On 10/16/68, ROBERT H. STRADER, 122 William Drive, Apartment J, Brownsburg, Indiana, telephonically contacted this office advising that he wished to speak to an agent in regard to captioned subject. Arrangements were made to meet him at which time he furnished information substantially the same as was furnished by his wife, MARGARET CARMICHAEL STRADER, in referenced airtel. The only discrepancy with information furnished previously by his wife was that he compared photographs that were published of JAMES EARL RAY to the persons that he remembered having overheard at the Gulf Truck Stop, Lebanon, Tennessee, in late March, 1968. After comparison he advised that none of the five men he overheard at the truck stop were identical to JAMES EARL RAY. His wife had previously stated in referenced airtel that one of those persons had been RAY.

STRADER advised that after hearing this conversation with the five men in the restroom at the truck stop on or about the last day of March, 1968, that he and his wife turned around and traveled back to Memphis, a distance of about 65 miles, to report what he had overheard. When they returned to Memphis, however, he got scared, did not want to get involved and did not report what he had heard to anyone.
