

Attached for the information of all Agents is a press release issued at Washington the afternoon of 4/19/68 and which has been issued locally in Richmond. The Bureau instructed that no elaboration whatsoever be made regarding this release and that additional instructions regarding investigative leads will follow.

As will be noted in the attached press release, GALT has been identified as JAMES EARL RAY, subject of a UFAC Bureau case in which he has been a fugitive since 7/20/67.

Attorney General Ramsey Clark announced today that the FBI has identified James Earl Ray, an escapee from the Missouri State Penitentiary, as Eric Starvo Galt, against whom a Federal complaint was filed last Wednesday in connection with the fatal shooting of the Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

Director J. Edgar Hoover said that a systematic and exhaustive search of latent fingerprints uncovered in the Dr. King case against the fingerprints of the over 53,000 persons from whom "wanted notices" have been posted in the files of the FBI's Identification Division led to the determination that Galt and Ray are identical.

Mr. Hoover said that Ray, who is 40 years of age, was reported missing from the Missouri State Penitentiary at Jefferson City, Missouri, since April 23, 1967. He had been received at that institution on March 17, 1960, to serve a 20-year sentence following conviction in St. Louis for armed robbery and for operating a motor vehicle without permission of the owner.

In September, 1966, while serving this sentence, he was confined for a time in the maximum security ward at the State Hospital at Fulton, Missouri.

According to Mr. Hoover, Ray has a known arrest record dating back to 1949. Prior to the 1960 conviction for which he received the 20-year term, Ray had been convicted of burglary in Los Angeles, California, in 1949; armed robbery in Chicago, Illinois, in 1952; and forging United States Postal Money Orders in Missouri in 1955.

He has served terms in the Los Angeles County Jail in 1949; in state prisons at Joliet and Pontiac, Illinois, in 1952-54; and in the Federal Penitentiary at Leavenworth, Kansas, in 1955-58.

Ray was an enlisted man in the United States Army from February, 1946, to December, 1948, at which time he was given a general discharge due to ineptness and lack of adaptability for military service. While in the army, he received a three-month sentence at hard labor for being drunk and breaking arrest.

Mr. Hoover said that during his criminal career,
Ray has also used the names of James McBride, James Walton,
W. C. Herron and James O'Conner. He is a white male; claims
to have been born March 10, 1928, in Illinois; is approximately
5 feet 10 inches tall and weighs about 163 to 174 pounds.

He has blue eyes and brown hair. There is a small scar on the center of his forehead and a scar on the palm of his right hand.

Ray has claimed that he attended school through the 10th grade in Alton, Illinois. He has had the reputation of being a "drifter" since leaving school. His vocational experience includes working as a baker, laborer, and color matcher.

In connection with his escape from the Missouri State Penitentiary, an FBI complaint was filed in Jefferson City, Missouri, on July 20, 1967, charging Ray with unlawfully fleeing from the State of Missouri to avoid confinement. He has been a federal fugitive since then.

Ray should be considered armed and extremely dangerous. Anyone having information concerning him should immediately contact FBI Headquarters in Washington, D. C., or the nearest FBI Office.

FBI Released This Photo as Eric Starvo Galt

Artist Drew in Eyes, Which Were Closed

Galt Named Specifically; So-Called Brother Sought

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. (P) —A if e d e r a l fugitive warrrant W e d n e s d a y charged Eric Starvo Galt, a white man who has been hinted for a week, with conspiracy in the April 4 sniper assassination of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

The FBI complaint charges that Galt and a man who Galt claimed was his brother entered into a conspiracy about March 29 in Birmingham. A federal warrant for Galt's arrest was issued in Birmingham.

There was no indication from the FBI that other persons would be charged with the conspiracy. The second man that Galt said was his brother was not identified, nor charged.

A witness in Memphis, where King was killed, said an FBI photograph of the wanted man does not resemble the man he saw leaving the scene after the shooting.

"Unless he was wearing a wig or had had a face lift or something, it's not the man I saw," said Charles Q. Stevens, a resident of the Main Street rooming house from which the sniper was believed to have shot King.

"The hair is too full and the face is too young," said Stevens. He said he only got a side view of the fleeing man, however.

The FBI did not indicate when the photograph was made, but a source said it was taken within the past three months.

