed at the Naval Supply Center (NSC), Building Z-99, on the U.S. Naval Station.

He stated that a white male having a narrow face, 5' plus, 160 pounds, wearing regular driver's clothing with insulated jacket, had some .30 caliber cartridges on the dashboard of his truck and had that date exhibited to some other employees a .30 caliber replie which he keeps in the cab of that truck.

ASHBURN stated that the truck is presently unloading on the north side of Pier #3 at the NSC, and after unloading at Pier #3, will complete unloading at Building Z-99 this evening. The driver, who, he stated, generally fits the description of UNSUB, is driving a Trans-Cold Express of Texas Meat Packers, having 1968 Texas License Z-40806 on the trailer.

Chief of Police "JAKE" HARDISON, SPF, USNS, was advised of the foregoing; that the driver had a rifle in his possession on the USNS and was requested to obtain identifying data and photographs, if possible, from the driver. HARDISON insured that the driver would not determine the Bureau's interest in this matter.

Jacksonville police said Sunday the man was arrested after a resident noted a likeness to a composite picture which peared in Florida newspapers. This sketch was prepared by a newspaper artist from the description given of the slaving, It was not released - nor endorsed - by the FBI.

Residents of the Memphis rooming house from which King was shot April 4 reported last week that investigators had shown them composite drawings. But they said the sketches were the same - or at least very similar - as those prepared by newspaper artists.

FBI officials rejected reporters' requests for a composite drawing of the man they are seeking in what perhaps is the most massive manhunt of modern times. They refuse to say whether they have prepared such a sketch.

Agents have a good physical description of King's assassin: 30 to 32 years old, 5 feet, 10 inches tall, weighing 165 pounds. with a receding hairline and a long, thin nose.

They also have a good description of the white 1966 Mustang which witnesses said sped away from the Memphis rooming house minutes after King was shot as he stood on a motel balcony 205 feet from the rear of the rooming house.

A white Mustang was impounded Thursday night from an Atlanta parking lot where it had been parked since the morning after King's slaying.

## l Holds Sketch, Police Say

MEMPHIS (AP)-The FBI is withholding nationwide distribut tion of a composite drawing of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s assassin, police sources said Sunday.

"They haven't given us anything but a physical description," said one police official. "They aren't handing out pictures of the man. They either don't have a good one, they're going it alone."

The official asked that his name not be used, citing the FBI's ban on comment about the investigation.

When Jacksonville, Fla., police questioned a Louisville. Ky., man Saturday night about the King slaying - the man since has been cleared of any connection - Police Lt. M.F. Richardson said, "It's a long shot, but he looks too much like FBI

He again observed them leaving the store with the rifle and saw them drive off in a white Mustang. MR. ROBESON said he thought no more of it until seeing the GALT picture on television at which time he observed a strong similarity between GALT and one of the men buying the rifle.

THE FBI DIRECTOR SAID THAT GALT, WHO HAS USED THE NAMES OF JOHN WILLARD AND HARVEY LOWMYER IN THE PAST, IS THE OWNER OF A 1966 WHITE MUSTANG BEARING ALABAMA LICENSE PLATES WHICH WAS LOCATED ABANDONED IN ATLANTA, GEORGIA, ON APRIL 11, 1968. INVESTIGATION DISCLOSED THAT GALT PURCHASED THIS CAR FROM A PRIVATE CITIZEN IN BIRMINGHAM ON AUGUST 30, 1967. THE MUSTANG'S ODOMETER SHOWED THAT IT HAD BEEN DRIVEN MORE THAN 19,000 MILES BETWEEN LATE AUGUST, 1967, AND EARLY APRIL, 1968.

on 4/16/68 HAROLD WILSON telephoned the Norfolk office of the FBI and identified himself as a member of the faculty at Old Dominion College, Norfolk. WIESON stated that he had been discussing the MARTIN LUTHER KING ,Jr. assistantion in one of his classes and he arrived at a theory that he thought might be of some assistance to the FBI. WILSON stated that the aliases used by the assising i.e. WILLARD and GALT, are significant. He explained that the WILLARD HOTEL was prominent in LINCOLN's assasination and the name GALT was a name used by the authoress AYN RAND in her novel "Atlas Shrugged". WILSON stated that at present there is a disciple of AYN HAND named I BRANNIGAN (phoenetic) who is organizing "Objectivist Clubs" in the U.S. and that the assasin could be associated with one of these clubs. Information regarding these clubs could be obtained from the cover of a recent printing of one of RAND's books. Objectivism is the philosophy of RAND and followers of it are disenchanted with the present society and are "dropping out to from their own exclusive society.

It is recommended that the above be filed in the MURKIN case file for possible future use. No action is recommended at this time.
