On April 19, 1968, DAVID CLARENCE ORT was interviewed at his home at 1709 Harvest, Cahokia, Illinois, by SA BERNARD E. CURRIGAN and SA LARRY W. GREEN.

ORT was interviewed concerning his knowledge of ALBERT PEPPER and his associations with a person named PEPPER. ORT denied any knowledge of PEPPER and stated that he is totally unfamiliar with the person identified to him as ALBERT PEPPER. When asked if he received a call on February 13, 1968, from Mrs. ALBERT PEPPER or Mr. ALBERT PEPPER, ORT denied ever receiving such a call and a check of his telephone statements for the months of January, February and March, indicates that no long distance calls were made to PEPPER at 645-2948, Maplewood, Missouri. ORT's telephone number is 332-1117, Cahokia, Illinois.

During the interview, ORT mentioned that his neighbors do not have a telephone and have not had one since they moved in approximately five months ago. ORT stated that the neighbors next door to him at 1711 Harvest Street, Cahokia, Illinois, are tenants of his and have rented from him since they moved in. The neighbors at 1711 Harvest are identified as JAMES and BETTY DOSSETT, JR. ORT stated that on occasions the neighbors would come into his home and use his telephone to call numbers in Cahokia, Illinois, and sometimes to call relatives in Belleville, Illinois. ORT further stated that on occasions, the DOSSETTS would receive calls from persons unknown to him but when such calls came to his home for the DOSSETTS, he would go next door and get them to come and answer the telephone. He stated that he ordinarily knew who was calling since it was the DOSSETTS close relatives in Belleville, Illinois. ORT stated if DOSSETT received a call from either Mr. or Mrs. ALBERT PEPPER, such telephone call is unknown to him and that certainly it was not a call charged to his telephone number.

ORT maintains a janitorial service after his work hours at Universal Match in St. Louis, Missouri.

JAMES DOSSETT, JR., 1711 Harvest, Cahokia, Illinois, was interviewed by SA BERNARD E. CURRIGAN and SA LARRY W. GREEN at his residence, on April 19, 1968, concerning his knowledge of Mr. or Mrs. ALBERT PEPPER.

DOSSETT stated that he is not personally familiar with ALBERT PEPPER, but has met him through his father, JAMES DOSSETT, SR., who works with ALBERT PEPPER at Ace Hardware, Forrest Park area, St. Louis, Missouri. He states that his father has worked with PEPPER for some time but other than this, has no personal knowledge of either Mr. or Mrs. PEPPER. DOSSETT stated that some time in early February, he made a deal with ALBERT PEPPER to buy a 1962 black Fairlane sedan. He stated that the transaction was conducted largely on the telephone which calls he took at the home of DAVID C. ORT, whose telephone number is 332-1117. He said that he very likely received a call from ALBERT PEPPER on February 13, 1968, but can't be sure of this. He stated that in early February he went to the residence of ALBERT PEPPER in Maplewood, Missouri, with his father, JAMES DOSSETT, SR., to take a ride in the 1962 Fairlane Ford, to see if he was interested in purchasing it from PEPPER. DOSSETT stated that before the purchase of the car was negotiated, PEPPER was unknown to him.

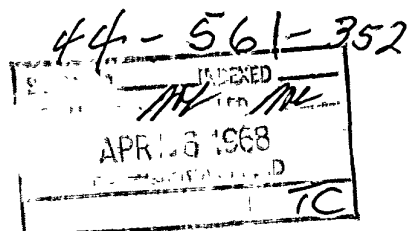

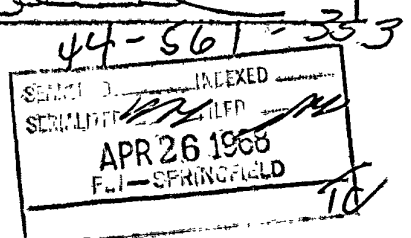

This is to record additional information concerning LAWRENCE WAYNE FEGETT, who was the probable recipient of a laundry bundle bearing laundry mark 20R-3 in December, 1967.

On 4/25/68, Mr. and Mrs. TERRY FEGETT, were located in Oakwood, Illinois. Mr. FEGETT advised that his son has been a constant source of concern to him since he was about fifteen years of age. FEGETT said that his son had epilepsy and also drank heavily. FEGETT stated that this habit had caused his son to be arrested on several occasions and had caused his son's marriage to end in divorce.

FEGETT stated that his son was in the Army for approximately six months before his marriage but was given a medical discharge and had not been steadily employed since that time. FEGETT stated that his son had traveled with carnivals in Florida and in Michigan, both before and after his marriage.

FEGETT stated that after his son left the apartment on North Hazel Street in Danville, Illinois, in December, he moved to an apartment at 327 North Hazel Street, Apartment 8 in Danville but only stayed there about a week. FEGETT stated that his son then moved to Martinsville, Illinois, and had been there since that time as far as he knew. FEGETT stated, however, that he had not seen his son during that time.

FEGETT stated that during the summer of 1967, his son again joined the carnival and was in Florida and other southern states as well as in the state of Michigan. FEGETT stated that his son had just left the carnival when he came to Danville, Illinois, and rented the apartment at 805 North Walnut Street.

