MURKIN CIVIL RIGHTSS

At 16:50am on this date, the Dominican Connel General RAMON CASTILLO telephonically contacted the NYO and asked to contacted at his office immediately by Bureau agents as he had information of national importance.

He was interviewed at the Dominican Consulate, 1270 Avenue of the Americas, NYC, by SAS HEINRICH VON ECKARDT and JOHN A. BEHRINGER at 11:30am to 12:15pm. at which time he furnished the following information:

Last night while reading the Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, newspaper "Listin" Diario" edition of 4/9/68, he noticed a composite drawing of the alleged assassin of MARTIN LUTHER KING and he thought it resembled someone he had seen This morning, while reading the NY Spanish language recently. newspaper "El Tiempo" he saw another composite drawing of the same individual which comfirmed his impression that he had recently seen this person. He then remembered that this person had a striking resemblence with a man who was seated next to him on the evening of April 55 5, 1968, on a Pan American flight from New York to San Juan, Puerto Rico, leaving NY at (possibly PAA flight 287, but Castillo was not sure 8:15pm. of the flight number). He remarked remembered this man as he appeared to be extremely nervous, more so than the usual air traveller. He noted that this man ordered and drank in rapid succession 6 to 8 double scotchs on the rocks. During the flight this man attempted to engage CASTILLO in coversation but CASTILLO limited the conversation to a minimum due to CASTILLO 's limited English. CASTILDO remembered that when the man noticed that CASTILLO was reading a Dominican newspaper, "El Caribe", he began his convers ation by asking CASTILLO how conditions were in the Dominican Republic. CASTILLO replied that things were progressing satisfactory. In order not to appear impolite, CASTILLO continued the conversation by asking the man if he was going to Santa Domingo. The man said he was Curiand Comad not, but was going to San Juan where he wanted to spend a vacation.

She man then asked CASTILLO what he thought of Puerto Rico, to which CASTILLO replied that it was a very nice island and the people are friendly. The man then asked CASTILLO what he thought of the assassination of the Rev. MARTIN LUTHER KING. CASTILLO said that he thought this was a horrible crime. man made no further mentioned of KING after this. CASTILLO said that this was the extent of their conversation. CASTILLO stated that when the plane arrived in San Juan, he, CASTILLO, got off the plane before this man but noticed this man got off the plane also and the last time he saw him this man was walking toward the air terminal building. CASTILLO noted that this man did not appear to be intoxicated when he last saw him. No one seemed to be accompanying this man when CASTILLO last saw him.

CASTILLO stated that he RXMXXXX occupied a window seat on this flight, the unknown man occupied the middle seat and an unknown woman occupied the aisle seat. These seats were in the Economy flightxxx section of this flight, toward the front of the plane. The only conversation that CASTILLO noted between the unknown man and unknown woman was when the man ordered kixxxxxx one of his drinks, the woman asked him to order a drink for her also. The woman drank two double scotches on the rocks, which theunknown man paid for. The woman smoked incessantly, even during periods when the "No Smoking" sign was lighted. The man offered CASTILLO a Lark cigarette. The woman smoked extra long king size cigarettes, brand name unknown.

CASTILLE stated that all conversation was done in the English language between himself and the unknown man, but CASTILLO stated that his English is so limited that he was unable to tell whether the man spoke with any type of accent.

#### CASTILLO described the unknown man as follows:

The forehead, looks and lips of composite in "El Tiempo" bear strong resemblance to unknown man.

He could not further describe this woman.

CASTILLO noted that the same stewardess served the unknown man all of his drinks, therefore she may be able to furnish further descriptions of unknown man and woman.

At 1:30 p.m., this date, Supervisor JACK THOMPSON, U.S. Secret Service, 90 Church Street, New York City, telephone #26# 7204, telephonically advised the writer that at 12:30 p.m. this afternoon the White House received a call from an individual who identified himself as TIM ELMENDORF, 6319 Park View Garden, Apartment 2, Riverdate, New York, who advised that he knew who killed MARTIN LUTHER KING and that "they" are after him also. The person receiving the call at the White House commented that the caller appeared to be "mental".

Supervisor THOMPSON said that this information was also given to Detective DOOLEY, Shield #2752, New York City Police Department, simultaneously with the call to this office.

THOMPSON said Secret Service is taking no action but would like to know if our investigation determines that ELMENDORF is "mental" so that they can make an appropriate notation.

Indices of NYO have not been checked. Agent JOHN F. SHANLEY was notified of the above information at 1:35 p.m., this date.

Rosen believed the listing of marks to be completeand are part of a continuing survey conducted by patrolmen on the beat.



