Re Albany airtels 4/10/68 and 4/11/68, setting forth concerns who purchased Thermo-Seal marking machines, and Bureau teletype to Memphis, 4/12/68.

The FBI Laboratory advised that pillowcase and bed sheet were found in trunk of 1966 white Mustang registered to ERIC STARVO GALT, which was located at Atlanta 4/11/68. These items contain Thermo-Seal laundry tapes of approximately same size as tapes on items previously recovered, but are yellow in color and contain code, "20R-3." In opinion of Textile Marking Machine Company, Syracuse, New York, the tapes were produced by a different machine than previous tapes since the first three characters are 15 point type and the last two characters are 18 point type.

The Textile Marking Machine Company suggests the twenty in above code would be the lot number, the R may mean that this was a return of a batch of laundry, and the three is the bundle number.

At 9:25 a.m. this date, Mr. ALLEN A. GRAY, mgr., Albertson's Food Store, Lake Forest Park Shopping Center, tel: EM 3-5397, telephonically advised that on last Tuesday or Wednesday he had just opened the above mentioned store and noticed that a man purchased a morning issue of the PI by placing a dime on the counter of an unmanned check stand. This occurred about nine o'clock in the morning, just after opening of the store.

GRAY said that the PI on this particlur morning carried pictures of the suspect in MURKIN and that he was sitting at his desk which was about 15 ft. from the checkstand. He saw only a quick sideview of this unknown man but after thinking about the matter for a day or two he thought that this unknown resembled the suspect in MURKIN in light of the news this weekend about a man attempting to go to Canada. GRAY did not know where this unknown man came from or how he left the store and general area. He has never seen this man before and does recognized as a store customer.

Gray was unable to describe the unknown man other that to state that he was wearing dirty clothes but generally looked 1 ke the pictures which appeared in the PI on that date. GRAY could not recall the hair, ears, specific clothes or any other features of the unknown man.

Gray apologized for his vagueness and felt we would condider him a crack pot; nevertheless, he felt he ought to call in what little he had.

It was suggested to him that if this unknown mancame to the store again it would be a great help if a licenses number of the vehicle driven by this man could be obtained.

At about 6 p.m. on 4/4/68, while standing on the second floor balcony outside Room 306 of the Lorraine Motel, 406 Mulberry Street, Memphis, Tennessee, Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. was struck in the right side of the face by a single bullet fired from a 30-06 rifle. The bullet severed KING's spinal cord and death was almost instantaneous.

This investigation, predicated upon a specific request from the Attorney General of the United States, disclosed that the fatal shot had been fired from the bathroom of a cheap rooming house located at 422½ South Main Street, Memphis, which bathroom was located at the rear of the rooming house, and had a window overlooking the Lorraine Motel.

At about 3 p.m. on 4/4/68, an individual using the name JOHN WILLARD had rented Room 5-B in the rooming house at 4222 South Main Street and had paid one week's rent. After hearing the rifle shot at about 6 p.m. on that same day, other tenants in the rooming house observed a man presumably identical with WILLARD, fleeing from the rooming house carrying a large package which was subsequently abandoned by him on the sidewalk in front of the Canipe Amusement Co., 424 South Main Street, Hemphis. A neighborhood investigation in the vicinity of 424 South Main Street disclosed that the subject had fled from the scene in a white Mustang.

Found abandoned in front of 424 South Main Street was a 30-06 Remington model 760 rifle which was determined to have been

sold to one HARVEY LOWMEYER on 3/30/68 by Aeromarine Supply Co., Birmingham, Alabama.

Investigation at Memphis disclosed that an individual had purchased a set of binoculars at the York Arms Company in Memphis on 4/4/68. These binoculars were among the material abandoned with the rifle and recovered in Memphis. Also recovered was a brown and green herringbone bedspread. The items abandoned in Memphis were all wrapped in this bedspread. The blue bag which was inside the bedspread contained numerous items, among which were the binoculars and a set of underwear consisting of a T-shirt and shorts. The T-shirt and shorts are those on which appears the laundry mark which has been a matter of interest in this case.

A search of motel records in the Memphis area disclosed that an individual using the name ERIC S. GALT had spent the night of 4/3/68 at the Rebel Motel, Memphis, Tennessee, and was driving a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama License 1-3893.

Investigation at Birmngham disclosed that this automobile had been purchased by ERIC S. GALT on August 30, 1968, from a private person in response to a newspaper ad. He paid a total of \$1995 cash. While in Birmingham he furnished the address of 2608 South Highland Avenue, Birmingham. This is also the address which appeared on a driver's license issued to him by the State of Alabama. The driver's license identifying data listed his birth date as \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_, his height as 5'11", his weight as 170 and his eyes blue and hair brown.

