The Hunt for James Earl Ray

The FBI's failure to apprehend the assassin of Dr. Martin Luther King has led to reports that J. Edgar Hoover is not interested in catching the murderer. The reports are based partly on the fact that Hoover and King were not on good terms, Hoover having publicly branded King as "the most notorious liar in the world."

We have checked into the operations of the FBI in this respect and are convinced that it is conducting perhaps the most painstaking, exhaustive manhunt ever before undertaken in the U. S. Its G-men have checked every bar ever patronized by James Earl Ray, every flophouse he ever stopped at, every cantina in Mexico he ever visited. It has collected an amazing array of evidence, all linking Ray with the murder.

That he has not been found may be due to the possibility that he himself was murdered by those who hired him to kill King, or that he is hiding in some remote Mexican village.

If he has money—and apparently he has—Ray might be able to live in a distant part of Mexico indefinitely. The Mexico City police are efficient and cooperative, but police in the remote areas are not.

What the FBI has established about King's assassin was that he was a professional killer who had studied the suspense writing of Ian Fleming and Ayn Rand.

* * *

All the evidence points to the probability that Ray was hired to kill Dr. King. He broke out of the Missouri State Penitentiary on April 23, 1967, after boasting to fellow prisoners that he intended to make a big "score" on the outside, that he might try to collect a \$1 million bounty supposedly offered by a "business men's group" for the death of Dr. King.

Four months later, on Aug. 30, 1967, he opened a safe deposit box in the Birmingham Trust National Bank and began passing out crisp \$20 bills like a big spender. He paid \$499 for dancing instruction.

He shelled out money for a bartending course,

but showed no interest in working behind any bar. He also took a course in lock-picking from a correspondence school in Michigan. His white Mustang cost \$1,995, which he paid in cash.

Occasionally he slipped \$20 to bar girls and prostitutes. In Mexico he lived with a prostitute in small towns like Jalisco and Puerto Vallarta where prices were cheap. In Los Angeles, he advertised in the hippie newspaper that he would like to meet "a passionate married woman." He paid \$1 to the Swinger's Club for the names and addresses of five girls.

All told, Ray spent an estimated \$10,000 in seven months. Yet he never held a job.

* * *

It seems likely that Ray planned the murder of Dr. King for several months. He finally purchased the Remington rifle in Birmingham on March 30, then moved to a boarding house in Atlanta. In his room, agents found a map of Atlanta with four locations circled.

They were Dr. King's residence, his headquarters at the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, Ray's boarding house and the spot where he abandoned his Mustang after the murder. In the middle of the map was also a clear thumbprint from Ray's right thumb.

Evidently, Ray changed his mind about way-laying King in Atlanta and followed him to Memphis instead.

If white extremists put up the blood money it was probably not the Ku Klux Klan or the Minute Men, for they are an impatient lot who would not have waited for several months for Ray to get results. Black extremists have also not been ruled out. They might have sought to get rid of King in order to remove the prophet of nonviolence.

Note: Ray was the product of a broken home. He was the eldest of eight children. His father deserted Ray's mother, and various people adopted the children. When the FBI approached the father, they discovered that the elder Ray had not seen his son for 17 years.

In recent check of the Dale Carnegie Institute at Birmingham, Birmingham was advised that records of all people enrolled in the Dale Carnegie self-improvement courses are maintained at New York City. It is noted that subject, JAMES EARL RAY, is described as an introverted individual who prefers to be by himself. Yet the investigation shows that he has enrolled in at least two dancing courses and a bartenders school, in which he was compelled to mix with other people. It was further noted that RAY sought professional help in Los Angeles to overcome his "shyness" and his tendency to be an introvert.

It is suggested that the Bureau consider having the records of the Dale Carnegie Institute and similar type institutions checked to ascertain if the subject was formerly enrolled or is currently enrolled in a self-improvement or confidence gaining type course.

Mrs. ANITA BINSSE, 377 Ocean Parkway, Apartment C-12, Brooklyn, NY, was interviewed at her residence by SAS JOHN BRADSHAW, JR. and JAMES E. SNIEGOCKI.

She advised that she is divorced from ALFRED RADEWITZ, a cabinet-maker who resides at RFD, Valatia, Columbia County, NY, telephone (518) 384-4353. Her daughter, BARBARA RADEWITZ, is 21 years old and resides with her former husband. Her daughter occasionally visits her in NYC.

Mrs. BINSSE said that on Friday, April 5, 1968, she and her daughter went into NYC and visited the "Electric Circus" in Greenwich Village. During the course of the evening, they engaged in a conversation with an unknown male who said his name was "JERRY." She said that JERRY was dressed shabily, with a leather vest and dungarees. She described him as 5'7", medium build, sallow complexion, dirty blond hair. She said that "JERRY" talked constantly of civil rights and the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. Although he was suppose to be a supporter of the civil rights movement, he expressed the idea that Dr. KING "had to be killed." He likened the assassination to the Crucifixion of Christ.

She advised that JERRY gave both her and her daughter a ride to her apartment on Ocean Parkway at about 4:30 am. He drove a very dirty brown or beige Mustang. He seemed to be educated and said that he was formerly a seaman. He told Mrs. BINSSE and her daughter that he was employed by IBM in NYC. *44-1609588*

Mrs. BINSSE advised that she thought nothing of the above incident until she read the publicity about the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING. Inasmuch as "JERRY" said he was a seaman and he drove a Mustang, she called the FBI.

Mrs. BINSSE was exhibited the artists conception photos of the suspect in instant case. She said that the artists composite sketch from Birmingham was definitely not the individual she knows as "JERRY." The artist's composite sketch from Memphis, she advised, contains physical similarities to "JERRY", but she could not say whether it is or is not the suspect.

Mrs. BINSSE suggested that the FBI contact her daughter and exhibit the photos since her daughter spent much time dancing with JERRY throughout the night.

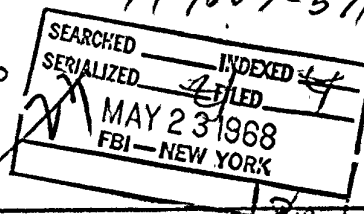

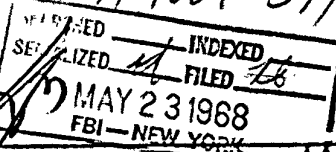

NY 5772-C made available the attached material which this informant obtained from LOUISE R. MOORE. According to the source who furnished this material on May 24, 1968 the piece of yellow ruled pad paper is in MOORE'S handwriting. The typewritten matter is the usual distributive in which MOORE indulges and is loaded with her old title of "Black Youth Internationale" with herself as editor. According to the source MOORE is in communication on a regular basis with the Progressive Labor Party at 336 Lenox Avenue, New York, N.Y. and receives a large volume of printed material some of which she plagiarizes and puts out under her own name. NY 5772-S said that MOORE is "some kind of a nut". She is a sort of "psycho" and is a person who perspires profusely. The typewritten material which is dated February 21, 1968 is entitled "Memorial To Malcolm" and commemorated the third anniversary of his death.

A paragraph at the bottom of the first page reads ,

"In the name of Malcolm and his memory, it is the duty of everyone to stop King and his plot to kill off black people this summer. Write letters, telephone make some kind of contact to stop this hired killer."

Apparently this paragraph refers to the late MARTIN LUTHER KING who was assassinated on April 4, 1968.
