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# Man Indicted In Slaying In Roanok

ROANOKE (AP) Roanoke Circuit Court Grand Jury called into special session Friday indicted a 29-year-old Roanoke man on a charge of murder in the death of a man. whose decomposed body was found in a coalbin more than three years ago.

CECIL WILLARD, 4813 Edwards Street, Alexandria, Virginia, Phone Number 354-0693, advised that he has a half-brother known as JOHN SAUNDERS WILLARD. He informed that his half-brother's true name is JOHN SAUNDERS ARCHIE, JR.; however, he had never utilized this name inasmuch as his father had died shortly after his birth.

WILLARD informed that his half-brother was approximately 22 years of age, was a white male, 5 feet 11 inches, 160-170 pounds, sandy hair, blue eyes, and had no scars or marks that he could recall. He stated he does not know of any rifle that his half-brother ever owned; however, he knows that he has gone target shooting with him on several occasions and he was a good shot.

WILLARD informed that his half-brother, JOHN, to the best of his knowledge, was in Roanoke, Virginia, and had been in Roanoke, Virginia, up to two months ago. He related that he was presently residing with a girl named PENNY, and PENNY at the present time was pregnant. He stated that PENNY was from Pulaski, Virginia, and she left her husband to live with his half-brother, JOHN. For the information of all Agents, the Bureau authorized a press release as of 4/17/68 in connection with a Federal warrant obtained by the FBI in Birmingham, Ala., 4/17/68, charging ERIC STARVO GALT with conspiring to violate the civil rights of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., in violation of Title 18, Section 241, of the U. S. Code. GALT is being sought by the FBI as a fugitive on the Federal charge arising from the fatal shooting of Dr. KING in Memphis, Tenn., on 4/4/68.

The complaint charges that on or about 3/29/68 in Birmingham, Ala., GALT and an individual, whom he alleged to be his brother, entered into a conspiracy which continued until on or about 4/5/68, to injure, oppress, threaten, or intimidate Dr. KING in the free exercise or enjoyment of a right secured to him by the Constitution or laws of the U.S.; namely, the right to free travel from state to state. The complaint further charges that in furtherance of this conspiracy, GALT did, on or about 3/30/68, purchase a rifle at Birmingham, Ala.

In connection with the finding of a 30.06 rifle equipped with telescopic sight near a rooming house in Memphis immediately after the fatal shooting, it has been determined that this rifle and sight had been purchased from a gun dealer in Birmingham, Ala., on 3/30/68.

CALT, who has used the names JOHN WILLARD and HARVEY LOWMYER in the past, is the owner of a 1966 white Mustang, bearing Alabama license plates, which was located abandoned in Atlanta, Ga., on 4/11/68. It has been determined that GALT purchased this car from a private citizen in Birmingham, Ala., on 8/30/67. GALT's travels in the Mustang include trips to Los Angeles, New Orleans, Birmingham, Memphis, Atlanta, and Mexico. He was reported to have been in Memphis on 4/3 and 4/68 and to have departed there for Atlanta.

Investigation disclosed that GALT has claimed to have been employed as a cook on Mississippi River vessels and as a merchant seaman. He is said to be an avid dancer and took dancing lessons in New Orleans in 1964 and 1965; in Birmingham during September and October, 1967; and in Long Beach, California, from 12/67 - 2/68. He left Los Angeles on December 15, 1967, and drove his white Mustang to New Orleans. He left New Orleans on December 19, 1967, and arrived back in Los Angeles on December 21, 1967. While in the Los Angeles area early this year, GALT took a course at a school of bartending and was graduated 3/2/68.

GALT is described as a white male, 5'8" to 5'11", weighing between 160 - 175 pounds, and issaid to be a neat dresser, with medium build. He has brown hair, worn in a "brush" cut; blue eyes; straight, narrow nose; clean, straight teeth; and has listed his date of birth as 7/20/31. He reportedly has a nervous habit of occasionally pulling at an ear lobe with his hand. His left ear protrudes farther from his head than his right ear. GALT is described as a "loner" and his language and diction have a "rural" quality which suggests he probably does not have a high degree of education. He is said to drink alcoholic beverages with a preference for yodka and beer, and he is a fan of western and country music.

