

Mrs. RUBY DANSBY, owner and manager of the Belvoir Gwill, 9100 Richmond Highway, U. S. 1, Fair-to., va., phoned Fairfax Co., Va. FD night of 4/10/68 and they in turn, phoned WFO to advise that DANSBY served an unknown itinerant on 4/10/68, whom she thought resembled the artist's conception of subject which had appeared in local newspapers.

Mrs. DANSBY was interviewed by SA ROLAND M. COCKER 4/11/68 and advised that the description of the itinerant who came to her Grill was 54 years of age, 5'8", 155 lbs., sandy-graying hair, thin mustache, blue eyes, no car, and without money. She later saw the artist's conception appearing in the local newspapers and believed the itinerant to have resembled the artist's sketch. She advised she has not maintained the dinner utensils used by this person. This description was also furnished by ROSE "FRENCHIE" KELLY, a waitress who also saw the itinerant.

In view of the wide discrepancy of the physical description of the itinerant from that of the subject, no further action is being taken in this regard.

An examination of the Danville telephone and city directories failed to result in locating a listing for Associated Pipeline Contractors, and L.R.Wyatt, Retail Merchants Association states he has never heard of this firm operating in Danville, Va.

Lt. MARION SETLIFF, PD Danville, Va. advised he has never heard of Associated Pipeline Contractors operating in the Danville, Va. area and he has no record for JOHN A. GAULT.

Records of C & P Telephone Company, Danville, Va. reflect telephone 793-2731 issued Holliday Inn Motel, Danville, Va.

Mr. WESLEY DOVE, Clerk, Holiday Inn Motel, Danville, Va. stated JOHN A. GAULT registered at that motel during the PM of 4/4/68, however the exact time of registration was not shown. He gave his address as 5514 Darnell, Houston, Texas, and stated was representing Associated Pipeline Contractors of Houston. He stated he was operating a 1968 Ford and listed the license number as North Carolina 2953-C. While at the hotel GAULT made three local calls from his motel room, however no record was kept as to the numbers called. On 4/4/68 and again on 4/8/68 he made a call to Houston, Texas, telephone 667-0906. He made another call on 4/8/68 however the number he called was not shown on the telephone charge slip. GAULT checked out of the Motel during the morning of 4/9/68, exact time of check out not shown.

This was put out on a State Police All Points Bulleting and subsequently cancelled. However, prior to cancellation, the Henrico, Va. PD apprehended one MICHAEL WALTER GRIFFIN as a hitchhiker on Interstate 95 north of Richmond, as a possible suspect, however he was charged by them with vagrancy. GRIFFIN gave his address as 559 South Ditman Street, Los Angeles, California. It is noted that this individual from North Carolina was positively known to have a tattoo on his upper right arm consisting of a heart with the words, "Born to Lose" through the heart. GRIFFIN had no such tattoo.

This is being made a matter of record merely to record the name of this hitchhiker.

ROEHRL/at approximately 2:30am on April 8, 1968 that female his office had received an anonymous/telephone call from advising that a person by the name of ZEZNEKK "CHUCK" from Tennessee, a white male, six feet, sandy hair, side burns, dark sunglasses, driving a light colored Pontiac with Tennessee tags had commented ower the weekend that he had shot MARTIN LUTHER KING. The caller advised that she did not know if he were serious in the comment or not but another person by the name of JANET WHEATLEY of 2301 N. 11th Street in Arlington, Virginia with the phone number 522-6605 was present. "CHUCK" was further described as being married and with children in Tennessee and in the rear of the window of his car was an imitation skeleton head. His whereabouts was not known staying but he might be in Alexandria near Columbus or Wolfe Streets.

The caller mentioned that she had advised her boyfriend, NEAL HUSTON who is employed at the HEISHMAN VOLKSWAGEN Dealer as a mechanic on Jefferson Davis Highway in Alexandria.

MR. NEAL HUSTON, 310 E. Nelson Avenue Alexandria, Virginia employed as a mechanic at the HEISHMAN VOLKSWAGEN dealer on Jefferson Davis Highway in Alexandria on Hologo advised, that he was not present when any comment againsT MARTIN LUTHER KING WAS made by "CHUCK" but his girl friend, LOUISE HELTON who is a telephone operator and who resides at 2301 N. 11th Street in Arlington had told him of the incident and of the fact that she had called the Federal Bureau of Investigation in Washington, D.C. to advise of the comment which she had heard.

