adjustment, having had three punishment reports, one of which was for a fight with snother inmate. We consider him to be an occasional type offender, and feel that he should be considered a questionably improvable type.

TITUTIONAL

This inmate is apparently wanted by the Indiana Reformatory authorities as a parole violator. He states that he still owes them about 2 years and 10 months, and expects to be returned there to finish up the time after his release here. Due to this situation, he has made no definite plans for the future.

EIDANCY:

This inmate is single, and his nearest dependant would be his mother who is apparently receiving ADC assistance for the support of herself and the inmate's half siblings. He has had rather limited contacts with her in late years, and we seriously doubt that he would be of much financial assistance after his release.



Although the photocopy, Qc288, lacks the quality necessary for a satisfactory comparison, some differences were noted between the writing appearing on the face of this item when compared with the writings appearing on specimens submitted in this case.

Some features noted on Qc288 which might give an indication of its place of purchase are a stamp with the wording "Montreal 28 VII 67;" the number of the money order, "C-31,600,868;" the printed name "Hector Cormier" at the bottom of the money order and the initials "M." or "N." "D." on the bottom line to the right of the printed Cormier name.


