FBI Sees King Reward As 'Lever'

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (UPI) — Robert Jansen, Federal Bureau of Investigation special agent, yesterday said the \$100,000 in reward money offered for the assassin of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. might be a "lever" to pry open the case.

"I want to be able to tell our agents if there is a reward and how it can be collected," Jensen said. "It could be a lever they need to get some information."

Jensen is the agent in charge of the Memphis FBI office, the field headquarters in the search for the sniper who killed King April 4 as he stood on the balcony of the Lorraine Motel here.

REWARD DATA

Jensen made the comment while getting information about the reward from the offices here of the Memphis Commercial Appeal and Press-Scimitar.

The newspapers began the reward fund the morning after King's murder. It was doubled later that day when the Scripps-Howard group, owners of both newspapers, matched the newspapers' \$25,000 offer.

The fund grew later when the Memphis City Council appealed for public contributions and underwrote a reward of \$100,000 in the case.

In Atlanta yesterday, Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark said he remains confident "law enforcement will break the case." Clark added. "I had hoped we would have an arrest by this time.

SNIPER ALONE?

Clark said the FBI still believes only the sniper was in Memphis at the time King was shot and that other members of the conspiracy the FBI has said existed did not take part in the actual slaying.

Meanwhile, a Los Angeles woman now staying in a Milwaukee hotel was visited by an FBI man and a Milwaukee detective after she was named in a syndicated column as the girl friend of James Earl Ray.

Louis Lomax of the North American Newspaper Alliance identified the girl as "Jerrie." She told a reporter and officers that she did not recognize a picture of Ray and had not heard the names James Earl Ray, Eric Starvo Galt or any of the other alliases Ray has used.

American Touring in Mexico Is Quizzed in Slaying of King

MEXICO CITY (AP) — Mexican authorities questioned a U.S. citizen today they said resembles the man wanted on a charge of slaying Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., then released him without pressing any charges.

Daniel David Kennedy, 41, of Baltimore, who said he was on a walking tour of Sonora State, denied any connection with King's death.

An FBI agent, identified only as Mr. Smith, said there was no resemblance between Kennedy and the suspect, James Earl Ray, according to police in the city of Hermosillo.

Taken Into Custody

Lt. Roberto Fletcher of the judicial police in Caborca, Sonora, had taken Kennedy into custody from a Caborca hotel.

In Baltimore, Kennedy's mother, Pearl E. Kennedy, said, "There is just no connection. He doesn't even look like him (Ray).

"It was impossible for him to do it," said Mrs. Kennedy. "He wouldn't even kill a fly, let alone kill a human being."

Wanted to Take Off

Mrs. Kennedy said her son left Baltimore March 24 to go to Mexico — "he wanted to take off, that's all" — and that he telephoned her from there on Sunday.

"He was so happy when he talked to me," said Mrs. Kennedy. "He said people were so friendly to him there, because everything was so peaceful and quiet."

Fletcher said earlier that the man he was holding made a telephone call this week to Baltimore asking that money be sent him in Caborca.

Fletcher said he picked the man up about 6 p.m. yesterday in Caborca, about 80 miles southwest of Nogales, Ariz.

Crossed Border

The officer said he took the man in because of his similar-

Fletcher said the man crossed the border at Nogales on April 7 and told him he had walked to Caborca.

Police in Ciudad Victoria detained another man briefly 10 days ago because he fit the general description of Ray. There have also been reports from several other Mexican cities of persons spotting men resembling Ray.

The FBI announced April 17 that it was seeking a man identified as Eric Starvo Galt in connection with King's slaying in Memphis on April 4.

Escaped Prison

Two days later, the bureau said a "systematic and exhaustive search" through its fingerprint files revealed that Galt and Ray, a 40-year-old drifter and prison escapee, were the same.

Ray fled from the Missouri Penitentiary on April 23, 1967, while he was serving the seventh year of a 20-year sentence for a market holdup and

Ray was described as 5-foot-10, 163 to 174 pounds, with brown hair, blue eyes and small scars on his forehead and right palm. He was said to have a habit of tugging on an ear when nervous. His left ear protrudes slightly further than his right ear.

Authorities said Ray had worked at various times as a laborer, baker and colormatcher.

Mexico Frees King Suspect

HERMOSILLO, Mexico (UPI)

King Jr., was released yesterday with apologies by state authorities.

Daniel D. Kennedy, 42, had been arrested Wednesday in Caborca, 80 miles southwest of Nogales, Ariz., and questioned for 12 hours before being brought to this Sonora state capital.