In Birmingham, Galt's landlord for six weeks last fall, Peter Cherpes, told the Associated Press that the FBI photo might be a picture of Galt. 'It's very near, but I'm not sure,'' said Cherpes. He remembered his boarder's hair as being much lighter.

The AP reported Monday that Cherpes had identified FBI drawings as the Eric Galt who had lived at the Birmingham rooming house from Aug. 26 to Oct. 7, 1967.

An Atlanta taxicab driver said an FBI picture he identified as a two-block fare the night after the slaying was different from the one released Wednesday. "That is definitely not the man I picked up," the cab driver said.

Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark, who went to Memphis after the slaying of the civil rights leader, announced in a statement that Galt was being sought as a fugitive on the charge of conspiring to injure, oppress, threaten or intimidate King in the exercise of a federal right, "namely, the right to freely travel from state to state."

Charged by State

Tennessee charged Galt with first-degree murder late Wednesday in the King slaying. The state warrant was issued five hours after the FBI announcement.

The FBI charge was the first disclosure that authorities had evidence of a conspiracy in King's slaving. An early statement by Clark referred to "one man on the run." It was dropped from a later statement.

FBI director J. Edgar Hooer said in the Wednesday release that Galt bought a rifle in Birmingham about March 30. Only a few weeks before, the statement said, Galt had graduated from a bartending school in Los Angeles.

Galt had told acquaintances in Birmingham that he worked in shipyards or on ships, and on a driver's license application he put "merchant seaman, unemploved."

In Hollywood, director Tomas Reyes Lau of the International School of Bartending,

said Galt graduated March 2 and disappeared after refusing a job. Lau said Galt was an excellent student.

The FBI said Galt also was known as "Harvey Lowmyer and John Willard." The slaying suspect registered under the latter name.

An FBI statement said Galt has given his date of birth as July 20, 1931, has brown hair, wears his hair in a brush cut, reportedly has blue eyes, a straight narrow nose, is between 5-feet-8 and 5-feet-11 and weighs between 160 and 175 pounds.

The FBI said, "The fugitive is said to have a nervous habit of occasionally pulling at an

Continued From First Page | ear lobe with his left hand. His left ear lobe protrudes farther from his head than his right ear."

The FBI statement said that Galt, on or about March 30. bought a rifle at Birmingham. The bureau did not say specif ically that it was the rifle that killed King.

But the statement said, "Å 30.06 rifle equipped with a telescopic sight was found near a rooming house on South Main Street in Memphis immediately after the fatal shooting of Dr. King occurred." The rooming house overlooks the Lorraine Hotel and Motel where King was staying.

FBI agents have determined that the rifle was purchased from a Birmingham gun dealer March 30. The sight also was said to have been bought from the same dealer, whom the FBI did not identify.

Owned Mustang

The FBI said Galt owns a 1966 white Mustang with Alabama license plates which was found abandoned April 11 Atlanta. It was bought from a private citizen in Birmingham last Aug. 30.

The car's odometer showed it had been driven more than 19,000 miles between late August 1967 and early April 1968.

The FBI said, "Galt's travel in the Mustang included trips to Los Angeles, Calif., New Orleans, La., Birmingham, Ala., and Mexico as well as to Memphis, Tenn., and Atlanta, Ga. Galt was reported to have been in Memphis on April 3 and 4, 1968 and to have departed from there for Atlanta."

While he was there, he purchased two post cards and when he left asked if she could mail the cards for him. She agreed to mail the cards and after he left, she read them and noted the contents and the way that they were signed and decided to turn them over to the FBI rather than mail them.

Mrs. REID furnished the cards which read as follows:

"Should you ever again warn me about Houston's rain, you'll be speaking to a confirmed believer. Visability was so poor, could only do 40 MPH. Having neither radar nor pontoons, stayed over at Winnie, Tex (25 mi W. of Beaumont)

It was noted that both of the cards were hand printed in ink and appeared to have been written by the same individual. The cards are being maintained in the Richmond file.

Furthermore, the list currently is filled. The latest to be added—as of today — is David Stuart Neff, 31, wanted in connection with two Massachusetts bank robberies.

Persons who have met Galt, the FBI reported, described his as a loner with a "rural" speech and little schooling, fond of vodka, beer and hillbilly music.

"The fugitive is said to have a nervous habit of occasionally pulling at an ear lobe with his left hand. His left ear protrudes further from his head than his right ear."

"Galt should be considered armed and dangerous," the FBI release warned.

