THEY REMARRIED ON FEBRUARY 28, 1967, AND SEPARATED ON MARCH 28, 1974. A DECREE OF DIVORCE WAS ENTERED ON JUNE 27, 1974, GRANTING CUSTODY OF TO BETTY LOW WILSON AND REQUIRING BURGESS A.

WILSON TO PAY CHILD SUPPORT. A MOTION FOR CONTEMPT WAS FILED ON AUGUST 19, 1974, AS WILSON WAS IN ARREARS IN CHILD SUPPORT PAYMENTS. THE COURT HAS BEEN UNABLE UNTIL THIS TIME TO LOCATE WILSON FOR THE PURPOSE OF SERVING NECESSARY PAPERS.

ON AUGUST 22, 1978, FRANK ALLEN, PROBATION OFFICER, COMAL COUNTY, TEXAS, ADVISED THAT BURGESS WILSON WAS REFERRED TO HIS OFFICE FOR PRESENTENCE INVESTIGATION.
