type machine as he considered it an unsatisfactory machine and
even attempted to sue Textile Marking Machine Co., Syracuse,
New York.

He made his records available and they reflected he traded this machine to KrynxMawr Best Equipment Co., 2243 Bryn Mawr Ave., Phila., Pa. on 4/26/67. The serial # for this machine was 33766 and the model # was H5S4B1.

He stated when he used this machine he used the following code:

The first number would be a lot number. This number would start with 1 and go up to 10. The letter would follow

number. Example 1A would be the beginning of the first lot and this lot number would go as high as 10A then the lot number would be changed to 1B. A different color of tape would be used for the new lot. The last number following the letter would be the bundle number. This number would go as high as 99. Example - number 1A-1 would the beginning of a new lot and bundle. This humber would go as high as 10A-99.

No customer was ever assigned a permanent number.

He stated that he would be unable to determine to whom a specific number was assigned to as he did not have these slips available as he did not use the machine any longer.

He stated that depending on the volume of work done by a laundry would determine how frequent and how many different people would have the same number assigned to them during a specific period of time.







This lot number would go up to 20 and then a new lot number would be started which would be IB-1. During a period of time and depending on the volume of customers would be the factor determining how many people may have the same number assigned to them. It is to be noted that each time a customer brought in new laundry he would have a new number.
