Result of examination:

Significant differences were noted as the result of comparing the "William A. Marshall" signatures on Q343 and Q344 with the known handwriting of JAMES EARL RAY, K171, K211 and K257, indicating that the questioned Marshall signatures were probably not prepared by Ray.

Because of variations within the limited questioned signatures a definite conclusion was not reached.

Q343 and Q344 are temporarily retained. Photographs were made.

Mr. EDWIN WILSON, 1328 Ynez Street, Coronado, California, care of the Oxford Hotel, was contacted by SA ARNOLD W. O'BRIEN on 5/21/68 and the receipt of his letter at the Bureau was acknowledged.

He was questioned as to any additional information in his possession which would indicate the whereabouts of JAMES EARL RAY.

Mr. WILSON advised that he had previously been employed as a dishwasher in a number of establishments at Hot Springs, Arkansas, and had observed a number of hoodlums and gangsters who frequent in this area.

Because of this element at Hot Springs, Arkansas, Mr. WILSON had the "feeling" that JAMES EARL RAY might be hiding out at Hot Springs, Arkansas.

Mr. WILSON had nothing upon which to base this "feeling" and he was thanked for his interest in this matter.

On 5/20/68, Lieutenant CLIFF REED, National City Police Department, telephonically contacted the San Diego Office and furnished the following information:

REED advised that he had just been contacted by STEVEN CLIMER, age 20, and DAVID PARKS, age 20, of 1138 East 20th Street, National City, California, who advised REED that at twelve noon and again at 9:30 p.m., 5/19/68, they had been talking to a man who resembled JAMES EARL RAY.

The man had been at Cesar's Cocktail Lounge, Tijuana, B.C., Mexico. The man told CLIMER and PARKS that he was staying with a Lieutenant JACOBY (phonetic) in Chula Vista. Lieutenant JACOBY had purchased this individual an airline ticket to someplace back East, but this individual went to Los Angeles, cashed the airline ticket at Los Angeles, and came back to Tijuana for the bullfights.

Lieutenant REED was recontacted by SA ARNOLD W. O'BRIEN on 5/21/68 and advised he had no additional information and that CLIMER seemed to be the individual knowing Unknown Subject better than PARKS.

STEVEN CLIMER, 1138 East 20th Street, National City, California, was contacted by SA O'BRIEN on 5/21/68 and advised as follows:

At approximately twelve noon, 5/19/68, STEVEN CLIMER and a friend, DAVID PARKS, had occasion to be in Cesar's Cocktail Lounge, Tijuana, B.C., Mexico.

CLIMER entered Cesar's Cocktail Lounge by himself and was later joined by DAVID PARKS. Shortly after entering, an individual came in and sat next to him. This individual started a conversation with CLIMER and told him the following concerning himself:

He stated that he was staying in either Chula Vista or San Diego and seemed vague about the area with a Lieutenant JACOBY (phonetic) and that this Lieutenant JACOBY had purchased an airline ticket for him to return somewhere back East.

This individual advised that he took a flight from San Diego, California, to Los Angeles, California, where he cashed in his airline ticket. He then took a Greyhound bus from Los Angeles to San Diego with the idea of returning to Tijuana, B.C., Mexico, to see the bullfights. This individual advised that he also purchased a train ticket to return to somewhere in New York State. This individual showed CLIMER the train ticket and he noted the final destination was New York State and the total price was eighty seven dollars and a few odd cents. This individual also advised that he purchased meal tickets for his train trip back East.

This individual advised that he was going to leave California on Monday evening, 5/20/68.

At this time, this individual advised CLIMER that he needed a place to stay and asked CLIMER if he resided by himself, at which time CLIMER advised that he stayed with his mother and was unable to bring this individual to his house.

CLIMER's friend, PARKS, then entered the bar and observed this individual briefly.

CLIMER and PARKS again returned to Cesar's Cocktail Lounge at approximately 9:30 p.m., 5/19/68, at which time they again saw the same individual at the end of the bar. On this occasion, they had no contact or conversation with him.

On 5/20/68, CLIMER had occasion to view a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY in the Chula Vista newspaper and stated that there was a resemblance between JAMES EARL RAY and the individual he had contact with at Cesar's Cocktail Lounge.

Mr. TOM LOWE, Ticket Agent, Santa Fe Railroad Station, San Diego, California, was contacted and he made inquiry among other ticket agents to determine if the above unknown individual had purchased a ticket recently to the State of New York. None of the ticket agents could recall such an incident and were unable to identify photographs of JAMES EARL RAY.

Mr. LOWE advised the fare from San Diego to New York City is \$109.55, one way. The only \$87.00 fare to New York State is Jamestown, New York, for \$87.18. Mr. LOWE also advised that meal tickets can be purchased to pay for the meals en route to any destination.

On 5/21/68, PAMI Locator, 11th Naval District, was contacted to determine if there are any Lieutenant JACOBYs in the San Diego area, at which time, it was determined that the only Lieutenant JACOBY in the 11th Naval District is Lieutenant ROBERT M. JACOBY, Serial Number 698811, stationed at Point Mugu, California.

On 5/20/68, Mr. LARRY ROBERTS, Bartender, Stan's Chula Room, 247 Broadway, Chula Vista, California, was contacted by SA ARNOLD W. O'BRIEN and he advised that the person who was at the bar between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 1:00 a.m., 5/17/68, who was engaged in an argument with another customer, is RAYMOND PENDLETON, who is employed for Rohr Construction Company, Chula Vista, California.