State police turned him loose with apologies less than two hours after his arrival here. Kennedy left state police head-quarters saying he wanted to continue his trip to Guaymas.

Arnold Denys, American vice council in Hermosillo said Kennedy has been "completely eliminated" as a suspect through a check by Hermosillo police of his background, circumstances, facial features and fingerprints.

MEDIA AID IN SEARCH

Pre-Trial Publicity Justified

Can there be many Americans who do not know much about Eric Starvo Galt, alias John Willard, alias Harvey Lowmyer and also apparently known as James Earl Ray?

In recent weeks we have learned that this person, sought in connection with the insane slaying of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., is an escaped convict from Missouri.

We have learned through the press and electronics media that he is a hard drinker, likes to dance, has aggressive tendencies, where he lived, the kind of car he drove and where he visited, the guns he purchased, his political leanings, his occupations, what his cellmate thought of him and many other things.

Much of the information represents the hard, traditional work of the press. Much of it, including photographs, was released by law enforcement agencies.

The purpose of this proper volume of information and publicity is to bring Ray before the bar of justice to question him about the slaving of Dr. King.

It is a legitimate purpose, an excellent and traditional co-operative effort between the press and law enforcement. If history is an indicator, the publicity will eventually lead to the arrest and a fair trial for Ray.

Ironically, if more recent history also sets a pattern the informational spigot regarding Ray will be turned off abruptly after he is arrested.

And the authority for the silence likely will be the Reardon Report of the American Bar Association. In that report, the ABA group recommends that law enforcement officers give little more than the name, "rank and serial number" of persons arrested.

The case of Eric Starvo Galt or James Earl Ray is a dramatic one and public interest is high. The public has been asked to co-operate in apprehension of the suspect and has a right to the information.

This does not mean in any sense, however, that Galt/Ray will not be able to get a fair trial in the United States of America. We submit that Americans who have not heard of Ray probably could not be on a jury that eventually hears his case.

We have the utmost faith that he will be able to get an impartial trial on the basis of the evidence submitted in court, regardless of the publicity that is essential for his apprehension.

And when Ray does come to trial, the Reardon Report and the American Bar Association's penchant for denying the public its right to know crime news also will be before a jury — the American people.

People should see clearly the illogic of saying a fair trial is not possible with widespread publicity. In the Ray case this is not locking the barn door after the horse is gone. The door was never closed and never should be.

On May 1, 1968, Missouri State Penitentiary (MSP) records were checked for RAY EUGENE WARREN. The following information was obtained:

RAY EUGENE WARREN was received at the MSP on June 9, 1955, to serve a 10 year sentence on charge of robbery first degree by means of a dangerous and deadly weapon under court case #1941-C. He completed this sentence and began an additional 20 year sentence on July 11, 1961, on charge of robbery first degree by means of a dangerous and deadly weapon, court case number 1945-C. He was assigned MSP number 69963. WARREN was discharged by commutation of sentence from April 13, 1968. Relatives listed on WARREN's correspondence and visiting list are wife DORIS WARREN, 3330 Sims, St. Anne, Missouri; brother-in-law BILL SCOTT, same address; sister, BETTY WARREN, Route 2, Box 187, Robertson, Missouri. Records reflect that WARREN was visited by his mother and brother, PAUL WARREN, Robertson, Missouri, and brother, SCOTT WARREN, Pomona, California. While WARREN was in the MSP, he was in the following cells:

From November 6, 1959, until January 4, 1960, G70; From January 4, 1960, until July 1, 1960, G89; From Jly 1, 1960, until August 31, 1960, C20; From August 31, 1960, until October 31, 1960, E80; October 31, 1960, until January 6, 1961, E33; January 6, 1961, until March 17, 1961, F96.

Warden HAROLD SWENSON advised confidentially that WARREN had assisted his department in an investigation which had been conducted and that from November, 1965, until after JAMES EARL RAY escaped from the MSP, that WARREN was in solitary confinement being given maximum security for fear of his life. Warden SWENSON continued that if at all possible, WARREN should not be contacted as he is extremely nervous and fearful for his life. However, Warden SWENSON advised that WARREN is to be living with his brother, SCOTT L. WARREN at 17902 Edmond Place, Covina, California.

SINCE WARREN WAS SENTENCED TO THE MSP FOR A TOTAL PERIOD OF 30 YEARS ON CHARGE OF ROBBERY WITH A DANGEROUS AND DEADLY WEAPON AND IS EXTREMELY NERVOUS, HE SHOULD BE APPROACHED WITH CAUTION AND POSSIBLY CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS.
