"HE DIDN'T say much about his family affairs, only that he was divorced. He only talked about the weather, never about politics or racial problems."

Cherpes said he agreed shortly after Galt had moved into the boarding house to go with him downtown to take a driver's test.

Cherpes said in September Galt received a prepaid package in the mail from Chicago. The package weighed about 25 pounds and was about 2 feet long and a foot wide, Cherpes said.

The following day, Galt told the landlord he had received the wrong package and was re-turning it. "About a half hour later I saw him carrying the box to his car."

IN OCTOBER, Galt paid Cherpes a week's rent in ad vance, then left, saying he was going to Mobile, Ala., to seek a job. Galt told Cherpes he would not return, but was, expecting a letter from Chicago and wanted him to hold it.

Cherpes said he never saw Galt again.



Five of these tapes have the same length (1 1/16 inches) as Q69 and Q70. The other nine are longer, either 1 3/32 inches or 1 1/8 inches in length.

The K8 and K9 tapes were found to differ in printing from the tapes appearing on Q69 and Q70.

The tapes comprising K10 are of varying lengths; however, no significant differences were noted between the Q69 and Q70 laundry tapes when compared with some of the K10 tapes indicating they may have originated from the same machine.

Specimens K8, K9 and K10 are retained.


