PATTERSON that on 4/22/68 two white males in a 1961 or 1962 white Chevrolet Impala bearing Louisiana license, number unknown, purchased gas and tires in the amount of \$42.28 at PLYLER's Gulf Station in Bartow, using Gulf Credit Card # [REDACTED] in the name of S. G. STEINER, address not recalled in Louisiana. One of the men who was wearing cowboy hat and cowboy boots signed the purchase slip with the name, JAMES HAMMONS. He stated he was from Oklahoma and had just arrived in the area to work with a core drilling outfit. PLYLER discovered that HAMMONS left the area immediately after the purchase, and there are no drillers in the area. Also, this credit card had been cancelled about one week prior to 4/22/68.

On 5/2/68, PLYLER read in a newspaper that JAMES EARL RAY had an associate from New Orleans, La., named STEIN and similarities in names, STEIN and STEINER, caused him to conclude that HAMMONS may have been RAY. He could not recall descriptions of the man with HAMMONS, other than he was a white male with a "fat face." PLYLER said he recorded license number of the Chevrolet on the purchase slip, but no longer has record of the number as the slip has been forwarded to Gulf Oil Company Headquarters in Philadelphia, Pa. King's Slaying a Conspiracy Justice Department Believes

WASHINGTON — THE FBI's central Martin Luther King desk, under the personal direction of J. Edgar Hoover, is operating on the hard theory that the Negro leader was the victim of a conspiracy of "several or more persons."

There are those high in the Justice Department, therefore, who believe that Eric Starvo Galt-James Earl Ray was a hired killer, heavily paid and amply supplied with cash. Most of this was in \$20 bills. Evidence is piling up inside the Bureau to justify investigation of a conspiracy beyond Galt and a man he said was his brother. This evidence moves the case swiftly beyond the conjectures of amateur detectives and dilettante criminologists.

Part of the evidence is the provable free flow of cash (some \$7000) Galt-Ray was able to pour out whenever he wished. In addition to the white Mustang, the dance lessons and the bartenders school fee, the accused assassin crisscrossed this country in a manner no poor man could. The car has 19,000 miles on its speedometer.

Whether or not he drove, he is known to have lived well in cities so distant from each other that Galt-Ray would have had to have traveled more than 15,000 miles in the last nine or ten months.

Whoever planned his itinerary, his make-up, his aliases, had a novelist's imagination. Ray, for example, is (or was) a James Bond fan. "Eric Starvo" are the letters which

characters. The name "Galt" was contrived by novelist Ayn Rand, who fashioned the "John Galt" in "Atlas Shrugged" after the late John Gall, one of the most prestigious of capital attorneys and once a power in the iron and steel industry. So the pseudonym, apparently not the creation of an illiterate, reflects a smooth fellow, suave and dynamic and a leader of men.

NO one in the FBI or the Justice Department, despite weeks of questioning, would conjecture over the nature of the conspiratorial cell. It could be Klan-like. But it could be northern as well as southern.

The conspirators could be in Southern Mississippi, Chicago or even out of the country.

One thing is certain. There's been a fantastic search. For example, every "John Willard" (Galt's Memphis boarding-house alias) in the U. S. has been checked out.

Investigators don't put much stock in the interpretation that because Galt-Ray frequented Atlanta and Birmingham the conspiracy was centered in the deep South. The probers believe that the white car and the Remington rifle were purchased and planted in such a manner that the leads would point southward.

Galt-Ray had Chicago connections of some kind, it's believed. There is obvious evidence and there are leads which the authorities grimly refuse to discuss. The obvious

are the letters which

Eric Starvo Galt resided in Chicago while living in the Birmingham rooming house.

The Bureau and the Justice Department, as well as Attorney General Ramsey Clark, are silent because they think too much has been said already.

THIS is the second biggest manhunt in the history—second only to the probe of the John Kennedy assassination when each of the Bureau's 6000 agents was involved in some fashion.

Where is Galt-Ray? Of course he can be on any continent. But the prevailing Justice Department theory now is that the killer is in some tiny hamlet or village—so small that big town dailies just aren't followed closely by all the residents.

So, the Federals now are preparing to get the sniper's photo into those isolated clusters of rural communities.

One thing is certain: The Justice Department believes it has evidence leading to a conspiracy.

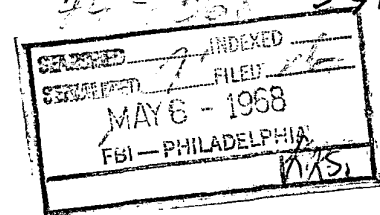

Detective KENNETH SWEIKERT, Reading, Pa. Police Department advised 5/1/68, both their regular fingerprint men are off duty. He stated Detective ANTHONY O'REILLY will next be on duty 5/3/68, and Detective MICHAEL DEMARCO will return to duty 5/6/68.

Trooper JAMES RUCCO, Bureau of Criminal Identification, Pennsylvania State Police, Reading, Pa. advised 5/1/68, he will compare the fingerprints of JAMES EARL RAY, IO 4182 with all the unidentified latents in their files since 4/23/67. He stated that due to their heavy work load he will be unable to complete his comparisons until 5/2/68.

On 5/2/68, Trooper RUCCO advised RAY's prints as set forth on IO 4182 are not identical to any unidentified latents in their files. Trooper RUCCO explained that with the exception of the Reading Police Department, all other law enforcement agencies in Berks County generally request the assistance of State Police in dusting and lifting latents prints and he knows ~~none~~ of no other department with the exception of the Reading PD who might maintain unidentified latent prints.

On 5/3/68, Detective ANTHONY O'REILLY, Bureau of Criminal Identification, Reading Police Department advised his department does not maintain an unidentified latent print file per se but does retain unidentified latents in the various case files where they have been obtained.
