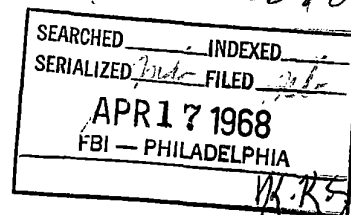

This lot number would go up to 20 and then a new lot number would be started which would be 1B-1. During a period of time and depending on the volume of customers would be the factor determining how many people may have the same number assigned to them. It is to be noted that each time a customer brought in new laundry he would have a new number.

It is to be noted that a sample from his machine could not be obtained because the machine was inoperative and needed a special attachment for the air hose which he did not have.

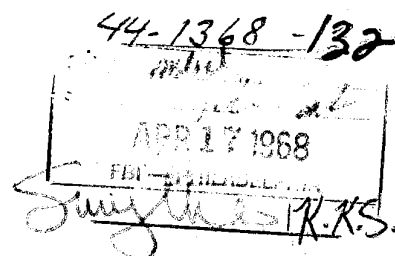
