On the above date office was contacted by Sgt. Harris Seager, Va. Beach, Va., PD to advise that he had received a call from Mrs. Mary Ann Briley, 865 Hunting Hill Lane, Va., Beach, Va., 497-2094. Mrs. Briley advised him that there had been a man by the name of Robert Terry staying at her residence for about a week that resemble the subject James Earl Ray. Terry was brought to this residence by Mrs. Briley's husband of April 17 or 18 from Columbus, Ohio. Mr. Briley is a long distance trucker, recently he left for the west coast and Mrs. Briley got him to take Terry along with him. She received a call from her husband and he advised that Terry had left him and stayed in Chicago.

Mrs. Briley had told police that Terry has keys to her house and that he has told her children that he was planning to return on the 15th of May.

Terry was described as white male, 5' 8" 160 lbs., 50 years old gray hair was black but died, well educated and could play piano. Terry also had a California chauffers license.

Sgt. Harris said if he could be of any help in this matter do not hesitate to call upon him.

JAMES F. GREGORY was contacted at his residence at 608 Ellen Road, Newport News, Va. He advised that he is employed by the Newport News, Shipbuilding and Drydock Company. He advised that he is preparing a scrapbook in regard to the killing of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. He stated that his postcard to the FBI headquarters in Washington, D.C., whereby he requested wanted flyers #442 and #442a, was for the purpose of their inclusion in his personal scrapbook.

GREGORY advised that he has no personal knowledge of any of the principals in the instant matter.

He was furnished copies of the afore mentioned wanted flyers by SA BURRELL.

It is noted that during the course of the interview, GREGORY advised that he feels that Attorney General RAMSEY CLARK is a hindrance to the investigation of the instant matter. GREGORY advised that soon after sending the postcard to FBI headquarters, Washington, D.C., he sent a postcard to Attorney General CLARK stating that he was "a miserable failure as Attorney General of the United States." GREGORY stated that

Private TIMOTHY JOHN TAYLOR, was contacted at Ft.  
Eustis, Va. He advised that he is in Company E of the Second  
School Battalion, Transportation School Brigade. He advised  
that he boarded the instant flight 338 at Oklahoma City, Okla.,  
on 4/6/68, with his destination being Philadelphia, Pa. He  
sat in the most rear seat in the tourist section, next to a  
white female with blond hair. He was shown a photograph of  
JAMES EARL RAY with negative results. He advised that he  
could recall no one on said flight who even resembled RAY.  
He noted, however, that due to his close attention to the white  
female with whom he was sitting that he did not really pay to  
much attention to any of the other passengers. He stated that  
due to his seat in the most rear section of the airplane also,  
that his observation of all passengers in the tourist section  
would have been quite limited.

Due to the above, no further investigation being  
conducted re this matter by Norfolk.

## 2 Photos Of Suspect Released

WASHINGTON (UPI) —The FBI distributed Tuesday two more photographs of the accused killer of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., one of them "an extremely good likeness."

Both were snapshots of James Earl Ray, alias Eric Starvo Galt, an escaped convict accused of shooting King to death in Memphis April 4.

The "extremely good likeness" is a candid photograph of Ray in a business suit and tie and shows almost his full face, taken in late January or early

February somewhere in California.

The other, which the FBI said was taken last November somewhere in Mexico, shows

him wearing sun glasses and what appears to be a white sports shirt. The FBI said Ray is known to wear sun glasses frequently.

The two new photographs—the FBI refused to say where or how they were obtained—will be displayed throughout the country along with three other pictures of Ray which now appear on FBI's wanted posters.

One of the earlier photographs was taken when Ray was graduated from bartending school in Los Angeles early this year. His eyes were closed when the shutter snapped, but they were sketched in by an FBI artist. The picture shows him wearing a white shirt and black bow tie.

The other two photographs were made when Ray entered the Missouri state prison in 1960 to serve a 20-year sentence for armed robbery.