FEGETT said that his son had a child by a woman named HAZEL AYRES of Chrisman, Illinois. FEGETT stated that Mrs. AYRES was still married to her original husband but

continued to visit his son, both while he was in Danville and since he had moved to Chrisman, Illinois. FEGETT said that Mrs. AYRES might be able to account for his son's location since he left Danville, Illinois.

FEGETT stated that on Tuesday, 4/23/68, his son, LAWRENCE WAYNE FEGETT was arrested in Martinsville, Illinois, for attempting to remove a candy dispensing machine from a service station. He stated that his son had been jailed at Marshall, Illinois, by the Sheriff's Department but was scheduled to be transported to the Peoria State Hospital for observation on 4/25/68.

FEGETT stated that his son was normal until he either had an epileptic seizure or had too much to drink. FEGETT said that on these occasions, however, his son became extremely violent and on one occasion had kicked the door in to his residence in an attempt to take his life. FEGETT said that it was necessary for he and his wife to hide until law enforcement officers could come and apprehend his son.

On 4/24/68, Mr. L. J. O'BRIEN, Model Star Laundry, 208 East Van Buren, advised that the laundry mark 20R-3 was one that his laundry had used. O'BRIEN stated that the 20 is the lot number. The R represents the week and the 3 represents the bundle number. O'BRIEN stated that the letter is changed every week and a check of his calendar indicated that the last week he had used the letter R was the week of December 3-9, 1967 and during that week, his tape machine was using yellow tape. O'BRIEN stated that his record showed that bundle 3 was checked into the laundry on 12/11/67, which was a Monday. He said that the record showed that bundle 3 was picked up by driver ED ORR who had route #5. O'BRIEN stated that this was the only information that could be determined about this bundle at this time because all of the tickets with the customers' names on them had been destroyed. O'BRIEN stated that bundle 3 of lot 20R had been washed on 12/11/67 as a part of load B and this load included bundles 1-18. O'BRIEN stated that the yellow tape marker 20R-1 and the yellow tape marker 20R-18 appeared on his slip to indicate that this was the first and the last bundle in load B on this day.

Mr. ED ORR stated that he had been driving for Model Star for about ten years and knew most of his regular customers very well. ORR said that he rarely ever got a bundle of laundry from a stranger. ORR said that he remembers picking up a bundle from a stranger at 805 North Walnut several months ago but he cannot recall what this person looked like. ORR said that when he returned the laundry to the 805 address, the individual told him that he was moving. ORR said that in addition to approximately eighty regular customers, he also picks up laundry at the Holiday Inn, the Grier-Lincoln Hotel, and the Plaza Hotel. ORR stated that the bundle 20R-3 did not come from these establishments, however, because their laundry was always on a special and if it had been picked

up the week of December 3-9, 1967, it would have been washed during that week, also.

ORR viewed pictures of JAMES EARL RAY and stated that the individual at 805 Walnut was much younger than the photograph of RAY appeared.

JANICE BARKER, secretary, Brumaghim Real Estate, 302 West Fairchild, advised that her company handles the rental of the apartment at 805 West Walnut. Miss BARKER checked the records for 805 North Walnut and advised that a WAYNE FEGETT occupied the apartment from 11/8/67 through 11/7/67 when he was asked to move. Miss BARKER stated that FEGETT caused the other tenants trouble by being very demanding and the other tenants were afraid of him. She stated that he also had damaged the apartment by removing water pipes and electrical wiring and they had received word that he had burned down a house in Chrisman, Illinois. BARKER stated that the record indicated he paid his last week's rent on 12/7/67 and would have moved sometime during the next week. BARKER said that a Mrs. CHARLES NORWELL lived in the apartment above FEGETT and was one of the tenants who had complained about FEGETT's activities.

BARKER stated that FEGETT told her that he was going to Iowa to enter a hospital for treatment. She said that she had not seen WAYNE FEGETT since 12/7/67.

JANICE BARKER viewed photographs of JAMES EARL RAY and stated emphatically that FEGETT and RAY were not identical. She stated that FEGETT was a smaller, younger, individual and had reddish - blond hair.

Mrs. EVELYN NORWELL, 805 Walnut Street, advised that she remembered the tenant who lived at 805 (downstairs) in December of 1967. Mrs. NORWELL stated that this man had entered her apartment on several occasions, without permission, and used the telephone. She said that he had made calls to Chrisman, Illinois on two occasions and she had received the bill for them. She stated that he had been very demanding of her and her husband and requested that they take him different places. She said that they had taken him to the Plaza Hotel to pick up his belongings

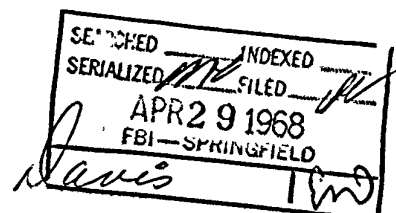

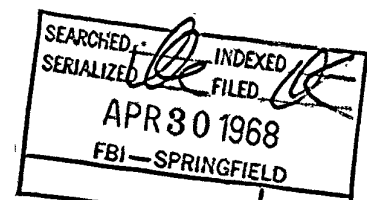
