

Senior RAs will therefore determine and furnish to such charitable type missions located in their respective territories, the IO for RAY.



The Bureau has further advised for information and investigative assistance, that subject JAMES EARL RAY has been known to consort with prostitutes and "street bums." A photograph of RAY was obtained from a prostitute in Mexico, which is the photograph publicized of RAY, showing him wearing sunglasses.

The Bureau has instructed that the above should be borne in mind in our daily contact with informants, officers of vice squads, and prostitutes, in covering leads in connection with this and other cases.






