



A report of a "million-dollar bounty" offered by a "businessman's association" has intensified the FBI's investigation of a conspiracy in the

murder of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

A former cellmate of fugitive James Earl Ray, hunted as King's assassin, told the FBI in a Georgia jail "that a quick nervous sneer" came across Ray's face when a new man told of the bounty for killing King. Convicted murderer Raymond Curtiss quoted Ray as saying: "I'll collect that if I ever get out of here.'

The new evidence of a possible conspiracy prompted FBI agents to return to Whitfield County jail, near Dalton, Ga., and the Tennessee state line, where they questioned Curtiss Sunday and Monday nights Monday nights.

Grapevine Spreads Word Sheriff Gerry Mauldin, war-

den of the jail, said: "Word that Ray Curtiss knew the fellow Ray, wanted by the FBI, came to me through the prison grapevine. I sent for him and he told me how he knew him. I called the FBI and they sent men in both Sunday and Monday nights."

Curtiss, awaiting appeal on a murder conviction, told the agents that he knew Ray (also known as Eric Starvo Galt) in Kansas City, Mo., jail, in the federal prison at Leavenworth, Kan., and in the Missouri State Prison at Jefferson City. It was from Missouri that Ray escaped last April. It was also in Missouri that Ray made the statements concerning the bounty. the bounty.

Curtiss also told the FBI that Ray had told him that, if he wanted to kill someone, he would buy a gun under a false name, and have everything ready for an escape.

"He used to talk a lot about "He used to talk a lot about escaping to New Zealand, Brazil and Argentina," the convict said. In telling about his friendship with Ray, Curtiss said: "When I was hospitalized for six weeks with hepatitis, Ray came to visit with me every day."

Curtiss said he didn't "connect Ray with King's killing until he saw his picture on a TV set." "I didn't even know he had escaped

didn't even know he had escaped Missouri prison," he said.
"If others were involved in a plot to kill King," Curtiss said, "Ray will carry the secret to his grave."

Lawyer Backs Curtiss Former Georgia Rep. Irwin Mitchell, Curtiss' lawyer, tol THE NEWS last night:

"I tirmly believe what Curtiss told the FBI is the truth. He has nothing to gain and he's smart and savvy enough to know he



In Memphis, Tenn., where King was slain on April 4, the FBI refused to confirm or deny that it was investigating a possibility that the hunted man was dead.

According to authorities in Atlanta, Ga., Ray registered in the Briarcliff Hotel there under the name of Galt on the weekend after the slaying. Three water glasses, supposedly used by Ray and two females who visited him, were impounded by the FBI after a desk clerk identified a photograph shown by agents agents.

The FBI in Los Angeles was reportedly trying to find a blonde woman who was dating Ray be-fore he disappeared from Southern California.

The FBI would offer no state-ments regarding the investigation or Curtiss' information.





Tam also enclosing sketch (from our local paper) that very much resembles a man that was on TV in a showing of The American Alcoholic over WFMJ - 21 between 10:00 PM & 11 P.M: It was made at an Alcoholic Clinic in Atlanta, Gorgia. It showed this man in jail - also before the judge (being released) also showed him crossing street and entering a bar with another man (looked like other one had blond hair - about 1/2 head shorter than the man I am mentioning. Also showed them coming out of bar & drinking from bottle. When Judge called his name he mentioned the name Rudolph 3 or 4 times. I could not quite get the last name - sounded like Helon or Hallon. Judge was quite plump. Do not know who he was either. Man is classified as an alcoholic. I could be very wrong but I could not help noticing the resemblance to description of dress, heighth etc. that has been in our paper.

Please do not mention this letter to anyone as we are already living in fear all over America of the violence going on.

COMMUNIST INFILTRATION OF SOUTHERN CHRISTIAN LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE INTERNAL SECURITY - C

ASSASSINATION OF DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. RACIAL MATTER

On April 22, 1968, a confidential source advised he had recently learned that subsequent to the death of Reverend Martin Luther King, Jr., Bernard Lafayette, Program Administrator, Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC) ... and Hosea Williams, Director of Voter Registration and Political Education, SCLC, have on more than one occasion commented to SCLC Executive Staff members that it can be anticipated other members (not identified) of SCLC's Executive Staff might die as a result of violence in the continuing civil rights struggle. They have pointed out that the continuing civil rights struggle will require the utilization of economic pressures (not specified) which will result in conflicts of interests in the Nation's economy.

With reference to the death of Reverend King, some members of the SCLC Executive Staff feel the shooting of Reverend King was the work of a mentally unbalanced person. While others appear to have an open mind regarding this matter, a minority of the staff feel it is quite plausible that the shooting of Reverend King was directly or indirectly instigated by President Lyndon B. Johnson and/or members of his administration. In support of this line of thinking these members maintain that Reverend King's status as a powerful civil rights leader, his staunch opposition to the Viet Nam War, and potential to embarrass the current administration through SCLC's pending Poor People's Campaign, have undoubtedly irked the President and his administration for an appreciable time.

Source could furnish no further details regarding the above matter, but expressed the opinion that such thinking might be the result of an emotional reaction to a catastrophe, coupled with a distrust of "the establishment". INDEXED. SEARCHED.

During October, 1964, a confidential source advised that on October 3, 1964, RUTH BAILEY, then an employee of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, (SCLC), Harlem, New York Office, while discussing several SCLC personalities with one CONNIE CAMPBELL, referred to WILLIAMS. BAILEY said WILLIAMS had mentioned to her (date not specified) that on a prior occasion (date not specified) HUNTER PITTS O'DELL had told him more about politics than he could read.





HUNTER PITTS O'DELL

In July, 1962, HUNTER PITTS O'DELL, also known as JACK H. O'DELL, was considered by the Communist Party, USA, as a member of its National Committee.

HUNTER PITTS O'DELL told EDWINA SMITH December 27, 1963, he would not go back to the Southern Christian Leadership Conference on the same basis because he is now a "left person" and if they cannot accept him the way he is then they will have to forget about him.
