

youngsters how to dance the dances. Mrs. MARTIN declined and looked into his eyes which were a cold blue and noticed that the pupils were not dilated and that he was not drunk. At the time, she wondered why he would be acting drunk if he were not.

After the ship docked back at San Pedro, Mrs. MARTIN noticed the man get into a white 1966 Mustang with a black interior and a black strip on the door. She recalled his ears she had looked at that type before she herself purchased another style of a 1966 Mustang.

When she read the Life Magazine article regarding RAY in 1968, Mrs. MARTIN realized that the man she had seen on the boat over a year before was RAY, and she realized that he had been in possession of a white 1966 Mustang prior to the time the newspapers and magazines stated he did.

Mrs. MARTIN explained she has had medical problems since 1965 and was taking codene at the time of the boat trip; however, this did not impair her memory of the events. After the trip, she was in the hospital for approximately six months and still takes pain medication to date. She stated she did not "want to get involved" and that is why she never made mention of this matter before now. Mrs. MARTIN advised she is employed by the Pacific Telephone Company in Oceanside, and has recently moved to Oceanside for health reasons.

Mrs. MARTIN stated she is certain the man she observed on the steamship in March, 1967, was RAY as she has seen the photographs of him in the news. The only reason she wanted to mention this matter to the FBI was that she wanted to get the information to the FBI that RAY went to Catalina and had a white Mustang in 1967 in the Los Angeles area. She could furnish no further information in this matter.

The above information is furnished for information purposes to the Bureau and office of origin. No further contact is contemplated with Mrs. MARTIN at San Diego.

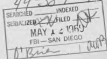

MURKIN

William Bradford Huie has written a third article for "Look" magazine. The article appears in the issue dated April 15, 1969, but this issue was circulated on April 1, 1969. A review of the article reveals that James Earl Ray allegedly registered at the Travelodge Motel, Five Points, Birmingham, Alabama, on March 29, 1968; at a motel near Florence, Alabama, on April 1, 1968; and at a motel near Corinth, Mississippi, on April 2, 1968. It is to be noted that Ray, using the name Harvey Lowmyer, negotiated the purchase of a rifle at the Aeronarine Supply Company, Birmingham, Alabama, on March 29 and 30, 1968. On April 3, 1968, he was registered at the Rebel Motel in Memphis, Tennessee.

In an effort to establish whether or not Ray was in contact with any individuals immediately prior to the assassination, appropriate investigation should be conducted by the Birmingham and Jackson Offices. It should be understood that there is to be no indication made whatsoever that the following investigation has any connection whatsoever with the case involving James Earl Ray.

Birmingham and Jackson Offices should make inquiries of the motels in or near the cities indicated above to determine the identities of individuals registered during the period March 29 to April 3, 1968. Efforts should be made to identify all individuals listed, as well as

obtaining descriptions and registrations for the automobiles of such persons. A review of such records might indicate whether any one individual might have accompanied Ray or been in contact with him during this period. Pertinent or questionable registration records should be obtained if possible for examination by the FBI Laboratory.

Memphis should insure that the Bureau is kept currently advised of pertinent developments in this case, particularly all aspects of court action since the death of Judge Battle on March 31, 1969.

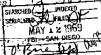

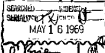

By airtel dated 3/7/69, copies of which were not furnished the Bureau, the Jackson Office set out leads for those offices to whom copies of this communication are designated. These offices have been requested to interview several hundred persons who spent the night in motels at Corinth, Miss., on or about 4/2/68.

In view of the fact that more than a year has passed since these persons stayed over night at Corinth, and since similar investigation of this type in this case has previously been unproductive, and since GUE has admitted that RAY frequently is untruthful in statements to him, and further since it is not believed that it is of any particular importance to establish whether or not JAMES EARL RAY stayed over night at Corinth on 4/2/68, all offices will disregard the leads set out in Jackson airtel dated 3/7/69 unless specifically advised by the Bureau to cover same.

TASK FORCE MEMBERS HAVE TRAVELED TO MEMPHIS, MILWAUKEE, KANSAS CITY, OMAHA, SAN FRANCISCO AND LOS ANGELES AND REVIEWED MURKIN AND INTELLIGENCE INVESTIGATION FILES OF THOSE OFFICES. FUTURE TRAVEL BY THE TASK FORCE IS PLANNED FOR ATLANTA, BIRMINGHAM, CHARLOTTE, CHICAGO, NEW ORLEANS, NEW YORK, SPRINGFIELD AND ST. LOUIS.

AFTER ABOVE TRAVEL IS COMPLETED AND KING RELATED SECURITY FILES AT FBING ARE REVIEWED, THE TASK FORCE WILL HAVE SEEN THE MAJORITY OF SERIALS IN OUR FILES RELATING TO THE KING INVESTIGATIONS. 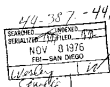

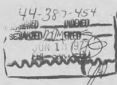
