

A call to telephone number 26200126 revealed that the Campbell Truck Co. is now located at 1540 Tidelands Ave in National City. Mr. Dwayne Campbell the owner telemonically advised as follows:

OLIVER was first employed by him as roximately three years ago. He was subsequently released because he was not producing on the job. OLIVER than went to work for the GEORGIA PACIFIC Co. in National "ity. He worked there "or a while and than went to work as a deep sea fisherman. OLIVER camb back to work for CAMPBELL on February 9, 1968 and quit his job on April 12, 1968.

MR. CAMPBELL stated that OLIV'R was an excellent worker and that he hated to see him leave. According to CAMPRELL OLIVER stated hewas leaving because he was having a lot of trouble with his former wife. She has been in a lot of trouble for drinking and OLIVER has been paying her a lot of momey for her support and the support of the two children. Recause of her drinking, however, the children are not benefiting from the money and OLIVER decided to leave the area and not pay her any more money.

CAMPBELL described OLIVER as follows:

EVERET ANTHONY OLIVER Age: About 28 yrs ald. Height: About 5' 10" Weight: About 200 lbs. Dark Hair: Complexion: Dark Eyes: Brown Address: 8810 Joris - Las Masa Marital Status: Divorced

On 5/23/68 LEOBARDO CORNEJO, Officer, Secret Service, Tijuana PD, Tijuana, B.C., Mexico, accompanied SA MUNOZ to Cassar's Hotel cocktail bar, where photo of JAMES EARL RAY was exhibited to RAUL MONTEMAYOR, maitre d'hotel. He, in turn, exhibited the photo to (FMU) CISNERGS VAZQUEZ, bartender, who exhibited the photo to the bartenders. RAUL MONTEMAYOR advised that the photo of JAMES EARL RAY, where he appeared wearing a bow tie, appeared to resemble several individuals who were known to him to be Mexicans and who came to the hotel dining room at infrequent intervals. Copies of the photo of JAMES EARL RAY were left with Mr. MONTEMAYOR to be exhibited to other employees. Mr. MONTEMAYOR was instructed to contact the Chtf of Police, Tijuana, B.C., Mexico, in the event that any individual resembling RAY was observed at the hotel or in the cocktail lounge.

(FNU) CISNEROS VAZQUEZ noted that the early photos of JAMES EARL RAY resembled numerous servicemen he had observed in Marine uniform when he, CISNEROS VAZQUEZ, was in San Diego, California. Mr. CISNEROS VAZQUEZ was furnished photos of RAY and was requested to immediately contact the Secret Service at Tijuana PD or the Chief of Police in the event that anyone resembling RAY should be seen on the premises of Caesar's Hotel.

Compten CIVIL RIGHTS - CONSPIRACY; UNLAWFUL FLIGHT TO AVOID CONFINEMENT - ROBBERY

Syropole JAMES EARL RAY, FBI #405 942 G. excaped Missouri State Penitentiary (MSP) 4/23/67, and on 7/20/67 a complaint was filed before USC W. C. SHELRY, Jefferson City. No., charging RAY with unlawful flight to avoid confinement in violation of Title 18, USC, Section 1073. On 4/17/58 an authorized complaint was filed against ERIC STARVO GALT for violation of Title 18. USC. Section 241, charging that he did conspire to injure, oppress, threaten, or intimidate MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., in the free exercise and enjoyment of his rights secured by the Constitution of the Boiled States. Complaint was filed before USC, Birmingham, Ala , by SAC JOSEPH H, GAMBLE, and a warrant was issued for the arrest of GALT. Recommended bond is \$50,000. On 5/7/68 Shelby County GJ, Memphis, returned a secret indictment charging JAMES EARL RAY with murder in the first degree. Chronological listing of subject's activities from 4/67 to 4/68 set forth and reflects he resided briefly at Montreal. Province of Quebec, Canada. He traveled to Birmingham, Ala., purchased a 1966 Ford Mustang, then traveled to Puerto Vallarta, Jalisco, Mexico, for a brief residence, and then to Los Angeles, Calif. Subject made 2 round trips by automobile from los angeles to New Orleans and in 3/68 established residence in Atlanta, Ga. Using the name HARVEY LOWMRYER, a Remington, Wodel 760, rifle was purchased 3/30/68 At 6:00 P.M., 4/4/68 Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., Birmingham, Ala. was shot and killed by a single interest fired from the bathroom of a nearby rooming house while he was standing on the balcony of the Lorraine Motel, Memphis. Same Remington rifle identified above recovered at scene along with other items and personal belongings of the subject. Results of Laboratory examinations of all evidence described herein. Interviews of relatives of JAMES EARL RAY, fellow prisoners, and associates set forth. Subject is described as a loner with no close associates, reportedly on amphetamine, and selling drugs at MSP while incarcerated there. Identification record and description also set forth.
