Shortly before reaching the Earlsboro exit on Interstate 40,
a young man in a black convertible Mustang passed him at a
high rate of speed. He stated as the Mustang passed, he noted
the license number to be Hines County, Mississippi tag HB931/
After noticing the Mustang bore a Mississippi license, he
passed the car in order to get a futher look at the occupant.
He noticed that the occupant had a long sharp nose and
resembled the artist's conception of the murderer of KING,
which he had recently seen in an Oklahoma City newspaper.

Here stated that shortly after passing this individual ne pulled off the Earlsboro exit and the subject also pulled off the exit and pulled into a cafe located! on the right hand side of the exit. The subject parked behind a service station located adjacent to the restaurant, even though parking space was available in front of the restaurant. Reverend Here stated he had driven past the restaurant but returned and parked near the motel adjacent to the restaurant and walked by the window of the restaurant in order to obtain a closer view of the Subject.

He described the subject as about 27 to 28 years of age; 5' 10" to 6'; 165 to 170 pounds, short dark hair which was windblown at the time. Subject was dressed in green trousers and a lighter green shirt, which appeared to be uniform type work clothes. He observed the Subject was in the restaurant for only a few minutes, left the restaurant and got in his car, and proceeded east on Interstate 40.

He stated he realizes subject may have been suspicious of him since he made a point of looking at him as he passed him on the Interstate and may have followed Reverend Hoff the Interstate out of curiosity. He stated that in view of the fact the subject had a sharp rather long pointed nose, he felt the FBI might want this information.





On 4/15/68, J. H. Chief, Beneficiary Control Section, Medical Administration Division, Veterans Administration Hospital (VAH),
Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, personally advised SA G. M. that one W. had been admitted to VAH at 4:00 A.M., 4/14/68 for examination relative to Myro Cardiac Infraction, after first having been brought to St. Anthony's Hospital. Oklahoma City.
DR. F. W. and nurse, Miss D. attended him at the time of admission.

At the time of admission, James Wall Medical Administration Assistant, wrote out a report of contact dated 4/14/68 which shows in part, "Though there might be little evidence to be of major concern, Mr. Gallottold the Nurse and Dr. Will on that the day Dr. King was shot in Memphis, Tenn. he was there and has a large bruised area on his chest to show for a scuffle that ensued."

Mr. How pointed out that he thought that this information may be of interest to the FBI. Mr. How provided one xerox copy each of "Report of Contact" as prepared by J. W. And "Application for Hospital Treatment or Domiciliary Care" dated 4/14/68 over the signature of WALTER S. GOGOL which latter document sets forth background regarding GOGOL who alledges to be a veteran. These copies are being made attachments to this memorandum.

Mr. F. advised that on 4/15/68, it was telephonically determined through Veterans Administration at Cleveland, Ohio that W. G. born at Lynn, Massachusetts has VA claim #C 11080340, that he served in the military from 6/10/42 to 11/19/45 and that he is drawing benefits from the VA, however this amount was not confirmed in the call to Cleveland.

Further, on 4/15/68, SA_6 made personal contact with W in the presence of J which time H advised that his permanent address is Cleveland, Ohio, that he left home 4/4/68in his personally owned vehicle which he described as a 1967 Chevrolet, bearing 1968 Ohio license AG 1321. He stated that en route, he stopped at a roadside reststop to the east side of Angolia, Ohio where he said he was attacked from behind by two Negro males, age about 18 and 22, whom he could not further describe. He stated these Negroes had beaten him about the chest and legs and broke his glasses and left him lying face down in a dazed condition at the roadway, near his car. He said they stole over \$200 from him which he had rolled up his one of his trouser pockets. He said they drove off in what he thought was a 1956 Buick. G said he did not report this incident to any law enforcement agency because he was mainly interested in getting out of that area. He said he proceeded to Chicago, Illinois where he spent Saturday and Sunday nights, 4/5 and 6/68, with a cousin, D Chicago, Illinois.

He said that he had intensions when leaving Cleveland to go to El Paso, Texas. IrFnom Chicago, he arrived in Oklahoma City, 4/11/68 where he checked into the YMCA on Northwest 5th Street, where his car is currently located at a parking lot at that location.

He said that early Sunday morning, 4/14/68, he began to feel very uncomfortable in the area of his left chest, that he had taken about 4 ozs. of brandy to relieve what he thought may have been conjection. He said the situation did not improve, that he was taken by an ambulance first to St. Anthony's hospital and then transferred to V.

said that he has never been in Memphis, Tennessee, that in fact he has never been in the state of Tennessee and stated that he knows nothing concerning the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. and that he said that upon admission to the VAH or at least that he meant to say that upon admission to VAH, that he had been beaten about the chest on the same date of the assassination in Memphis, Tennessee. He did not mean



THE FEI DIRECTOR SAID THAT CALT, WHO HAS USED THE MAMES OF JOHN WILLARD AND MARVEY LOWMYER IN THE FAST, IS THE OWNER OF A 1966 WHITE MUSTANG BEARING ALABAMA LICENSE FLATES WHICH WAS LOCATED AFANDONED IN ATLANTA, GEORGIA, ON APRIL 11, 1968. INVESTIBATION DISCLOSED THAT GALT FURCHASED THIS CAR FROM A PRIVATE CITIZEN IN EIRMINGHAM ON AUGUST 30, 1967. THE MUSTANG'S OLOMETER SHOWED THAT IT HAD BEEN DRIVEN MORE THAN 19,000 MILES BETWEEN LATE AUGUST, 1967, AND EARLY APRIL, 1968.

ACCORDING TO MR. 





A Federal complaint was filed by the FBI in Birmingham, Alabama, on 4/17/68 charging ERIC STARVO GALT with conspiring to violate the civil rights of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. JR., in violation of Title 18, Section 241, of the United States Code.

ERIC STARVO GALT obtained a drivers license in Albama in 1967 and the drivers license describes him as white, male, born 5' 11", 175 lbs, blue eyes and brown hair.

Memphis has instructed that all licensed drivers with birth date of except those that can be eliminated as obvious non-idents be located and appropriate investigation conducted to determine if they are identical with ERIC STARVO GALT. In those cases where the individual cannot be eliminated through other means, attempts should be made to obtain fingerprints for latent comparison by the Identification Division.

An actual photograph of GALT has been received from the Bureau and copies of the photograph are being made to furnish all Agents. A memorandum is also being prepared for all Agents setting forth all information known to this office regarding GALT's activities and whereabouts which will assist in the handling of leads in this case.