#### GALT SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS.

There are attached for information and assistance in covering possible fugitive leads in this matter two (2) photographs of GALT. The photograph with the eyes closed is an actual photograph taken in 3/68. The photograph with the eyes open is the same photograph in which the eyes have been drawn in by an artist.

## April 17, 1968

Attorney General Ramsey Clark announced today that Eric Starvo Galt is being sought by the FBI as a fugitive on a Federal charge arising from the fatal shooting of the Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., in Memphis, Tennessee, on April 4, 1968.

Director J. Edgar Hoover stated that a Federal complaint was filed by the FBI in Birmingham, Alabama, today charging Galt with conspiring to violate the civil rights of Dr. King in violation of Title 18, Section 241, of the United States Code.

The FBI complaint charges that "on or about March 29, 1968, at Birmingham, Alabama, Eric Starvo Galt and an individual whom he alleged to be his brother, entered into a conspiracy which continued until on or about April 5, 1968, to injure, oppress, threaten, or intimidate Martin Luther King, Jr., in the free exercise or enjoyment of a right secured to him by the constitution or laws of the United States; namely, the right to freely travel from state to state. In furtherance of this conspiracy, Eric Starvo Galt did, on or about March 30, 1968, purchase a rifle at Birmingham, Alabama..."

According to Mr. Hoover, a 30.06 rifle equipped with a telescopic sight was found near a rooming house on South Main Street in Memphis immediately after the fatal shooting of Dr. King occurred. The rooming house overlooks the Lorraine Hotel and Motel where Dr. King was staying.

Mr. Hoover said that FBI Agents determined that the 30.06

rifle had been purchased from a gun dealer in Birmingham, Alabama, on March 30, 1968. The telescopic sight also was purchased from this dealer.

The FBI Director said that Galt, who has used the names of John Willard and Harvey Lowmyer in the past, is the owner of a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama license plates which was located abandoned in Atlanta, Georgia, on April 11, 1968. Investigation disclosed that Galt purchased this car from a private citizen in Birmingham on August 30, 1967. The Mustang's odometer showed that it had been driven more than 19,000 miles between late August, 1967, and early April, 1968.

According to Mr. Hoover, Galt's travels in the Mustang included trips to Los Angeles, California; New Orleans, Louisiana; Birmingham, Alabama; and Mexico, as well as to Memphis, Tennessee, and Atlanta, Georgia. Galt was reported to have been in Memphis on April 3 and 4, 1968, and to have departed from there for Atlanta.

Intensive investigation by the FBI has disclosed that Galt has claimed to have been employed as a cook on Mississippi River vessels and as a merchant seaman. He is said to be an avid dancer and took dancing lessons in New Orleans in 1964 and 1965; in Birmingham during September and October, 1967; and in Long Beach, California, from December, 1967 to February, 1968.

Galt left Los Angeles on December 15, 1967, and drove his white Mustang to New Orleans, where he claimed he contacted either an engineering or a contracting firm. He left New Orleans on December 19th and arrived back in Los Angeles on December 21, 1967.

While in the Los Angeles area early this year, Galt took a course at a school of bartending and was graduated on March 2, 1968.

The fugitive is described as white male. He is approximately 5 feet 8 inches to 5 feet 11 inches tall and weighs between 160 and 175 pounds. He is said to be a neat dresser and has a medium build.

Galt has brown hair, which he wears in a "brush" cut. He reportedly has blue eyes; his nose is straight and narrow; his teeth are straight and clean; and he has given his date of birth as July 20, 1931.

The fugitive is said to have a nervous habit of occasionally pulling at an ear lobe with his hand. His left ear protrudes farther from his head than his right ear.

According to Mr. Hoover, persons who have met Galt describe him as a "loner" and state his language and diction have a "rural" quality and suggest that he probably does not have a high degree of education. He is said to drink alcoholic beverages and has a preference for vodka and beer. He is fan of western and country music.

Galt should be considered armed and dangerous. Any information concerning him should be furnished immediately to the nearest FBI office.

Mr. WRAY stated that SHORT paid his motel bill of \$103 with a Gulf Oil Company Credit Card No. He stated there were no telephone calls charged to the bill, and the record indicates that SHORT was driving a 1997 Comet with 1967 Louisiana license 48D933.

