Re Savannah airtel to Bureau, 5/21/68, and memo of SA WOODRUFF, 5/29/68.

The following investigation was conducted by SA DEAN M. HOWEN at Oak Hill, W. Va., on 5/31/68:

Sgt. W. A. GOSNELL, WVASP, and Chief of Police ROBERT MURDOCK were alerted concerning 1968 Alabama license 27-17864 on a 1959 Pontiac or on a green Chrysler product car, to advise if noted.

Observation of the grounds of the James H. Drew Exposition at Oak Hill and general area failed to locate any vehicle or license as above.

HENRY WRIGHT, office manager, James H. Drew Exposition, advised he has no record or knowledge of a WALLACE GREATHOUSE as an employee and no one by that name is on the payroll; however, GREATHOUSE could work for a concession, which are independent. He said he knew of only one young couple traveling with the show from Alabama, and they are from Birmingham, and he is a small fellow with dark hair. WRIGHT could not identify photo of RAY.

Mr. WRIGHT said the show is presently split, with part now at Bristol, Virginia; that JAMES H. DREW is presently at Bristol, but the entire show will be combined and be set up at Bluefield, W. Va., to open 6/3/68. He suggested Mr. DREW be contacted at Bluefield on 6/3/68 when the entire show is together for further efforts to locate and identify GREATHOUSE.

Observation of all ride and concession employees did not reveal anyone who resembled subject.

Only one Alabama license was observed in the area. 27-18180, on a 1960 green Valiant, operated by a white male, age 25, 5'7", 135 lbs., dark brown hair, accompanied by a white female, early 20's, light brown short hair.



ON SIX THREE INSTANT, AZEL BRYANT, COMMANDER, INVESTIGATIVE UNIT, HUNTINGTON PD, STATED HIS RECORDS REFLECTED A MISSING PERSONS REPORT FOR JAMES FORD HEDGE, SEVEN THREE SEVEN SEVENTH STREET, HUNTINGTON, W. VA., IN AUGUST, NINETEEN SIXTYSIX. HE STATED A BODY WAS RECOVERED ON ONE TWENTYTHREE SIXTYSEVEN, IN A DUMP OUTSIDE HUNTINGTON CITY LIMITS, IN WAYNE COUNTY, W. VA. HE STATED INVESTIGATION BY HIS DEPARTMENT REVEALED THAT IN ALL PROBABILITY, UNIDENTIFIED BODY WAS THAT OF HEDGE. HE STATED AN AUTOPSY WAS MADE, WHICH REFLECTED NO METAL PLATE IN THE HEAD OF UNIDENTIFIED BODY. 

ALLEN said he is an artist and works for Horne's and that is why he noticed this resemblance. He did not notice if the man's ear protruded.

On 5/29/68. ROGER PHILLIPS, Deputy Coroner, Allegheny County Morgue, Pittsburgh, Pa. advised that they have not had any unidentified male dead who could possibly be identical with JAMES EARL RAY. PHILLIPS advised that he would be on the alert for such a body and an ID on RAY was left with him. He said he would contact the office immediately if he gets any possible identification.

Re Cincinnati teletype to Bureau 6/20/68.

On 5/21/68, Mrs. ANN JACOBSON, 434 Robb Avenue, Johnstown, Pa., advised SAs EARL W. GALLOWAY and JOHN S. HUGHES that for the past three weeks she has been doing domestic work for a DONALD SHAFFER and a Mrs. HELEN STANCE, at 446 Somerset Street, Johnstown, Pa. She explained that SHAFFER and STANCE are not married, but are living together; that SHAFFER is a local contractor and that he has several employees working for him who meet at the residence of 446 Somerset Street, each morning prior to going out on a particular contracting job.

Mrs. JACOBSON initially denied making any statement to anyone that the "killer of MARTIN LUTHER KING" was in any way connected with SHAFFER or his contracting group. She then advised that she might have made a statement that SHAFFER could be the killer of MARTIN LUTHER KING inasmuch as he drinks excessively and has made statements that he could see nothing wrong with KING's assassination. Mrs. JACOBSON stated that all of SHAFFER's workmen are in their late teens or early 20's; that none of them look like JAMES EARL RAY, but that SHAFFER bears some slight resemblance to the subject.

On 5/22/68, Detective HAROLD BERKEYBILE, Police Department, Johnstown, Pa., advised that he is personally acquainted with SHAFFER; that SHAFFER has been a fly-by-night contractor in Johnstown for many years; that one of SHAFFER's employees is his brother, JOSEPH, and that SHAFFER could not in any way be identical to JAMES EARL RAY.

On 6/4/68, WILLIAM C. DOERR, U. S. Postal Inspector, Charleston, West Va., advised that he recalls the investigation of RICHARD STANLEY and from records he stated that this was handled out of Washington, D.C. He stated it was a December 1966 case and was conducted on a complaint received from the Charleston, West Virginia, Police Department that STANLEY was molesting small girls and that he was writing and sending them obscene cards and letters.

Mr. DOERR checked his files and stated that RICHARD STANLEY called his little operation the Iris Girls Club. His sole purpose was to get little girls involved with him. The file indicated that STANLEY is a mental case and is very peculiar. He is about 60 years of age and has been employed for many years in the press room of The Charleston Gazette, Charleston, West Va., where he was last known to have been employed in 1966.

Mr. DOERR said that STANLEY resides at Route 2, Box 276B (Loudendale) Charleston, West Va., with relatives and he is not married. He said that STANLEY's only operated locally and that he was the only man involved but that the local police had investigated him because he allegedly had attempted to molest small girls.

Mr. DOERR said he does not know what disposition was made of this case and further details would have to come from Washington.
