On the morning of Saturday, April 20, 1968 Sheriff Russell Watters, Wapello County Sheriff's Office, Ottumwa, Iowa telephonically contacted the writer at his residence and advised the Wapello County Sheriff's Office had just arrested The man, according to Sheriff Watters, a man for vagrancy. was similar in appearance to JAMES EARL RAY. Sheriff WATTERS stated he definitely did not feel that the individual he had under arrest was RAY, but he stated there is a remote possibility that he is RAY.

The furnished the name of the individual in question as WILLIAM IRVIN LATHAM, white male American, born at Atlanta, Georgia. We further described LATHAM as 11", 145 lbs., brownimh-grey hair, and hazel eyes.

SAS L. JOSEPH HERSLEY and E. ARTHUR RIEGE immediately proceeded to Ottumwa, Iowa. LATHAM was interviewed in detail and his fingerprints were taken by buagents.

On the same date, 4-20-68, Detective Robert Penland, Des Moines, Iowa Police Department classified the fingerprints of WILLIAM IRVIN LATHAM and compared the classification to that of the fingerprints of JAMES EARL RAY. Detective Penland stated WILLIAM IRVIN LATHAM is positively not identical to JAMES EARL RAY.

The following description and background information was obtained regarding LATHAM through observation and interview:



On 4/23/68 OMAR H. (Pete) ADLER. Credit Consultant. Thorp Credit Corp. Mt. Pleasant, Iowa advised that on 4/20/68 he was attending an auction at Keokuk, Iowa which was held and sponsered by the Thorp Auction Corp. During this auction he noticed an individual who resembled JAMES EARL RAY. Adler stated that on the morning of the 20th, he had read the newspaper accounts of Ray's description and hometown of EWING, ILL. and that it was fresh in his mind when he observed the individual in question. Adler stated that at 12:30 PM the man came walking into the sale area and browsed in a highly suspicious manner, carefully avoiding contact with the other customers and speaking to no one. Adler approached this individual on one ocassion and attempted to start a conversation but was rebuffed in a very curt manner by the suspectwho ignored him. The individual left the auction at approximately 2:30 PM, and Adler did not see him drive a car away. Adler indicated that he had never seen the man before but that he highly resembled the 1959 photo of JAMES EARL RAY, and fit the description as listed except that the man he saw had shorter hair, described by Adler as a "Hollywood Butch" cut.

The flyer listed RAY's number as 00416, listed him as 35, 5'll, 163 lbs, brown hair and blue eyes. It showed that he was born in Illinois, a resident of St. Louis and a Baker by trade. It listed a Grandmother as MARY MAHER, 1903 Hickory, St. Louis, a Brother, JOHN RAY, 1918 Park Ave,. St. Louis, and another brother, JERRY W. RAY, Wheeling, Illinois.

This is all well and good however, the FBI # was shown as 306443A and the fingerprints shown on the card are not identical with the ones on 10 #4182. The ones on the flyer are not too clear and the subsecondary could be in question; however, the FPC is 18 L 1 U III 15 and this is

a long way from the 16 M 9 U ooo 12 and FBI # 505942 G shown on IO M 4 W IOI

4182. There is no question that the prints on the Missouri flyer are not identical to those on the IO as I checked them myself.

If this has not been straightened out at the Bureau it could cause some confusion as in the case of the NSP they now have two stops on both sets of fingerprints and connot say they are identical. There is, of course, a logical explanation that the Missouri flyer in 1967, which was printed in the Pen had the wrong prints placed on it but this should be corrected and all states having a stop similar to Nebraska's advised of the correction and some explanation shown. The photograph on the Missouri stop is the same as used on the recent Bureau stops.





Re: James Milton Curtis Oshel Threat Against 1968 Presidential Candidate Robert F. Kennedy, Fremont, Nebraska, April 24, 1968

Captain Francis L. Hurt, Fremont, Nebraska Police Department, furnished the following information relating to Oshel, a deaf mute, arrested at Fremont 8:00 p.m., April 24, 1968, following complaint that Oshel had circulated a note among patrons at Woody's Bar in downtown Fremont, bearing a reference to the killing of 1968 Presidential Candidate, Senator Robert F. Kennedy of New York, whose campaign train was scheduled for a whistle stop at Fremont at 6:00 p.m., Saturday, April 27, 1968.

Oshel had been drinking but did not appear to be intoxicated. Interviewed by the Fremont Police Department with assistance of an interpreter proficient in the Manual Alphabet, Oshel denied any knowledge of or even having seem before, what appeared to be a portion of a Kraft type paper bag found in his possession when arrested and bearing the following separate handwritten items: "Deaf I can kill Robert F Kenne - Kennedy," "Can Kill Robert F. Kennedy," and "Assain." Although Oshel refused to write these words in the same order, he did furnish handwritten specimens of the individual words, including the misspelled word "assain" which, it was determined, he understood to mean "assassinate." It was the opinion of Captain Hurt and of Dodge County Attorney Richard L. Kulhman, who participated in the interview of Oshel, that his handwriting specimens bore resemblance to the handwriting on the note.

Mr. Kuhlman expressed his opinion that the circumstances suggest that in the event an actual threat were involved, it would more likely be that Oshel was seeking an offer to "kill Kennedy" for hire than that he planned to do so on his own initiative.