Mr. IRA GIENN WISENAN, 521 Wingfield Avenue, N.E., Roanoke, Virginia, telephone number 366-5734, advised that his wife has a brother, JAMES HENRY SHORT, who resides with his wife, JACQUELINE, in Alexandria, Louisiana. Mr. WISEMAN stated they had been informed earlier that morning that SHORT had disappeared from his home in Alexandria, Louisiana, about ten days before, and his wife, SACQUELINE, had not known his whereabouts until the morning of April 11, 1968, when she received an inquiry from her bank concerning a check her husband had given to the Moliday Inn No. 2 at Roanoke, Virginia. She immediately contacted Mr. WISEMAN, and he went to the Heliday Inn No. 2, Roanoke, Virginia, where he located Mr. SHORT.

Mr. VISEMAN then took SMORT to his home and in attempting to find out why Mr. SHORT had run away from his wife and children in Alexandria, Louisiana, he was informed by SHORT that SHORT was involved in the murder of the Reverend MARTIN LUTBER KING, JR. at Memphis, Tennessee, on April 4, 1968.

Mr. WISEMAN stated that he has not observed anything about SHORT which would indicate that he is mentally deranged or that he had been drinking to excess. However, he knows that within the past year, SHORT has been drinking. Mr. WISEMAN advised that SMORT was in U. S. Air Force for about eight years and was discharged six or eight months ago. He informed Mr. WISEMAN that while he was in the Air Force, he furnished some information of a military nature to a communist in Louisiana.

Mr. WISEMAN stated that SHORT was then at his home and would be receptive to an interview with an FBI Agent; therefore, Mr. WISEMAN was accomposed to his home and SHORT was interviewed in the presence of Mr. WISE-MAN. Tilos hours.

JAMES HENRY SHORT, 1722 Tullamore Street, Alexandria, Louisiana, was interviewed at the home of his brother-in-law, IRA GIENN WISEMAN, 521 Wingfield Avenue, N.E., Roanoke, Virginia, at the request of IRA GIENN WISEMAN, by Special Agent ICEALIUS A. HALL, who identified himself to SHORT as a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI).

At the outset of this interview, SHORT was advised by SA HALL he was being interviewed for his possible involvement in the murder of the Reverend MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. at Nemphis, Tennessee, on April 4, 1968.

SHORT was further informed that his brother-in-law, IRA GIENN WISEMAN, had indicated that he, SHORT, wanted to talk with an FBI Agent, and that Agent HALL was there to take any information concerning the murder of Dr. KING that he had to offer.

SHORT was warned of certain rights, and he waived them as shown on an executed warning and waiver form.

He declired to furnish a signed statement, but voluntarily furnished the following information:

SHORT stated that he served in the U. S. Air Force for seven years under Serial Mumber AF 13 705 516. He stated that he received an Undesirable Discharge on November 30, 1967 because of too many personal debts and for issuing fraudulent checks.

SHORT advised that while he was in the Air Force, he was assigned to the 319th Air Commando Squadron at Elgin Air Force Base, Florida, and during the latter part of April, 1966, this entire squadron was transferred to Alexandria, Louisiana. He stated that after their transfer to Alexandria, Louisiana, he was assigned to the Test Project "AGIIE" at Greenville, Texas.

He stated that this project was not classified but was not widely known in the Air Force. SHORT advised that while he was working on this project, a Company clerk, ENGENE BATTLE, also assigned to the 319th Air Commando Squadron, came to him and informed him that since he was the Company clerk, hewknew of SHORT's difficulty because of his financial matters with the Commanding Officer and that he could intercept the bills and letters coming to him without the Commanding Officer knowing about them, and he would be willing to do this for SHORT if SHORT would furnish information to him about the test project.

SHORT stated he did not know why BATTLE wanted this information but suspects now that he was furnishing the information to someone else.

SHORT advised that he did turn some information over to BATTLE but BATTLE could have obtained the information himself.

SHORT stated that they outfitted an aircraft with the test objects which he described as a "link temp volt" which was being sent to Vie tnam, and he gave the flight pattern of the aircraft to BATTLE.

SHORT stated that BATTLE did not pay him any modey for the information, and only intercepted the bills and letters concerning him to his Commanding Officer.

SHORT described BATTLE as a Negro male, 5'7" to 5'8", 150 - 160 pounds, black kinky hair, brown complexion, brown eyes, age 22, home address - Little Rock, Arkansas. SHORT stated that BATTLE was rated as a Specialist E-4 and was discharged from the Air Force four or five months before, he, SHORT, was discharged.