MESS LOUISE HELTON, Apartment 302 at 2301 - 11th Street North, Arlington, Va. advised that she is a telephone operator for the C. & P. Telephone Company in Arlington, Vxirginia at the N. MISS LOUISE WHEATLEY, roommate of LOUISE HELTON and also a telephone operator in Arlington, Virginia advised that she first met "CHUCK" DOLAN in Kingsport, Tennessee about five years ago and does not know where he lives or what where he might be staying at this time. She stated that she used to date him about four or five years ago but that she had not seen him for about six months. She advised that he did make the statement in the presence of her roommate on Saturday, April 6, 1968 that he had shot KING, but that he was only "kidding" and she paid no attention to the remark because she was certain that he ded not mean anything by it. She described him as a white male, married with children but residence not known, height 6'1" or 6'2", medium build, dark brown hair, about twenty-five years of age. His employment was not known but he used to be a door hangar in Kingsport, Tennessee, and had lived in the Alexandria, Virginia area about six or eight months ago, however, his residence or employment were not known. MISS WHEATLEY emphasized that she was certain that DOLAN had made the comment in a joking manner, perhaps using bad discretion in the presence of her roommate who did not know his personality and she regretted that it was called to the attention of the FBI.xx

FBI Hunt For Galt Widening

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (A) — FBI agents from Virginia to Florida were making an intensive hunt today for the mystery man whose abandoned white Muschang fits descriptions of a car seen leaving the scene of the Martin Luther King Jr. assassination.

The object of the widening search was Eric Starvo Galt, 37, known only as an unemployed seaman from Birmingham, Ala. A car registered in that name was seized by the FBI in Atlanta last Friday, eight days after King was shot to death in Memphis.

The FBI refused to acknowledge the hunt or to say why Galt was wanted. "No comment," was the routine reply. But Associated Press checks disclosed that FBI agents had contacted persons named Galt in several states including Virginia, Alabama and Florida.

ALERT-WITHDRAWN

An FBI alert for Galt was sent over the Florida police communications network last; Friday, but withdrawn four hours later.

FBI agents have continued to inquire about Galt at numerous places including dry cleaners and service stations in Birmingham, where a man named Eric Starvo Galt rented a room at a Southside boarding house within the past eight months.

Meanwhile, in Jacksonville, Fla., a man picked up for questioning about the assassination was cleared, police said.

Agents have exhibited composite drawings of a man's face, but no photographs, according to persons contacted Brrmingham.

At the same time, police scurces in Memphis disclosed Sunday that the FBI was withholding nationwide distribution of a composite drawing, of King's killer, who fired the death shot from a dingy second-floor bathroom in a rundown rooming house. King, leader of monviolent civil rights forces, was struck in the neck as he stood on a second-floor motel balcony facing the rear of the frooming house.

They haven't given us anything but a physical description. They aren't handing out pictures of the man," said a police official who asked that his name be withheld.

"They either don't have a good one or they're going it alone."





The records further reflect that WILLARD was a white male, born July 10, 1946, Richlands, Virginia, was 5'10", 145 lbs., blue eyes, brown hair, and was a service station attendant.

Lt. GRIMM informed that the arresting officer was JAMES L. OUTIAND. He related that OUTIAND was no longer employed by the police department; however, he is employed by the Secret Service in Washington, D.C. He stated his full name was JAMES L. OUTIAND, and his residence address 2as 709 Chatworth Place, Alexandria, Virginia.

Lt. GRIMM informed that he could not find the folder with reference to this particular case; however, he would make it available as soon as it had found.

On April 11, 1968, Lt. GRIMM made available the folder with reference to WILLARD, The becords indicate that WILLARD on December 1, 1962 at approximately 6 P.M., was getting off work at his place of employment, the Harper's Flying-A Service, 1000 South Washington Street, Alexandria, Virginia. At this time the owner, HENRY HARPER, paid him and informed him that he no longer needed his services inasmuch as he needed a man with more experience. A customer had left a 1962 Corvair at the station, and the keys were in this automobile. WILLARD took the automobile, then picked up J'MES W. BROWN of 1926 Duke Street, Alexandria, Virginia, They then drove to Washington, D.C., Maryland and various areas in Alexandria and during the period were drinking beer.

WILLARD was driving on Duke Street west when he hit a pedestrian. WILLARD was then charged with reckless driving, Grand Larceny of an automobile and operating a motor vehicle without a permit.