Galt has used the names of John Willard and Harvey Lowmeyer, the FBI said. The assassin registered at the Memphis rooming house under the name of John Willard.

Details of the alleged conspiracy were missing from the FBI release, as were vital statistics, such as Galt's birthplace, formal schooling, employment. The statement said Galt claimed to have been a cook on Mississippi riverboats, a merchant seaman and "is said to be an avid dancer.'

Galt, the FBI said, is the owner of a 1966 white Mustang with Alabama license plates abandoned in Atlanta the day after King was shot to death. The venicle was left in the it.

Two white Mustangs were parked near the rooming house shortly before the shooting, witnesses have said, and both disappeared minutes later. Some witnesses told of a man in a black business suit, neatly dressed, walking down the steps to the street with either Alabama or Arkansas tags.

A businessman said Wednes-Mustang parked farthest from "It's very near, but I'm not the shooting scene had an Arkansas tag. "I'm clear in my own mind," he said.

The FBI said Galt's car traveled more than 19,000 miles between Aug. 30, 1967, when he bought it in Birmingham and its abandonment last week in Atlanta. There were trips to

Los Angeles, New Orleans and

Mexico, the FBI said. "Galt was reported to have been in Memphis April 3 and 4, 1968, and to have departed

from there for Atlanta," the FBI said.

Galt was said to have taken dancing lessons in New Orleans in 1964 or 1965, in Birmingham during 1967 and in Long Beach, Calif., in recent months.

BARTENDING COURSE

While in the Los Angeles The FBI statement also said, area early this year, Galt took a course in bartending and graduated March 2, the FBI said. In Hollywood, director Tomas Reyes Lau of the International School of Bartending said Galt took a four-week course but refused a job.

Lau said Galt turned down the job because he wanted lo visit his brother.



FBI Is Reported Searching for Galt Outside the U.S.

MEMPHIS P - The FBI any details at all about a man pressed one of the most thorough manhunts in its history Thursday for Eric Starvo Galt, charged in the slaying of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King

But little more was known publicly about the alleged assassin of the civil rights leader than when his name first arose a week ago. It was learned. however, that a man registered as Eric S. Galt in a Memphis motel a day before King was slain.

Police agencies continued their "no comment" handling of the case - including questions about a newspaper report that the search had spread outside the country, to Mexico or Cuba And they were silent on

with whom Galt may have conspired in the slaying.

Murder Warrant

A murder warrant was issued here Wednesday night for the 36-year-old Galt, five hours after the FBI charged him with conspiracy to violate the civil rights of King. The FBI war-rant charged him with con-spiring with a man "whom he alleged to be his brother."

King was killed by a single bullet the night of April 4 as he leaned over the second-floor railing of a Memphis motel. Police have said the shot was fired from the bathroom of a hotel across the street.

The FBI said Galt had used the names of Harvey Lowmyer and John Willard. A man named "John Willard" checked into the hotel just three hours before King was killed and left, shortly afterward.

Ivan B. Webb, night desk clerk at the Rebel Motel here, said a man registered there under the name of Eric S. Galt on April 3. Webb said a white Mustang with Alabama license plates and Mexican tourist stickers was parked near the room occupied by Galt. A similar car has been impounded in Atlanta, and the FBI said that car belonged to Galt. A white Mustar'g is believed to have been the getaway car after the slaying.

The FBI declined comment on the possibility that a man who had checked into another motel April 3 might have been Galt's brether.

Neat Dresser

In Washington, Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark described Galt as a neat dresser, of apparently limited education and a man with a taste for yodka and beer.

He also was described as an avid dancer with a liking for country and Western music.

Police recovered a :30-03 Remington rifle with telescopic sight soon after King was killed. The weapon had been abandoned in a doorway: near the scene of the shooting.

The Birmingham News said in a copyrighted story Thursday that a gun which the FBI said had been purchased in that city had been indentified in ballistics tests as the .30 Cb rifle that killed King.

The newspaper also said the search for Galt has spread outside the United States and that it is believed the man has fled to Mexico or Cuba.

Λ photograph, released Wednesday by the FBI, was obtained from the International School of Bartending in Hollywood, Calif., where Galt was graduated March 2 after a four-week course.