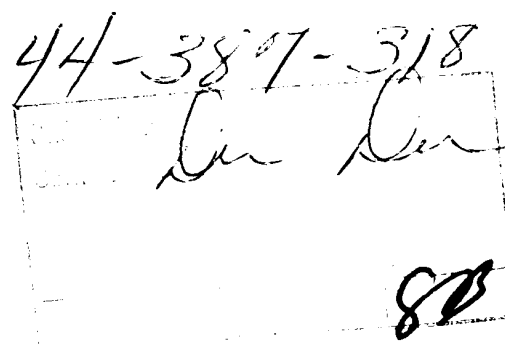
Photographs of JAMES EARL RAY were displayed to Mr. ROBERTS and he advised that they have some similarity to RAY PENDLETON, but he is sure that PENDLETON is not identical with JAMES EARL RAY.

Mr. RAY PENDLETON, Rohr Construction Company, Chula Vista, California, was interviewed by SA ARNOLD W. O'BRIEN on 5/20/68, at which time PENDLETON was eliminated as being identical with JAMES EARL RAY from observation. RAY PENDLETON was no more than 29-30 years of age, and although he had some facial characteristics of RAY, could not in any way be identical.

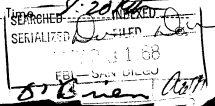
This date at 8:20 PM, Steven Oliver, 20 yrs, and David Parks, 19 yrs, both of 1138 E 20th Street, National City (417-1276) came to station to state they had observed James Earl Ray (Slayer of Dr. Martin Luther King) in Trapani. Oliver states they first observed subject in Caesar's Bar, Trapani, about noon on 5-19-68. Oliver said he engaged in conversation with subject and was told subject was staying with a friend in Chula Vista. The friend purchased a plane ticket to New York for suspect. Suspect stated he flew to Los Angeles, checked in ticket and returned by bus to Trapani to watch the bull fights. He used money to purchase a train ticket back to New York. Oliver stated suspect showed him ticket. Oliver and Parks left Caesar's returning about 9:30 PM. At this time suspect still observed at bar. Neither Oliver or Parks engaged in further conversation.

Both witnesses say suspect is identical to picture except he has shorter hair - suspect wearing lt blue shirt and dark pants.

On May 20, 1968, THOMAS E. JOHNSON, San Diego County Sheriff's Office, El Cajon Substation, telephonically contacted the San Diego Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and furnished the following information:

JOHNSON advised that he had been contacted by a fourteen-year-old boy named [REDACTED], [REDACTED], Chula Vista, California. [REDACTED] told him that while he was getting ready to leave the area in front of the Chula Vista library where ROBERT F. KENNEDY had just spoke, he was approached by a man who resembled JAMES EARL RAY. This man asked [REDACTED] where and when KENNEDY was to speak again. When told that he did not know where and when KENNEDY was to speak, this individual then asked him the location of a good place to eat with a telephone. [REDACTED] felt that the man with whom he spoke looked very similar to a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY appearing in a recent issue of the Chula Vista "Star News."

Mr. WILLIAM DOBREVIR, "Citizens for Kennedy," KENNEDY Campaign Headquarters, San Diego, California, was contacted on May 20, 1968, at which time he advised that ROBERT F. KENNEDY had departed the San Diego, California, area en route to Los Angeles, California.

Mr. DOBREVIR was advised of the information furnished by [REDACTED] and he stated that he would relay this information to the KENNEDY Campaign Headquarters at Los Angeles, California.

Deputy Sheriff THOMAS E. JOHNSON, San Diego County Sheriff's Office, El Cajon Substation, El Cajon, California, was recontacted on May 21, 1968 and advised that he had no further information to relate concerning information furnished to him by [REDACTED], except to state that [REDACTED] resides in his immediate neighborhood and considers him a highly reliable young man.

[REDACTED], Chula Vista, California, was interviewed on May 21, 1968 and he advised as follows:

[REDACTED] had occasion to be present at the campaign speech of ROBERT F. KENNEDY at the Civic Center, Chula Vista, California, on May 20, 1968. A short time after the speech by Mr. KENNEDY ended, which was then approximately 5:20 to 5:30 p.m., an individual closely resembling JAMES EARL RAY approached him and asked him if KENNEDY had made his speech yet. When told that he had, this individual appeared surprised and then asked where KENNEDY was going to speak next.

[REDACTED] stated that he had a schedule of Mr. KENNEDY's appearances in the San Diego area and told this individual that his next appearance would be at San Ysidro, California.

This individual asked [REDACTED] where there was a good place to eat where he could obtain a telephone. He also asked him if there was a telegraph office in San Ysidro, to which [REDACTED] replied he could not furnish this information as he did not know.

[REDACTED] described this individual as approximately forty years of age, white, male, American, five feet eight inches to five feet nine inches, 160 to 170 pounds, hair medium brown, complexion fair to medium, wearing a blue coat, light-colored slacks and brown shoes.

[REDACTED] advised that prior to seeing this individual he had read an article in the Chula Vista "Star News"

concerning JAMES EARL RAY, which also had a photograph of RAY in the paper. According to [REDACTED] the individual who contacted him at Chula Vista closely resembled JAMES EARL RAY.

On May 21, 1968, Mrs. ELSIE ZUNIGA, Manager, Western Union Office, San Ysidro, California, advised she usually closes the Western Union office at 5:00 p.m. on a daily basis; however, on May 20, 1968 she closed the office at 4:45 p.m. in order to go to the campaign speech of ROBERT F. KENNEDY.

Photographs of JAMES EARL RAY were displayed to Mrs. ZUNIGA and she advised that she has not seen anyone fitting his description in the San Ysidro, California, area.