Ray, who escaped from prison April 23, 1967 by hiding in a truck, is wanted by the FBI for illegal flight to avoid prosecution in Tennessee for King's slaying.

# Clark Still Hopeful On Capture of Ray

DURHAM, N.C. (AP)—U.S. Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark declared here Wednesday he is still optimistic that the accused slayer of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. will be apprehended. But, at the same time, Clark denied reports which quoted him as predicting the assassin would be caught "soon."

Clark said he had been advised that the only way to keep from being misquoted is to "keep your mouth shut." He said Texans find that hard to do.

The head of the U.S. Justice Department insisted he never mentioned a time during the time he discussed the assassination with newsmen in Memphis, Tenn. But at Duke University Wednesday he said he is still optimistic that James Earl Ray will be captured "for a number of reasons." And he said he hoped the arrest will be soon. Clark appeared at the Duke University Law School for a brief talk and question and answer session with the students. He addressed the student body later Wednesday night.

During his meeting with the law students, Clark said the

Justice Department is preparing for a variety of contingencies during the Poor People's March in Washington, "including the potential for violence."

Answering charges that he is unprepared for a takeover of the march by black militants, Clark insisted it is impossible to guarantee there will be no violence if the poor come or if they don't.

He said Washington police and other law enforcement officials are being prepared to handle any situation as "feasibility permits."

He indicated that federal authorities have been working closely with Washington officials in preparation for the demonstrations.

Clark also spoke at Chapel Hill and Winston-Salem during the day.

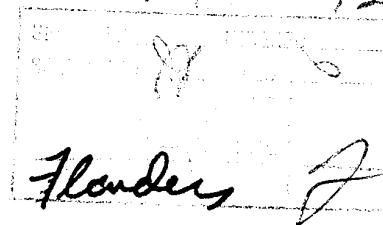

Ernst Stavro Blofield is a formidable person, John Galt is a "social drop out" and Eric Starnes is described in the book as a "whiner" from a low-class family.

## Ray Death Theory Out, Clark Says

WASHINGTON (UPI)—Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark expressed the belief Sunday that escaped convict James Earl Ray, accused of slaying Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., remains alive. He said he was "very optimistic" that Ray would be captured.

Clark said he found no evidence to support theories that Ray had been hired by conspirators to kill King and then himself was killed. "We have no evidence to believe that he is not still alive," he said.

"I believe we will find him," Clark said. Citing the "massive manhunt" under way for Ray, he said, "It is awfully difficult for an individual, and particularly an individual about whom so much is known, to remain at large in the United States under these circumstances."

Interviewed on television (Issues and Answers—ABC), Clark also said the investigation was still operating on the assumption that King's killer was not the agent of conspirators.

"Our evidence indicates a man acting alone," he said. "This does not negate other theories. It would be impossible to rule out a conspiracy of the right or the left or the middle or any other type conspiracy."

In order to cover the possibility that subject may have died since commission of the crime, the U. S. Census Bureau and Department of Health, Education and Welfare were contacted and they advised that no central records of unidentified deceased are maintained by those agencies. It was suggested that each state may maintain such a record in their Bureau of Vital Statistics or similar agency.

There is no known Federal law requiring the maintenance of such information; and it is possible that if any record of unidentified dead is maintained, it would only be maintained at local police departments, morgues, medical facilities, or the like.

Each office covering state capitals should check to ascertain if such records are maintained, and if so, should check records for the period from 4-5-68, to date, for any information which might possibly identify subject Ray with unidentified deceased person over that period.

If there is no central record repository maintained in the various states or nationally in the case of Mexico and Canada, you should, in connection with your contacts with law enforcement agencies on this case or other Bureau matters, make appropriate inquiries relative to

unidentified dead for the period beginning 4-5-68; and if fingerprints on such dead are maintained, they should be compared with those on the Identification Order on Ray in order to effect identification or nonidentification. This should be handled in the normal course of business and only reasonable investigation should be pursued along these lines.

The Identification Division has placed an appropriate stop on unidentified deceased inquiries it may receive. If feasible, appropriate offices and Legats, Mexico City and Ottawa should place similar stops with appropriate state, local or national agencies in your territories.