But several persons who said they either knew Galt or had seen him before or after the slaying had trouble in-dentifying the photograph. And the operator of a Memphis dancing school said the FBI had shown him a sketch not a photograph, just hours before the picture was released, in Washington. Others said the FBI had shown them another

At about 6 p.m. on 4/4/68, while standing on the second floor balcony outside Room 306 of the Lorraine Motel, 406 Mulberry Street, Memphis, Tennessee, Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. wasstruck in the right side of the face by a single bullet fired from a 30-06 rifle. The bullet severed KING's spinal cord and death was almost instantaneous.

This investigation, predicated upon a specific request from the Attorney General of the United States, disclosed that the fatal shot had been fired from the bathroom of a cheap rooming house located at 4222 South Main Street, Memphis, which bathroom was located at the rear of the rooming house, and had a window overlooking the Lorraine Motel.

At about 3 p.m. on 4/4/68, an individual using the name JOHN WILLARD had rented Room 5-B in the rooming house at 4222 South Main Street and had paid one week's rent. After hearing the rifle shot at about 6 p.m. on that same day, other tenants in the rooming house observed a man presumably identical with WILLARD, fleeing from the rooming house carrying a large package which was subsequently abandoned by him on the sidewalk in front of the Canipe Amusement Co., 424 South Main Street, Memphis. A neighborhood investigation in the vicinity of 424 South Main Street disclosed that the subject had fled from the scene in a white Mustang.

Found abandoned in front of 424 South Main Street was a 30-06 Remington model 760 rifle which was determined to have been

sold to one HARVEY LOWMEYER on 3/30/68 by Aeromarine Supply Co., Birmingham, Alabama.

Investigation at Memphis disclosed that an individual had purchased a set of binoculars at the York Arms Company in Memphis on 4/4/68. These binoculars were among the material abandoned with the rifle and recovered in Memphis. Also recovered was a brown and green herringbone bedspread. The items abandoned in Memphis were all wrapped in this bedspread. The blue bag which was inside the bedspread contained numerous items, among which were the binoculars and a set of underwear consisting of a T-shirt and shorts. The T-shirt and shorts are those on which appears the laundry mark which has been a matter of interest in this case.

A search of motel records in the Memphis area disclosed that an individual using the name ERIC S. GALT had spent the night of 4/3/68 at the Rebel Motel, Memphis, Tennessee, and was driving a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama License 1-38993. Investigation at Birmngham disclosed that this automobile had been purchased by ERIC S. GALT on August 30, 1968, from a private person in response to a newspaper ad. He paid a total of \$1995 cash. While in Birmingham he furnished the address of 2608 South Highland Avenue, Birmingham. This is also the address which appeared on a driver's license issued to him by the State of Alabama. The driver's license identifying data listed his birth date as July 20, 1931, his height as 5'll", his weight as 170 and his eyes blue and hair brown.

The automobile in question, the white Mustang bearing the Alabama tags mentioned above, was recovered in Atlanta on 4/11/68 and determined to have been abandoned there prior to 9 a.m. on 4/5/68.

In connection with the evidence submitted by Atlanta, Birmingham, and Memphis, identifiable latent prints were recovered. It was on the basis of these latents that identification was made of JAMES EARL RAY. In handling future leads, all offices should be particularly interested in securing an identifying number, military, police, or FBI, in connection with suspects so that the necessary check can be made through the Identification Division.

On 4/17/68, AUSA R. MACEY TAYLOR, Birmingham, authorized the filing of a complaint charging ERIC STARVO GALT with a conspiracy to violate Section 241. Title 18. U. S. Code. and

On 4/20/68, JAMES H. PADGETT, 518 East Cook, Bedford, Va., telephone Juo-9114, telephonically advised that on Saturday, 4/13/68, while he was sitting in front of the Courthouse at Bedford, Va., he had observed a new red bottom and white top SS Chevrofet Hardtop, being driven by a Negro male with a Negro female companion in the front seat, and bearing Tengessee tags. As this car passed him approximately 4 yards from where he was sitting, a white male got up from the back seat, and he is convinced that this individual fits the description of GALT (RAY). He stated that he could not get the Tennessee license number, and he stated that he had notified the Va. State Police and the FBI, Richmond, Va., on 4/15/68, and felt that neither organization had taken any action on this information. He stated that he has not seen this car since 4/13/68, and has no idea where the car is located at this time, nor could he furnish the identity of the Negro driver or his companion. He stated that he is convinced this car is in the Bedford area, and he felt this matter should be handled in view of the publicity this week in connection with King's murder.
