



Mrs. ELINOR LAIRD, Credit Reporter, Credit Bureau of Findlay, Ohio, advised THIMAS EUGENE CRAMER had been known to her files since 1961 and there was a notation that he had been divorced from a BETTY JIWISE in November, 1961; no other information.

Mrs. BETTY J. CRAMER, 342 Trenton, advised she divorced THOMAS EUGENE CRAMER in 1961 and had only seen him about once a year since when he had come to see their shild. 'She stated he re-married and she believed he left a second wife. She stated the last she knew he was driving an old Lincoln Continental.

She stated that on no occasion had she ever heard him mention the Nazi Party, attending any special meetings, of: any kind, nor had she ever heard him mention Dr. KING. She had no idea as to the whereabouts of subject, but advised his mother, MARY KENNEDY and a sister, FRANCES, lived in Findlay.

Mrs. MARY KENNEDY. 1209 Concord Street, advised that talked to her son's wife, GLINDA, in Chicago, by telephone, and that GLINDA, who is also known as DINK, lives at 3322 West Palmer Street, Chicago, telephone 312-772-4691. She stated GLINDA is employed at Sally's Beauty Shop, Broadway and Addison Streets, Chicago, telephone 312-WE-5-3510. She advised when talking to GLINDA, GLINDA told her THOMAS had left and gone to Seattle, Washington, where he lived in some motel, but that he reportedly had checked out of this hotel; also that she believed he had been working at some sporting. goods store. Mrs. KENNEDY had no idea as to the present whereabouts of her son, THOMAS EUGENE CRAMER, and advised that the person he would get in touch with would be his wife, GLINDA. She advised that her son had left the Findley area a year ago and she had not seen him in four or five months. She advised that her son did at one time go with a young man named DAVE SHAW, but she did not know the whereabouts of this DAVE SHAW. She said that in her opinion, her son needed psychiatric treatment, and has been known to tell tall stories when he has been drinking. Further, she stated she recalled hearing that her son had at one time telephoned the FBI in Chicago, within the last few years, but she thought it had something to do with Communism. She advised that her son does have two or three weapons; that he liked to hunt and fish; but, she has never known him to carry a weapon on his person. She stated that it no time had she ever heard her son mention Nazism or talk about Dr. KING. She stated it was her belief that at the time he may have called the FBI in Chicago, he may have been drinking at some bar in Chicago with some friends. She advised that although he was not mentally unbalanced, he did frequently during his marriages just take up and leave when he felt like it.

She stated she would immediately contact the FBI if she receives any information as to his whereabouts.

Dr. King's House, Church Circled Marked Atlanta Map Linked

to Assassin Suspect

WASHINGTON—A map of Atlanta with the areas of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King's residence and church circled has been linked to James Earl Ray, charged in Dr. King's slaying, it was learned yesterday.

The Los Angeles Times learned from an unimpeachable source that the map is part of the Federal Bureau of Investigation's evidence in its civil-rights conspiracy case against

Ray.

The map tends to support a theory by some investigators that Ray stalked Dr. King for some time before fatally shooting him April 4 as the civil-rights leader stood on a balcony outside his Memphis motel room.

THE AREAS CIRCLED included the Ebenezer Baptist Church on Auburn Avenue in a Negro business area on the eastern edge of downtown Atlanta and the area of Dr. King's residence several miles southwest of downtown Atlanta. Dr. King and his father, the Rev. Martin Luther King, Sr., served as co-pastors of the church.

Ray has been the object of a nation-wide hunt since April 17 when the F. B. I. charged him—in a complaint listing him under the alias of Eric Starvo Galt—with conspiring to violate Dr. King's civil rights. Memphis police quickly followed with a murder charge.

Two days after filing the complaint, the F. B. I. announced that fingerprints uncovered in its investigation revealed that Galt actually was Ray, 40, a fugitive from the Missouri penitentiary.

How the F. B. I. obtained the Atlanta map has not been revealed. It apparently was either left by Ray as he fled the murder scene or was found in his abandoned car in Atlanta.

THE F. B. I. CHARGES that Ray bought a fifle with telescopic sight in Birmingham March 29. The lefterson County (Birmingham) sheriff, Mel Bailey, has said the killing probably was planned for Birmingham.

Bailey said there was evidence that Ray was in Birmingham the same time as Dr. King last October and November.

Federal investigators, however, apparently lavor the theory that Ray did not plan the killing over that long a period.

Although the F. B. I. complaint accused the suspect of conspiring in the assassination with "an individual whom the alleged to be his brother," it was learned that the F. B. I.'s

The F. B. I.'s accusation of a conspiracy apparently rests solely on the statement by a clerk at a Birmingham sporting-goods store that Ray, in purchasing a rifle, mentioned that he and his brother planned to use it.

THE WEAPON was traced to the store by the F. B. I. after having been dropped by the assassin as he fled a Memphis boarding house from which he had fired the fatal,

A question still bothering the F. B. I. is whether Ray, although he is believed to have acted alone in the actual assassination, might not have been a hired killer. He is believed to have spent \$6,000 to \$8,000 in cash after the slaying and had no known employment just before or after the assassination.

The source of his funds is a puzzle. Could he have been a more successful robber and burglar than his record indicates? Did he live off stolen funds after his escape or did he have cash stashed away from a crime committed before his last imprisonment? The F. B. I. does not pretend to know the answers.

