Mr. BREMER advised that the metel had had several men staying there who were attending the National Cash Register Company training school at Denver, Colorado; some of them for rather extended periods. He advised that Mr. VELEZ and Mr. MELDRUM were still residing there, but that Mr. MELDRUM was cut of twom, having gone back to Pennsylvania to visit his family for a few days. Concerning Mr. WALLEM, for whom the Registration Card could not be located, Mr. BRUMER stated that WALLEM is a frequent guest at the motel and that he operates a motel in Estee Park, Colorado.

Mr. W. F. MC MURRAY, proprieter of the El Patio Motel, advised that he had no recollection of any guests receiving any long distance telephone calls either prepaid or collect from Quincy, Illinois. He was unable to recall any guest resembling the description or photograph of subject.

Er. EMILIO ISHMAEL VELEZ, who has been at the El Patio Motel since 3/25/58, advised that he will have been employed by the Mational Cash Register Company, International Division, five years by July, 1968. He is a service engineer with offices at 556 Munes Mivera, Mato Rey, Puerto Rico, home address same as set out above. He stated he has been attending the Mational Cash Register Company in-service training school in Denver. He advised that he has not received any long distance calls from Quincy, Illinois, that he is not acquainted with anyone in Quincy, Illinois, or vicinity and does not recall any guest at the motel since he has been there who resembles the photograph or description of subject. Mr. VELEZ stated he spends a great deal of his free time in the lobby of the motel and has had an opportunity to observe many of the guests.