The automobile in question, the white Mustang bearing the Alabama tags mentioned above, was recovered in Atlanta on 4/11/68 and determined to have been abandoned there prior to 9 a.m. on 4/5/68.

In connection with the evidence submitted by Atlanta, Birmingham, and Memphis, identifiable latent prints were recovered. It was on the basis of these latents that identification was made of JAMES EARL RAY. In handling future leads, all offices should be particularly interested in securing an identifying number, military, police, or FBI, in connection with suspects so that the necessary check can be made through the Identification Division.

On 4/17/68, AUSA R. MACEY TAYLOR, Birningham, authorized the filing of a complaint charging ERIC STARVO GALT with a conspiracy to violate Section 241, Title 18, U.S. Code, and

recommended bond in the amount \$50,000. On that same date, SAC JOSEPH E. GAMBLE filed a complaint before USC MILDRED F. SPRAGUE, Birmingham, and warrant was issued that same date.







On 4/20/68 ROBERT RICHARDSON, 1706 - 14th E, Seattle, EA 4-9588, advised at approximately 1PM he had just dropped off at the Greyhound Bus Station a hitchhiker he had picked up about 4PM, 4/19/68 on the freeway near Vallejo, Calif.

After leaving off the man, RICHARDSON had gone to his residence, and on opening his morning P-I, saw a photograph of the hitchhiker looking back at him from the front page. The photo he recognized was the one on the right of the 3, the one with the tousled hair.

RICHARDSON advised the man was not carrying any luggage, but was described generally as listed in the paper. He had no hat, was wearing denim trousers, a cotton shirt, work boots. He was carrying a short jacket, later described to SA EARL as being blue. He was sun-tanned. He has over \$100 with him.

He said he was Canadian and that he was going to Vancouver, B.C. He said he had been hitchhiking from Miami.

He was advised by RICHARDSON that he probably could not hitchhike into Canada, but would have to take a bus. Mr. RICHARDSON thought the man had a Southern accent. The man had given him a name, but RICHARDSON did not recall same.

RICHARDSON appeared so sincere as to be still shaking from the possibility he had driven JAMES RAY up from California.

RICHARDSON agreed to come down to Greyhound Station and help SAs locate suspect. SAs ZANDER, CHIPMAN, EARL, RUBIN and McFAUL contacted to assist.

SACadvised of allegations; directed group to check stations, scour the area - taverns, and to alert R/A at Bellingham to have Canadian authorities to check incoming cars and busses for suspects. SRA CONNOR requested to check 1:45 M bus at Everett, en route Vancouver, B.C. Ho was many 03 Lettors Legis.



At approximately noon thid: date SULLIVAN and his wife were driving north on the road that passes in front of the Free Methodist Conference grounds at Warm Beach, when they noticed a man walking south who appeared to be lost. After taking a closer look at him, SULLIVAN remarked to his wife that he closely resembled JAMES EARL RAY.

This evening while watching the news on TV MRS. SULLIVAN learned that it is believed that RAY may possibly be in the area. Because of this she felt there is a possibility the man on the road may be the suspect.

SULLIVAN described the man as medium height, about 160 lbs., dark hair combed back, not too short, about 30-35 years, wearing what may be blue denim coveralls, although he could not be sure on this pokint.. SULLIVAN stated that the man was walking south and they passed him driving north.

At approximately 12:50PM this date ROBERT E. RECHARDSON, 1706 14th Avenue. Seattle telephoned this office and furnished information to SA KETCHAN as set forth in his memo.

Sa KETCHAM immediately telephoned to Standby SAs ZHNDER and CHIPMAN, as well as SA's EARLE, RUBIN and McFAUL. Coverage was effected as set forth in SA KETCHAM's memo; taverns, Cafes, in immediate area of Greyhound Bus Depot, alerting all Greyhound Bus terminal employees and personally observing entire loading of passengers of 4:00PM, 6:15PM, 8:00PM Greyhound buses for Vanchuver B.C. (Bus departure of Trailways Bus to be covered at 10:PM and 2:15AM Greyhound also, by SAs CHIPMAN and ZANDER. Subject was not observed to get on any of the above mentioned three Greyhound buses. The 1:45PM Bus (Greyhound was checked by Everett while enroute to VBC.

SA's CHIPMAN and EARLE obtained a cardboard sign approximately 23 inces long by 12 inches wide, with the word CANALA drawn in large blue letters thereon, from Mr. richardson. He stated the Unsub used this sign to attract his attention to the fact he was hitchhiking a ride to Canada. Unsub also left a Texaco California road map in RICHARDSON's car, which was obtained.

