FRED WEBER, Sales Representative, Textile Marking Machine Company, Incorporated, Syracuse, New York, telephone 715-2135, advised he has been so employed for the past 10 years and his territory consists of the New England states, New York, East of Albany and New Jersey.

He stated that one, PAUL COMBS, Falls Church, Virginia, telephone 703-HU 1-9322, who is employed in the same capacity by the same firm had covered the territory from Pennsylvania south through South Carolina until his death about three weeks ago and that his work is being assumed by his brother, JOSEPH COMBS, who has been associated with PAUL prior to his demise.

WEBER advised that one, RICHARD BRISTO, 3462 Northwest 13th Avenue, Gainsville, Georgia, telephone 904-372-1290, is likewise employed and has a territory comprising of Georgia, Florida and probably Alabama, Mississippi.

He stated that about 10 years ago he and PAUL COMBS by mutual agreement and because of their contingent territories had adopted a common five digit code in connection with the identification tape dispensed by the machine be sold by them for the Textile Marking Machine Company.

WEBER stated the code was also discussed with the above named RICHARD BRISTO at that time but that he is not aware if it was adopted for use by BRISTO.

WEBER stated that he and COMBS agreed that the first letter of the identification number would be a lot number, which would be the letter D; the next digit would be a figure which would designate the day of the week; the next digit would be a letter indicating the first letter of the name of the laundry and the last digit would be a figure indicating the number of the bundle.

He stated that ll different colored tapes are available for use which are usually used in connection with a lot number, however, some laundry uses only one color for its

complete operation in which case color would become a limited factor in attempting to effect an identification of a particular customer.

A colored photo of two pieces of underwear bearing the five digit identification nymber D2B-6 on red tape was displayed to WEBER. He stated that the dash before the figure six is counted as a digit making the total of five digits. He stated that this indicates that the machine which was used is more than one year officer a six digit identification system, was adopted about one year ago for stamping machines sold since that time.

WEBER stated that from the appearance of the identification number in question it is his opinion, that the garments have not been laundered or cleaned since the said numbers were attached to the garment. These numbers are not permanent as a new number is attached to each garment on each occasion that it is cleaned.

WEBER stated that he believes that due to the nature of the garment that they were cleaned in a laundry rather than a drive-in establishment.

He stated that there/some wholesale laundries which perform the actual cleaning operation for several smaller and independent laundries and attached the appropriate identification number for the respective laundry to each garment in which case the letter which indicates the first letter of the name of the laundry, with which the customer is doing busines would be of no significance.

WEBER stated that he could attach no significance for identification purposes to the defect of a partial digit on the tape as shown in the photo color as this could be corrected when discovered by a simple mechanical adjustment on the machine.

WEBER pointed out that a record as to whom the machines were sold would not be conclusive as they are frequently resold by the original purchasers without the knowledge of the manufacturer.

WEBER suggested that a current list of the identities of laundry supply distributors to which identification tape for use in his machines is being sold by Textile Marking Machines Company at Syracuse, New York, would be of value in determining the names of laundries that are using the machines in question at the present time thereby expediting instant investigation.

JOSEPH AUSTIN LOUW, 45 Tiemann Place, New York, New York, telephone number 663-1283, advised he is employed by Public Broadcast Laboratory of National Educational Television, 342 Madison Avenue, New York City, as an Assistant Producer.

He further advised that he went to Memphis, Tennessee on April 1, 1968, and registered at the Lorraine Motel. He occupied Room 309. The purpose of this trip was to set the ground work for a documentary which his company was to film concerning the poor peoples campaign. This documentary was receiving the full cooperation of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. Dr. KING was to be the main subject in this documentary. He was the only individual from his company at Memphis at this time because it was not known if a march scheduled for April 8, 1968, being led by Dr. KING was to be held. If the march was to go on as scheduled, then a filming crew from his company was to come down that prior weekend and film excerpts of the march as well as other areas of Memphis.

He advised that on April 4, 1968, at approximately 5:00 pm, he went to a restaurant located at Butler and Mulberry Streets and had his dinner. This restaurant is located close to the Lorraine Motel. At about 5:30 pm, he left the restaurant and walked back to the motel and went directly to his room 309. At this time, Dr. KING was located in Room 306. The atmosphere around the motel at this time was quiet and he did not notice any police cars in the area or any spectators. On entering his room, he turned on the television set to the Huntley-Brinkley News Report. Excerpts from Dr. KING's speech from the prior night were just being completed on this show. At this time, he placed a telephone call to New York City to a JULIE KINNARD, 510 West 110th Street, New York City, telephone number 866-9906. He spoke with her and listened to the news at the same time. He hung up the phone just as the Huntley-Brinkley News Report was ending. He went over to the television set and turned down the volume. At this

moment, he heard a loud noise outside of the motel room. He went to the door of his room, opened it, and turned to the right, in the direction of Dr. KING's room and noticed Dr. KING falling to the ground, and his head about to reach the pavement. He saw Dr. ABERNATHY turn to Dr. KING and ABERNATHY raised his/hands and had an amazed look on his face. He ran to where Dr. KING was lying and when he saw the blood, his first impulse was to try to stop it with his hand. He saw the wound and knew that because of its size, he would be unable to stop the blood. At this time, Dr. ABERNATHY had a towel and placed it over the wound of Dr. KING.

