William Bradford Huie has written a third article for "Look" magazine. The article appears in the issue dated April 15, 1969, but this issue was circulated on April 1, 1969. A review of the article reveals that James Earl Ray allegedly registered at the Travelodge Motel, Five Points, Birmingham, Alabama, on March 29, 1968; at a motel near Florence, Alabama, on April 1, 1968; and at a motel near Corinth, Mississippi, on April 2, 1968. It is to be noted that Ray, using the name Harvey Lowmyer, negotiated the purchase of a rifle at the Aeromarine Supply Company, Birmingham, Alabama, on March 29 and 30, 1968. On April 3, 1968, he was registered at the Rebel Motel in Memphis, Tennessee.

In an effort to establish whether or not Ray was in contact with any individuals immediately prior to the assassination, appropriate investigation should be conducted by the Birmingham and Jackson Offices. It should be understood that there is to be no indication made whatsoever that the following investigation has any connection whatsoever with the case involving James Earl Ray.

Birmingham and Jackson Offices should make inquiries of the motels in or near the cities indicated above to determine the identities of individuals registered during the period March 29 to April 3, 1968. Efforts should be made to identify all individuals listed, as well as

obtaining descriptions and registrations for the automobiles of such persons. A review of such records might indicate whether any one individual might have accompanied Ray or been in contact with him during this period. Pertinent or questionable registration records should be obtained if possible for examination by the FBI Laboratory.

Memphis should insure that the Bureau is kept currently advised of pertinent developments in this case, particularly all aspects of court action since the death of Judge Battle on March 31, 1969.

# Ray Case Still Mystery

There can be no letup now in the investigation of the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. murder case despite the plea of guilty by James Earl Ray and his subsequent sentencing to 99 years in prison. The big unanswered question is:

Who, if anyone, conspired with Ray to kill the Negro civil rights leader?

Both prosecution and defense lawyers told the court in Memphis, Tenn., they were satisfied a conspiracy was not involved in the slaying.

There's plenty of reason to doubt that that is a proper conclusion.

Ray himself interrupted the court proceedings to say he did not agree with his lawyer's assurances that there was no conspiracy.

The original Federal Bureau of Investigation complaint, filed in Birmingham, Ala., alleged that Eric Starvo Galt, later identified as Ray, conspired with another individual to violate King's civil rights.

It would seem that Ray himself would be a good authority on the conspiracy question and that there would not be anything for him to gain to

indicate in court that he wasn't the only one involved.

The FBI and Tennessee law enforcement officials apparently developed a solid case of circumstantial evidence against Ray—so strong that his counsel favored a guilty plea.

Yet with the quick disposal of the case in court, there will be less opportunity to dig out more information about the case. For instance:

What was Ray's motive? The prosecutor said he believed racial hatred was it, but he didn't report substantial proof.

Where did Ray get the money he used to buy many things, including a car and the death-dealing rifle? The prosecutor said robberies and smuggling activities may have been the sources.

The Justice Department has pledged that the investigation concerning a possible conspiracy will continue. That is good, not only to see that justice is served, but also that the American people are informed about all possible details of a case that shook the nation.

## Ray Conviction Prompt Justice

The guilty plea and the sentencing of James Earl Ray to 99 years in prison for the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King reflects credit upon the American processes of investigation and the American system of justice.

The nation needs a case of this kind to offset its general image worldwide as a place where conviction of heinous crime is at best a slow and uncertain process.

The apprehension of Ray in Great Britain within a relatively short time of the commission of the crime to which he has pleaded guilty carries with it a powerful lesson to potential wrongdoers. It is new affirmation of the impressive efficiency of the Federal Bureau of Investigation that this arrest could have been made.

The guilty plea is further evidence of the kind of case the investigators had prepared. Coupled with other recent successes in the discovery and arrest of wanted suspects, a good case for the unprofitability of major crime can be inferred.

The fact that Ray will not be executed also has its constructive aspect. If he were, indeed, a hired killer, as he himself has hinted, it will be easier to trace the lines of any possible conspiracy if he is alive than if he were dead.

