GLADDEN ADVISED THAT AT 11:45 PM, ON 8/17/78, WILSON
TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED HIM AT HIS RESIDENCE SAYING HE
HAD TO TALK TO GLADDEN AND HIS WIFE ABOUT SOMETHING THAT