REGGIE SMITH, cameraman, Columbia Broadcasting System (CBS), Atlanta, Georgia, telephonically contacted SA JAMES O. INGRAM on April 12, 1968. He stated he had just arrived in Atlanta upon instructions issued by officials of CBS. The news media is presently carrying headlines indicating that ERIC STARVO GALT is a prime suspect in the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. at Memphis, Tennessee. A white Mustang registered to GALT was found in Atlanta, on April 11, 1968, abandoned. Through news media, SMITH has obtained description of GALT and believes he has information which could be of value to the FBI. He furnished the following information:

On Saturday, April 6, 1968, he and his soundman, LEROY COLLINS, traveled to Spelman College, Atlanta, Georgia, to film persons viewing the body of Dr. KING, or incidents. The first roll of film that he shot was of a group of about ten people. There was one lone white male who viewed the body in this first group and he and his soundman, COLLINS, noticed the unknown male pass by the coffin and smile. He appeared to laugh, looked around to see if anyone was observing him, and he left "with a smile on his face." SMITH did not consider the incident of any value at that time, until he reviewed the information on GALT and GALT's description.

He described the unknown subject who viewed the body of KING as a white male, in his early thirties, 5' 10" to 5' 11", weight 160 - 170 pounds, dark hair, and was wearing a light-colored suit. SMITH suggested that the FBI may desire to review his first can of sixteen

HANNES K. WATZLAWEK, Night Supervisor, San Francisco Office, telephonically advised at 2:00 a.mm Eastern Standard Time, 4/13/68, that Hertz Rent-a-Car Agency, San Francisco Airport had advised San Francisco Office that an individual who closely resembled the composit drawing of Unsub, who assassinated MARTIN LUTHER KING had attempted to rent a car for travel to NYC. Unsub stated his name was (FNU) REYES but furnished no further personal identification. He advised that he worked for Otis Elevator Company, Electronics Division, 35 Ryerson Street, Brooklyn, New Yorkm telephone UL 5-6800 and stated his supervisor the above was Mr. MARVIN GANT.

After ascertaining price of rental to NYC, subject stated that he would not rent a car and would probably buy one to drive to NY. Subject advised Hertz personnel he just arrived from Vietnam, has a German wife and plans a stop in Lawton, Oklahoma.

San Francisco requested NY to ascertain if above information could be verified. As subject told Hertz personnel he planned to stay in a hotel in the airport area and San Francisco was anticipated calling out agent personnel for a shake-down of numerous hotels and motels in airport area.

SA HAMILTON ascertained that local telephone numbers listed for Otis Elevator were connected to answering service and all listed Otis numbers were called with negative results as to ascertain available Otis personnel to verify employment of REYES and GANT.

A search of Key Facility (135) Indexes on 10th Floor reflected that GERALD CARROLL, 2317 Wallace Avenue, Bronx, NY, was listed as Bersonnel Manager and Security Officer for Otis Elevator, Brooklyh, New York, CARROLL was telephonically contacted by the writer at 231-854.

CARROLL was not advised of the matter of the inquiry but only that it was a matter of immediate interest to the FBI to ascertain identity of GANT and REYES. CARROLL stated that REYES is only known to him by his last name and he has no personal knowledge of him but believes that he is employed as a field representative in Stamford, Connecticut, and sometimes travels overseas. CARROLL further stated that MARVIN GAUT is a supervisor with Otis Elevator, Brooklyn, NY, and is a reputable employee.

The above was telephonically furnished to the San Francisco Office and San Francisco advised that a teletype would be forthcoming to further verify identity of REYES through Otis personnel records.

At 11:10PM, 4/13/68, Mrs. ANITA BINSSE, Age: 52, 377 Ocean Parkway, Apartment C-12, Brooklyn, N.Y. telephonically contacted the NYO and advised that approximately one week ago, exact date unrecalled, she accompanied her daughter BARBARA, Age; 21 to the "ELECTRIC CIRCUS", located at an unrecalled address in the Greenwich Village section of NYC.

While at the "ELECTRIC CIRCUS" they met an individual known only to them as "JERRY", who began dancing with BARBARA. During the course of the evening, according to Mrs. BINSSE, "JERRY", who she described as a white male, age: 27, 5'9", light hair, and wearing sports clothes, constantly talked about the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. She related this "JERRY" appeared to be very pleased over the killing of KING, and stated something to the effect, "It had to be done - it was the will of God." During the course of the evening "JERRY" stated he had been a merchant seaman, and related stories of his travels.

At the conclusion of the evening, Mrs. BINSSE advised "JERRY" drove both she and her daughter to her Ocean Parkway address in what Mrs. BINSSE described as a tan colored Mustang, license tags unknown. She further stated, she could furnish no information as to where this "JERRY" lived, not did she known his surname, and during their trip home did not appear to be familiar with the area.

Mrs. BINSSE stated she heard through the news media that the suspect in the murder of KING was a seaman and operated a Mustang, and for this reason was furnishing the above information to the FBI, for whatever value it might possess, and would be available for further interview. She further stated that she is divorced, unemployed and her daughter BARBARA is now residing with her, Mrs. Binsse"s former husband at RFD, Valatie, Columbus County, New York.