The authorities in Tennessee seem well aware of the need to protect him in prison, and that is good. As long as he lives, he is a daily threat to anyone who may have been involved with him in plotting the killing of the civil rights leader. His silencing could be accomplished in prison at least as easily as elsewhere. Thus, the security precautions devised for him in prison are well warranted.

Justice itself was on trial in this situation. A southern state has shown itself resolute in punishing the confessed murderer of a leader who was unpopular with many of what is now popularly called the establishment of Tennessee. The investigative work and the judicial work in the Ray case were done in a way to warrant general approval.

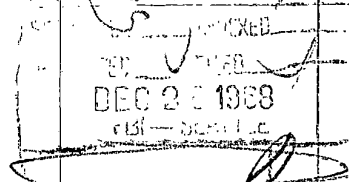

A check of telephone number 943 7928, disclosed it was registered to JIM J. FRUNZ, 3133 S. Lorne, Olympia, Washington and that he is the local sales manager for Smith Corona Business Machines. Efforts to locate FRUNZ at place of employment and residence disclosed that he had disappeared last week-end with his secretary and that his wife had left him and returned to her parents home in Seattle, telephone ME 2 1145.

On July 31, 1968, FRUNZ called the Olympia RA in response to a stop left with his place of business. He admitted making the phone call to the Shelby County, Tenn. Sheriff's Office on July 20, 1968. He said he had been drinking all evening and arguing with his wife. He noticed a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY being led into court, which appeared in the newspaper. He said for some foolish reason, he feared another situation like LEE HARVEY OSWALD. He mentioned it to his wife and finally picked up the phone and called the Shelby County SO. He said he does not recall saying that he was a member of the Olympia Police, nor did he recall saying anything about being in the service with RAY. He said he knows nothing about RAY except what he has read in the papers. FRUNZ said he was born in North Dakota, but lived most of his life in Portland, Oregon. He has lived in Olympia since April 1964. He apologized for having made the call and inconvenienced anyone.

FRUNZ has no record with the Olympia Police Department.

On 7/3/68, LLOYD GENE BASS was interviewed by SA WILLIAM B. HOLLOWAY at Dallas, Texas. BASS denied knowing any present or former inmate of the Washington State Penitentiary. He stated he certainly did not give anyone any amount of money to have MARTIN LUTHER KING killed. He said he has been almost destitute himself for many months and has had to resort to writing bad checks and petty thefts to sustain himself. He denied that he has any knowledge of any conspiracy to kill KING or has ever made any statement to anyone concerning having KING killed. He stated he does not own any meat packing company but has worked as a meat cutter and delivery man for meat packers in the Dallas area. He is presently employed as a meat cutter for Acorn Meat Company, 1737 Levy Street, Dallas, and resides at 1320, Marvin D. Love Freeway, Apt. 100, Dallas.

AT TONASKET, WASHINGTON

On July 17, 1968, Mr. FRED OWENS, Mgr. Whitestone Hotel, advised that the Greyhound Bus Depot is located in this building, and the tickets are sold by him in the hotel lobby. OWENS said he cannot from JOE GARSKE's description determine who the man was who allegedly told GARSKE sometime in the fall of 1967 that he was going "back home" and kill MARTIN LUTHER KING. OWENS explained that each fall there are thousands of transients in this area during the apple picking season, and many of them travel by bus and stay at the hotel. He said it would be absolutely impossible to identify the person by a meager description. OWENS added that most of the transients are drinking people, and many of them are "wineos"; he said he has heard so many of them talk so much and tell so many lies that he has found that he can seldom ever believe what they are saying.

On July 17, 1968, the following men advised that they can not recall anyone who might be the person who made the statement about going back home and kill MARTIN LUTHER KING:

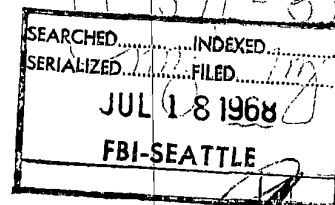