SHORT advised that after being discharged from the Air Force, he obtained a position with sthe ASCO School Equipment Company, Alexandria, Louisiana, and he was living with his wife and two children at 1722 Tullamore Street, Alexandria, Louisiana.

SHORT advised that on Monday, April 1, 1968, he had been drinking some, but was not drunk, when he received a telephone call from a man, who informed him that he wanted SHORT to help out on a job at Memphis, Tennessee, between 2:30 A.M., and 3 P.M., on April 4, 1968. SHORT stated the man whom he did not know and who did not identify himself to him, said that he should meet him in Room 126 of the Downtowner Motel, Memphis, Tennessee, between 2:30 and 3 P.M.

SHORT stated that he did not know what the man wanted him to do, and the man did not tell him what kind of a "job" it was. He stated the man further informed him that he should a Jackson, Mississippi, and pick up a man named "DICK COLLINS" at the Holiday Inn at Jackson.

SHORT stated that the man who gave him these instructions did not tell him how he would know DICK COLLINS; however, he drove to the Holiday Inn at Jackson, Mississippi, and arrived there at about midnight on Wednesday, April 3, 1968. He stated that he got a room at the Motel and stayed all night and that at 11:30 to 12 noon the next day, Thursday, a man named COLLINS came to the room and stated he was to go to Memphis with him.

SHORT adviced that they left Jackson, Mississippi, driving his 1967 Bonetbettomobile which has a blue bottom and vinyl top. He stated that it took them approximately five hours to drive from Jackson to Memphis because it rained very hard all the way, and he could not drive fester than 40 miles per hour.

He stated that they arrived at the Downtowner Motel in Memphis at approximately 5:30 F.M., and he and COLLINS immediately went to Room 126. He stated when they arrived at the room, there were four men in the room, and he did not obtain any of their names.

He described these as Number 1:

A white man in his early fifties, 6'1" to 6'2" tall, approximately 230 pounds or more, hair black but turning gray.

#### Number 2:

A young white man, approximately 30, well dressed, medium height and medium build, who appeared to be holding a "gun case" on his lap.

#### Number 3:

A white male, 38 to 40, with light hair, tall and thin, approximately 6'4", to 6'5", and weighing approximately 180 pounds.

#### Number 4:

A Negro male, in his late twenties, 5'll" to 6', 170 pounds, light complexion, black hair, straight and cut close, and well dressed.

SHORT stated that as a matter of fact all four of the men were well dressed.

He advised that when he and COLLINS entered the room, Number 1, who appeared to be the leader of the group, jumped on him because he was so late in arriving, and pointed to the young man, who appeared to be holding the gun case and stated that he drove from New Orleans today and did not have any trouble and got there in plenty of time.

SHORT stated that Number 1 then informed them they would have to hurry because KING was staying in a motel about eleven blocks away from the Downtowner Motel. SHORT stated he does not recall the name of the motel in which KING was to supposed to be staying. He stated further that the Number 1 man did not mention anything about injuring or killing KING, but instructed SHORT, COLLINS and the other three men they were to go to the motel and create a dispurbance in the vicinity of the motel so if there were any security guards around the motel or KING, their attention would be drawn from the motel.

SHORT stated the group left the Downtowner Motel and COLLINS and the Negro get into a light colored late model Bulck or Oldsmobile. The Number 1 man and the other two men get into a late model Chrysler and SHORT drove his own automobile, the 1967 Comet.

SHORT stated that on the way to the motel, he realized that there was going to be trouble there, and he did not want to have any part in an attack on Dr. KING, and decided to leave? there "fast".

He stated he did not know where he was going, but intended only to get away from Memphis as fast as he could. He stated that he was driving north on Interstate 240 away from Memphis when he heard on his automobile radio that Dr. KING had been killed.

SHORT advised that he continued driving until he reached Engsport, Tennessee, and checked into the Holiday Inn there at approximately 1:30 A.M., April 5, 1968. He stated that he used his correct name when he registered at the Holiday Inn.

SHORT advised that the next morning he continued to Roanoke, Virginia, and checked into the Holiday Inn Motel at the inteffection of Orange Avenue and Williamson Road, N.W., at approximately 1:44 A.M., on April 6, 1968. SHORT stated that he stayed at this motel until he was found there by his brother-in-law, at approximately noon on April 11, 1968.