SUBJECT: MURKIN

On 5/21/68, at 9:45 p.m. an individual who identified himself as AL GRIMSLEY, telephonically contacted the Norfolk office of the FBI and spoke with SPC JAMES GUYTON. He advised GUYTON that he was presently at the Portsmouth Naval Hospital Officer's Club and that there was an individual at the Officers Club at that time who resembled the photographs shown on the wanted posters of JAMES EARL RAY.

At 9:50 p.m. SA DAVID G. FLANDERS telephonically contacted the Portsmouth Naval Hospital and asked for Extention 580. The individual who answered it identified himself as one AL GRIMSLEY who resided at 105 Bingham Dr., Portsmouth, Virginia. It was quite evident from the speech of GRIMSLEY that he had been drinking and that he was in at least a partially intoxicated condition. At the outset of the telephonic interview, GRIMSLEY demanded that an Agent immediately come to the Portsmouth Naval Hospital Officer's Club and conduct investigation to determine whether an individual at the Officer's Club was identical with JAMES EARL RAY. GRIMSLEY was very hesitant about furnishing any information about the suspect or about himself.

GRIMSLEY did state that he was a delivery man, who had made deliveries to the bar at the Portsmouth Naval Hospital Officer's Club and that even though he was not a military personnel he was in at the bar drinking. He stated that he was 37 years old and that he resided at the above address with his home telephone number being 484-2482.

He advised that he had seen the wanted posters for JAMES EARL RAY and that an individual sitting at the bar who had identified himself as DICK MacDERMAT (Phonetic), closely resembled the photograph of RAY as taken during his bartending course in California.

GRIMSLEY would not furnish any physical description of the suspect, and was very foul in his language and his remarks about the FBI. He demanded that an Agent immediately come and talk to him. At this point, his speech became very slurred and he started yelling at the writer.

GRIMSLEY finally gave the rough description of the suspect as being white male, 6' tall, (his own height), 220 lbs., with no scars on his forehead, and with a smooth chin.

GRIMSLEY gave several inconsistent statements about the suspect; ie that he was alone at the bar and then GRIMSLEY said that he was with a girl; that he was a resident of this area and then GRIMSLEY advised that he was immediately getting up from the bar and was going to go to Alabama or Missouri.

Through GRIMSLEY's physical description of DICK MacDERMAT, it was determined that he was not identifiable with subject JAMES EARL RAY, due to the height and extreme weight of MacDERMAT, and due to the lack of any facial scars or cleft chin.

This fact was relayed to GRIMSLEY, who became very vehement about the FBI's not immediately coming and talking to him at that hour. He made several derogatory remarks about the interviewing agent in regard to his just not wanting to leave the house at that time of night. It was emphasized to Mr. GRIMSLEY that through his physical description of the man at the Portsmouth Naval Hospital Officer's Club, that he was not identifiable with JAMES EARL RAY.

GRIMSLEY then asked the interviewing agent to hold on the phone for a minute and the writer heard in the background several loud boisterous remarks about the incident and one remark, "Get that call through to me to Washington."

Due to GRIMSLEY's obvious intoxicated condition, the telephonic interview was at this point terminated after the interviewing agent having thanked Mr. GRIMSLEY for his interest.

PUBLICITY ON REWARDS OFFERED

Each Special Agent in Charge and Legal Attache is instructed to promptly remind their established cooperative news sources, in a discreet and tactful manner, of the existence of substantial reward money for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the killer of Dr. Martin Luther King. This money now totals at least \$100,000. The FBI should not, however, be publicized as the source of this reminder.

While the Bureau's continuing policy is to encourage the public to furnish information to law enforcement authorities as a matter of good citizenship, without expectation of financial reward, it is fully recognized that monetary rewards are often necessary to motivate some individuals. The knowledge of the existence of the substantial rewards available in the Murkin case could possibly prove of value in the solution of this major investigation.
