On 10/16/68, HOHERT H. STRADER, 122 William Drive, Apartment J. Brownsburg, Indiana, telephonically contacted this office advising that he wished to speak to an agent in regard to captioned subject. Arrangements were made to meet him at which time he furnished information substantially the same as was furnished by his wife, MARGARET CARMICHAEL STRADER, in referenced airtel. The only discrepancy with information furnished previously by his wife was that he compared photographs that were published of JAMES BARL RAY to the persons that he remembered having overheard at the Gulf Truck Stop, Lebanon, Tennessee, in late March, 1968. After comparison he advised that none of the five men he overheard at the truck stop were identical to JAMES BARL RAY. His wife had previously stated in referenced airtel that one of those persons had been RAY.

STRADER advised that after hearing this conversation with the five men in the restroom at the truck stop on or about the last day of March, 1968, that he and his wife turned around and traveled back to Memphis, a distance of about 65 miles, to report what he had overheard. When they returned to Memphis, however, he got scared, did not want to get involved and did not report what he had heard to anyone. They left Memphis and traveled East in the direction they had been traveling before returning to Memphis. Mrs. STRADER, in referenced airtel, advised to the contrary that he did not mention hearing of the plan to kill Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING that day and she did not advise of having returned to Memphis to report such information.

In addition to the above information, STRADER advised that he was approached by a man on the night of 10/13/68, at the har of Howard Johnson's, located at I-465 and Indiana State Highway 136, in Indianapolis. This man, according to STRADER, knew all about STRADER and was aware of his poor financial status. This man followed him to the car and told STRADER that he could make \$100,000 if he would testify to what he heard in the restroom in Lebanon, Tennessee, in late March. The man did not tell him who would pay the money, but told STRADER that if he was interested he was to be in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, at the airport at 3:00 AM, on Saturday, 10/19/68. The man also told STRADER that if he did not believe him, to go to the Holiday Inn har, at the Indianapolis airport at 5:00 PM the next evening. STRADER advised that he did, in fact, go the next evening to the Holiday Inn har, which was on 10/14/68, but he was not approached by anyone. On the morning of 10/15/68, at approximately 5:30 AK, STRADER heard a noise at his apartment door, and found a note which stated, "Bat. 3:00 AM, OKLA. City. Now much money". STRANGE stated that he became very werried and finally on 10/16/68 made a telephone call to ARTHUR HAYNES, atterney for JAMES BARL RAY, in Birmingham, Alabama, attempting to find out if HAYMES was responsible for the offer of \$100,000 for STRABER to testify. He talked to HAYMES, at which time HATRES mentioned to STRABER that he had received a mysterious phone call several days before, advising that he should get in touch with a ROBERT STRADER, however, HAYNES had taken it as a prank call. HAYNES knew of no offer of money to STRADER if he would testify, but did take STRADER's address and phone number.

After talking to HAYNES, STRADER immediately called the Indianapolis office and requested to talk to an Agent. STRADER gave as his reason for not contacting the PBI previously, that he was an ex-con and was not fond of dealing with police in any manner, however, he was scared and felt that he must make known the above information. STRADER furnished both notes he had received to interviewing Agents.

Indianapolis Office is retaining these notes at this time and has instructed STRADER to promptly advise if he is recontacted in the future by anyone concerning this matter. As the substance of this interview with STRADER has previously been furnished to the Bureau and Memphis, it does not appear further investigation is necessary. The Indianapolis Office will keep the Bureau and Memphis advised of any further developments.

On 10/16/68, ROBERT H. STRADER, 122 William Drive, Apartment J. Brownsburg, Indiana, telephonically contacted this office advising that he wished to speak to an agent in regard to captioned subject. Arrangements were made to meet him at which time he furnished information substantially the same as was furnished by his wife, MARGARET CARMICHAEL STRADER, in referenced airtel. The only discrepancy with information furnished previously by his wife was that he compared photographs that were published of JAMES RARL RAY to the persons that he remembered having overheard at the Gulf Truck Step, Lebanon, Tennessee, in late March, 1968. After comparison he advised that none of the five men he overheard at the truck step were identical to JAMES RARL RAY. His wife had previously stated in referenced airtel that one of those persons had been RAY.

STRADER advised that after hearing this conversation with the five men in the restroom at the truck step on or about the last day of March, 1968, that he and his wife turned around and traveled back to Memphis, a distance of about 65 miles, to report what he had everheard. When they returned to Memphis, however, he got scared, did not want to get involved and did not report what he had heard to anyone. They left Nemphis and traveled East in the direction they had been traveling before returning to Memphis. Mrs. STRADER, in referenced airtel, advised to the contrary that he did not mention hearing of the plan to kill Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING that day, and she did not advise of having returned to Memphis to report such information.