He further advised that he noticed JESSIE JACKSON, a member of the staff of Dr. KING, running down the corridor in a crouched position. Only then did he realize that the individual who shot Dr. KING might be still at the location and he then crouched down so that he would not also be a target. While in a crouched position he went back to his motel room and got his cameras, which were loaded with film. He came out of his room and began taking pictures of the scene where Dr. KING had been shot. He believes he took between 90 and 100 still photographs. After the ambulance had taken the body of Dr. KING away, he went down to the ground level of the motel and noticed the police running in different directions. He followed some of the policemen because he thought that he might be able to get exclusive pictures of the police arresting the individual who shot Dr. KING. It was while he was following the police that he heard over one of the police radios that the police weres chasing a white Mustang. This was the only time he heard any mention of a white Mustang and he had never seen one in the area prior to the shooting of Dr. KING.

He stated that after he had taken four rolls of pictures he took the undeveloped film over to a photographer friend of his, ERNEST WITHERS, whose studiosis located on Beale Street, Memphis, and asked him if he might be able to develop the pictures that he took in order to see the WITHERS was on the phone at the time he entered the shop and was speaking either to the Memphis Police Department or the Federal Bureau of Investigation, telling them about a RAYMOND ALEXANDER (phonetic), and that ALEXANDER should be checked out as a possible suspect in the killing of Dr. KING because ALEXANDER was a segregationalist and a schizophrenic. He developed the film and saw his results and called his company in New York, who told him to immediately return to New York with the pictures: that he had taken. These pictures were sold to Life Magazine and several of them appear in the April 12 issue of the magazine.

He further advised he called WITHERS two days after the assassination and told him that he wished to pay him for the use of his facilities in developing the film. He asked WITHERS at this time if he had heard anything concerning the results of the investigation concerning ALEXANDER and he was told that ALEXANDER had an alibi at the time of the assassination.

He stated that he had spoken to Dr. KING after Dr. KING had arrived at Memphis concerning the filming of the documentary and Dr. KING never made mention of any threats that were made on his life while in Memphis. The only threat that he, LOUW, heard was that made by the police commissioner of Memphis when he stated that if the march, which was led by Dr. KING on April 8 went off as scheduled, someone might be injured because the Ku Klux Klan was scheduled to hold a rally simultaneously with the march.

He stated that on the morning of the assassination, HONEA WILLIAMS, a member of the staff of Dr. KING told some young Negro militants who were occupying the Room 315, that they would have to move out because the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC) would no longer pay their motel bills for occupying that room.

LORNEL EDMUND ANDERSON, 1112 Mc Millan Avenue, Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, Canada, was contacted at the Port Authority Police Office, 40th Street and 8th Avenue, and was immediately made aware of the identity of the interviewing agent. ANDERSON stated that he did not have any objection to coming to the New York Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, 201 East 69th Street, New York City.

ANDERSON was taken to the New York Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and at this time stated that he was a student at the University of Montana located at Missoula, Montana. He left school approximately two months ago and went to California to visit some friends. The first date that he could recall is March 24 and 25 when he stayed in Venice, California. He left there on March 25 and went to Los Angeles, California. He left Los Angeles on March 28 and when to San Francisco. He stayed in San Francisco for several days and went to Lake Tahoe. Nevada, staying there a few days and then went to Reno, He had hitchhiked his entire trip. On April33, while in Reno, he was picked up by the Police Department and charged with disorderly conduct. He was subsequently fingerprinted and taken before a Magistrate and spent the night in jail. He was released at approximately 7:00 am on the morning of April 4. He went immediately to Lake Tahoe, Nevada, hitchhiking all the way. He remained there until April 7 and started hitchhiking across country taking the southern route, going through the towns of Barsto, California, Albuquerque, New Mexico, Amarillo, Texas, St. Louis, Missouri and the state of West Virginia, and subsequently arriving in New York City on the morning of April 16. On the evening of April 16, he went to the Port Authority Building, New York City, to clean up and also to sleep in the waiting room located in the building.





The following investigation was conducted by SA FREDERICK F. DALY at Staten Island, N.Y:







On 4/17/68, Mrs. SUSANN PEROSI, 67 Marianne St., Staten Island, New York, advised she observed OSCAR STUBBS when he made arrangements with Mrs. HELDER to the rental of a room at this address, and noticed his similarity to the newspaper sketch of the suspect in the KING case. She described him as male, white, about 50 years of age, slender, about 5'll", with light hair and receding hairline and Southern accent. The Bureau's sketches of the suspect were exhibited to Mrs. PEROSI and she said he was definitely not identical with the individual departed in these sketches.

On 4/17/68, Mr. MICHAEL ADINOLFI, Manager, Michaels Shoe Store, 1563 Forest Avenue, advised that OSCAR STUBBS has been employed by him as a salesman for the past six months. Sketches of the suspect were exhibited to him and he said that STUBBS is not identical. He also pointedout STUBBS and it was noted that he is at least 50 years of age, 5'll", slender build, about 160 pounds, with light sandy hair, and a pronounced receding hairling. STUBBS bore no resemblance to the artist's conceptions of the suspect in instant case.