SA ZANDER also covered Aurora Avenue early in the afternoon for possible hitch hikers, and SA EARL covered this same area later in the Afternoon, as well a s spot checking the entrances to the freeway in the downtown area, as unsub told RICHARDSON he usually waited at the entrances to freeways in hitchiking rides out of large cities. SA ZANDER also covered the departure of the Great Northern International out of Seattle at 3:30PM.

List of Taverns and Cafes, etc covered will be set forth in separate memorandum.

In talking personally to Mr. RICHARDSON after his telephonic contact with SA KETCHAM he furnished the following

information to SA's CHIPMAN and EARLE:

He had just crosped the Carquinez Bridge coming out of Vallejo, California ehroute from San Francisco to Seattle. when he observed unsub standing beside the highway kuning holding a cardboard sign with the word CANADA on it in large blue letters. The man appeared faitly neat and presentable, and RICHARDSON stopped and picked him up, as RICHARDSON was alone in his 1967 Cadilaac. RICHARDSON was very surprised to observe the man had no luggage whatsoever, and was not wearing a hat.

He appeared to be very tanned, almost sun burned, and said he has been in the Bahamas during the past two months and was enroute to Vancouver, Canada where he hoped to obtain a job in He claimed he hitch hiked an airplane ride Construction. from the Bahamas to Miami, and then had hitchhiked all the way from Miami, coming through Alabama, Louisiana, Texas, New Mexico, and colorado.

He claimed that he originally had been in Calgary, Canada, and was Canadian, however RICHARDSON's wife is from Canada and the RICHARDSON lived there three years, and he did not feel this man was from Canada, as he did not talk like a Canadian. Further he said he had been in Vancouver previously, but on conversing about Vancouver, RICHARDSON found that unsub did not appear to know anything about Vancouver. He did, however know a great deal about the southern states and mentioned having been in Alabama, knew Miamix quite well, had been in Louisiana, Arkansas, and Texas, especially Houston.

RICHARDSON advised he urged this man to take the Bus out of Seattle, as there is a law in Washington against hitchhikeing, and the Unsub agreed it was probably a good idea.

He had several twenty dollar bills in his wallet.

After thinking on the matter, RICHARDSON believed this After thinking on the matter, RICHARD man introduced himself to R as Tommy Sanders.

The man wanted to be let out at the Greyhound Bus Terminalx, and as he was about to depart Richardson's car he asked the direction of Downtown Seattle, commenting, "I may look around the town and then came back and catch the Bas". RICHARDSON said RICHARDSON said to walk down to fourth Ave and turn left. Bus Deport at about 11:5\$AM, and observed unsub went in the front door of the Bus Depot.

RICHARDSON then drove home, went into his apartment and a short time later glanced at the morning PI. He received a real shock, when he observed the photo of James Earl Ray, aka GALT, the one on the right of the three photos (attached to the original of this memo.) He had a very strong feeling this was the man he had driven from California to Washington. He immediately called the Seattle FBI.

He then drove down to the Greyhound Depot, arriving possibly about 1:05PM, looked around but did not see the Unsub. He later spoke with SA's CHIPMAN and EARLE, after which SA BARLE took RICHARDSON and drove around the downtown area, looking for the unsub without success for about forty five minutes.

# King Conspiracy Hinted; Galt Is Drifter's Alias





THESE ARE THREE pictures of the prime suspect sought in the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King. The sketch (center) is an artist's conception drawn immediately after the assassination. Note the marked resemblance of the sketch to the 1960 photo (left) of James Earl Ray, 40, also known as Eric Starvo Galt. At right is another photo of Ray, whom the FBI yesterday identified as Galt. This photo was made while Ray was in prison.

The photo of RAY which closely resembled unsub is shown above denoted by the arrow. RICHARDSON observed, however that unsub's hair was soemwhat shorter than in PI photo with arrow.

Unsub said he had been wearing his hair crew cut but was now letting it grow out, and it appeared to be about in between, and unsub several times rubbed his hand through his hair and complained about his hair being unruly. Said he might go and buy a hat.

Unsub had no belongings, not even a razor, and borrowed RTCHARDSON's razor and shaved as they were driving through. Unsub said he was very fond of beer, and had several enroute when they made stops.

When Unsub discovered RICHARDSON carries a revolver, while traveling they briefly discussed guns, and unsub seemed to be knowlexed eable concerning them. Unsub seemed very interested in hundting, and when RICHARDSON said he has a small ranch in Canada with a hunting cabin, between KAMLOOPS and LILLOOETE, unsub said he had been in KAMLOOPS, however he did not know where LILOOETE (sp?) was, and RICHARDSON observed it is on the way to KAMLOOPS.