Re Chicago teletype to the Bureau dated 5/1/68 and Seattle teletype to the Bureau dated 5/2/68.

On 5/1/68, STEWART NORTHRUP, Manager, Bush Hotel, 621 South Jackson Street, Seattle, advised that THOMAS E. CRAMER was registered at the Bush Hotel from 3/2/68, until 4/27/68. He furnished a home address of 1820 West Oakdale, Chicago, Illinois. He roomed with one LOUIS FEE, home address 2227 West 22nd, Chicago, Illinois. Although CRAMER moved out of the hotel on 4/27/68, FEE still resides there.

NORTHRUP stated he believed CRAMER to be employed at the White Front Department Store in Seattle, Washington.

On May 1, 1968, inquiry at the White Front Department Store, Aurora Avenue North, Seattle, failed to reflect any employee by the name of CRAMER or CREAMER.

On 5/1/68, MICHAEL MURRAY, Manager, White Front Department Store, Burien, Washington, advised that THOMAS CRAMER is employed there in the Sporting Goods Department. CRAMER was off on 5/1/68 but due to return to work on 5/2/68. MURRAY did not have a home address for CRAMER.

MURRAY referred to employment records for CRAMER and stated that he has been employed with White Front since 3/11/68, and is a most satisfactory employee. He stated that he works five days a week from 12:00 PM to 9:00 PM.

During April his days off were Wednesday and Thursday, although MURRAY could not be sure that CRAMER took his days off since employees sometimes work on their day off or trade the day off with other employees for personal reasons.

THOMAS CRAMER was interviewed at the White Front Department Store, Burien, Washington, on 5/2/68. He stated he has been in Seattle continuously since early March, 1968 with the exception of a few short trips to the nearby rural areas for fishing. CRAMER advised that while employed at the Stuart Warner Corporation, 1826 West Diversy Street, Chicago, Illinois, in 1966, he had occasion to fire a Negro girl under his supervision. Shortly thereafter a series of what he described as retaliatory measures took place, among them a personal assault on CRAMER accompanied by the theft of his automobile and threats to his family. When his automobile was recovered, it was found to have sugar in the gas tank and other damage which appeared to have been deliberately caused.

CRAMER stated that shortly after the above incidents, two detectives from the Damon Avenue Station of the Chicago Police Department approached him at his home and furnished him with information re HELENA KAUFMAN, such as that set forth in re Chicago tel. He advised the detectives at that time that he believed this to be another retaliatory measure; by members of the "Deacons For Defense", a Negro organization whom CRAMER believes is responsible for the attacks on his person and property in retaliation for his firing of the Negro girl, above. He felt at that time that this matter had been settled to the satisfaction of the Chicago Police. CRAMER stated that his supervisor at that time was one MITCH TSCHAIKOWSKY (PH) whom he claimed would verify the above information. He stated that TSCHAIKOWSKY would also be in a position to furnish information regarding a bomb threat which was received at Stuart Warner Corporation around the same time as the above incidents and which CRAMER believes probably was connected with the Deacons for Defense.

CRAMER advised he was born at Lima, Ohio, and currently resides at 6762 - 34th Avenue, White Center, Seattle, Washington. He operates a 1962 Oldsmobile. He claims to have been arrested on two occasions in Chicago as a result of fights.

On May 2, 1968 LOUIS FEE, the Bush Hotel, Seattle,

advised that he met CRAMER in Denver, Colorado, in early March, 1968. They came to Seattle together and lived, until recently, together at the Bush Hotel. FEE stated that, to the best of his knowledge, CRAMER has been in Seattle continuously since they arrived. He stated that he also worked at the White Front Department Store with CRAMER and knows that CRAMER was also continuously employed at that store since March, 1968. FEE specifically recalled telling CRAMER during the early part of April, 1968, of the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., and pointed out that FEE was the first one to mention this to CRAMER. He recalled that this was either during the afternoon or early evening on the day KING was shot.

In view of the above, UAC, no further investigation is being conducted regarding CRAMER at Seattle.



On April 19, 1968, Mrs. ANEVA FREEMAN, a waitress at the King's Row Restaurant, 3935 Stoneway North, advised that she served a customer in the mid afternoon of the 19th that resembled ERIC STARVO GALT, a man sought by the FBI. She described the individual as about 6'1" in heighth, 170 or 175 pounds, dark hair, and deep set eyes. She advised that he appeared thinner than the picture of GALT, as it appeared in local newspapers. She advised that the man, a white male, wore a gold ring on his left finger and that his ear stuck out. She stated he smoked Pall-Mall cigarettes. Mrs. FREEMAN said she never saw the fellow before and that he left after staying for about 45 minutes.

On April 19, 1968, PHYLLIS WILSON, owner of the King's Row Restaurant, advised that she observed the same white male who she described as under 6' with dark brown hair that was flattened down. She advised that the man kept his hand to his face and appeared nervous. She thought he resembled ERIC STARVO GALT.

On April 19, 1968, Mr. JACK L. MARTIN, bartender at the King's Row Restaurant, advised that the fellow observed by Mrs. FREEMAN and Mrs. WILSON looked somewhat like GALT, but that in his opinion, it wasn't GALT. He said the customer who was a white male, age 39 to 40, height 6'1", weight 185 pounds, had a sharper nose than GALT as GALT'S picture was presented in local newspapers.