EHORTitavalupathondous to SHORTithamen whom he claimed to be strangers to him and whose names nor identities he knew, would ask him to join in a plot to assassinate a man who stated that he does not know why they did except that he thought they might have a "hold on him" because of his involvement with BATTIE when they were in the military service.

SHORT stated further that he feared for his safety and the safety of his wife and children if he did not do as he was instructed.

It was pointed out to SHORT that it would be very unlikely for a group of men to ask a man whom they did not know to help them in an assassination because to do so would "put their necks in a noose" if he did not want to help them in the assassination and went to the authorities and reported the matter to them. SHORT stated that he was aware of that, but insisted that he was selling the truth.

He was then asked if he had participated in anyway in the assassination, and he stated that he had not except to meet the men in the Downtowner Motel, Reom 126, where they apparently had planned the assassination. He stated that when he realized what they intended to do, he got out of there as fast as he could.

SHORT insisted that he did not know the identities of any of the other five men except COLLINS, and that COLLINS was from Jackson, Mississippi.

SHORT was further asked if he had been drinking at the time he received the alleged telephone call, and he stated that he had drunk quite a bit that day, but insisted he was not drunk.

SHORT advised further that he has issued eight insufficient funds checks since he left Alexandria, Louisiana; one to the Holiday Inn at Roanoke, Virginia; one to Sears Roebuck and Company, Roanoke and one to Davidson's Men's Store Inc., at Roanoke. He refused to state why he

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT RAY, WHO IS 40 YEARS OF AGE, WAS REPORTED MISSING FROM THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY AT JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, SINCE APRIL 23, 1967. Attorney General Ramsey Clark announced today that the FBI has identified James Earl Ray, an escapee from the Missouri State Penitentiary, as Eric Starvo Galt, against whom a Federal complaint was filed last Wednesday in connection with the fatal shooting of the Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

Director J. Edgar Hoover said that a systematic and exhaustive search of latent fingerprints uncovered in the Dr. King case against the fingerprints of the over 53,000 persons from whom "wanted notices" have been posted in the files of the FBI's Identification Division led to the determination that Galt and Ray are identical.

Mr. Hoover said that Ray, who is 40 years of age, was reported missing from the Missouri State Penitentiary at Jefferson City, Missouri, since April 23, 1967. He had been received at that institution on March 17, 1960, to serve a 20-year sentence following conviction in St. Louis for armed robbery and for operating a motor vehicle without permission of the owner.

In September, 1966, while serving this sentence, he was confined for a time in the maximum security ward at the State Hospital at Fulton, Missouri.

According to Mr. Hoover, Ray has a known arrest record dating back to 1949. Prior to the 1960 conviction for which he received the 20-year term, Ray had been convicted of burglary in Los Angeles, California, in 1949; armed robbery in Chicago, Illinois, in 1952; and forging United States Postal Money Orders in Missouri in 1955.

He has served terms in the Los Angeles County Jail in 1949; in state prisons at Joliet and Pontiac, Illinois, in 1952-54; and in the Federal Penitentiary at Leavenworth, Kansas, in 1955-58.

Ray was an enlisted man in the United States Army from February, 1945, to December, 1948, at which time he was given a general discharge due to ineptness and lack of adaptability for military service. While in the army, he received a three-month sentence at hard labor for being drunk and breaking arrest.

Mr. Hoover said that during his criminal career,
Ray has also used the names of James McBride, James Walton,
W. C. Herron and James O'Conner. He is a white male; claims
to have been born March 10, 1928, in Illinois; is approximately
5 feet 10 inches tall and weighs about 163 to 174 pounds.

He has blue eyes and brown hair. There is a small scar on the center of his forehead and a scar on the palm of his right hand.

Ray has claimed that he attended school through the 10th grade in Alton, Illinois. He has had the reputation of being a "drifter" since leaving school. His vocational experience includes working as a baker, laborer, and color matcher.

In connection with his escape from the Missouri State Penitentiary, an FBI complaint was filed in Jefferson City, Missouri, on July 20, 1967, charging Ray with unlawfully fleeing from the State of Missouri to avoid confinement. He has been a federal fugitive since then.

Ray should be considered armed and extremely dangerous. Anyone having information concerning him should immediately contact FBI Headquarters in Washington, D. C., or the nearest FBI Office.
