ASSASSINATION OF MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. CIVIL RIGHTS

On Appil 10, 1968, Private John A. Horstkamp,
Precinct 12, Metropolitan Police Department (MPD), Washington,
D.C. (WDC), advised Special Agents (SAs) of the Federal
Bureau of Investigation (FBI) that at 6:55 a.m. on that date
and based on information furnished a few minutes earlier by
a confidential source that someone was loading rifles into
an automobile at 3204 22nd Street, N.E., WDC, he and
Private Paul R. Jones arrived at the above address to investigate.

Officer Horstkamp said that upon arrival they noticed a blue Pontiac, Maryland License Tags DZ 5648, being backed out of the alley near 3204 22nd Street, N.E. Officer Horstkamp stated that they then halted the vehicle and after initiating a search found two shotguns and two rifles in the car's trunk. The driver of the car, Robert Shirley Howerton, white male, 55 years of age, 4920 Taylor Road, Edmonston, Maryland, teld the officers that he had only recently returned from a hunting trip; and rather than risk having his guns confiscated by authorities during a search of his car at a check-point while en route from the District of Columbia to his Maryland home, he had left the guns overnight with a friend who lives at 3204 22nd Street, N.E. He said he had just picked up the guns when the officers arrived.

Officer Horstkamp stated that they confiscated the guns for police disposition in view of the civil disorder which has existed in the District of Columbia the past several days. In addition, he said that although not charged Howerton will be summoned to appear at a hearing on the matter before the United States Attorney, District of Columbia, on May 16, 1968, due to the restriction on firearms during an emergency situation.

WFO indices contain no information identifiable with FRED SHELTON OF ROBERT SHIRLEY HOWERTON.

ASSASSINATION OF DOCTOR MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

Samuel Milton, 1550 Butler Street, Southeast was contacted by a representative of this Bureau for the purpose of obtaining information pertaining to possible suspect in the Doctor Martin Luther King assassination and he advised as follows:

On Friday morning, April 5, 1968, between 2:00 - 3:00 a.m. while operating his taxicab in the area of 14th and K Street, Northwest, he was hailed by a white male, no further description, who had been doing a great deal of drinking and was very much in a drunken condition and the individual stated he had driven 200 or 300 miles to get to Washington, D.C. and had parked his car and wanted assistance in locating his late model white Thunderbird car. Milton stated he drove the individual around and located the car parked on K Street near 13th Street. Upon locating the car, he observed that it was a white T-Bird, with black vinyl top with West Virginia tags. The individual paid the cab fare and departed the cab. Milton stated the individual did not reveal why he was in Washington or where he was staying.

Milton stated the reason he first reported this information to the authority was that he thought that the person responsible for King's assessination was driving a white car and because of the fact that this individual stated he had been driving a great distance that there may have been some connection with this matter. He advised since reporting the information to the authority he has seen in a local newspaper additional information concerning the suspect and it was definitely his feeling that because of the individual's

drunken condition, he must have been in Washington for several hours and also that the vehicle that was reported to be the suspect's car was a white Mustang and that there appears to be no connection between the individual and the suspect. He concluded by stating the artist's sketch in the newspaper did not look like the individual he assisted in locating his T-Bird.

On 4/10/68, JUDSON RANDA LETT, Chief Analyst, Analysis Laboratory, Institute Cleaning Plant, 8021 Georgia Avenue, Silver Springs, Maryland, advised the institute supplies dry cleaning methods throughout the United States and the world.

LETT advised upon viewing the photos of the Thermal Seal Markings, that he knew of no way to identify the tape markings with any specific laundry-cleaners. He advised that markings are significant to a particular laundry-cleaners, but the only way to determine the specific establishment would be by process of elimination. This could only be done by showing the thermo tape to these establishments.

LETT advised that the red thermo tape is used by some laundry-cleaners to indicate the items are to be handled as a special, that is being done as soon as possible.

LETT advised that there are three methods of marking clothes. (1) thermal seal, (2) permanent ink markings, and (3) pre-marked strip tags, which are stapled on the clothes.

30.06 Hunting Rifle Was Believed Used in Slaying



A Remington rifle of the type believed to have been used in slaying. Its range is limited.

The weapon believed to have been used in the slaying of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. is a 30.06-caliber Remington pump rifle. It may have been one of several stolen from a Memphis sporting goods store a week ago.

A spokesman for the Remington Arms Company, Bridgeport, Conn., said yesterday that the weapon was "a standard game rifle used by people to hunt such things as deer, bear, mountain lions and moose." To maintain accuracy, hunters cannot ex-

pect to use it at more than 200 yards.

The 30.06 is a popular rifle that retails for \$139.95 to \$159.95, depending on how fancy a finish on the stock and metal surfaces the purchaser wants.

When it is fired, the rifle ejects a spent empty case on the rear move and automatically shifts a fresh round into firing position in the chember. This occurs on the forward move. All models of

chember. This occurs on the forward move. All models of the 30.06 have capacity for the four-cartridge clip except one, Model 223, which has a five-cartridge clip.

The rifle has simple iron sights — a blade atop the muzzzle and a notch on top of the breach. In taking aim, the object is to line up the target, sighting through the notch and blade. It is possible to attach telescopic sights for the weapon.

No such sights were attached to the Remington 30.06 believed to have been used to kill Dr. King. The Memphis police found a new 30.06 two doors away from the rooming house from which the fatal shot is believed to have been fired.

On 4/11/68, SA FENNETH J. HASER was advised that no record of ERIC STARVO GALT or ERNEST GALT could be located in the files of the Office of Security, the general correspondence files or the Visa Office, Department of State. A check was also made on 4/11/68 of the files of the Passport Office, Department of State concerning EARL GALT with negative results.

It is noted that the Visa Office, Department of State maintains records on fewer than 1% of all U.S. visas issued throughout the world. Visa records are maintained in the issuing Embassies or Consulates abroad, nonimmigrant files being retained for 4 years efter issue and immigrant files, 16 months, and then destroyed.

From a review of passport files in the surname of GALT, it was noted that several such individuals were born in England or Scotland; it is also felt that there are several GALT families in Fennsylvania of German descent. It is, therefore, suggested that the Bureau consider having Legats London and Bonn check with the Embassies there in an effort to locate a visa file on suspect GALT.

NCIC received an entry from Montgomery County, Maryland (Rockville), indicating a German Luger with Barrel Number 9454 was stolen 7/1/67. This entry contains no serial number.

All other serial numbers of guns listed stolen were checked through NCIC and no record located identifiable with these guns. It was indicated that the possibility exists that this stolen property has not been listed in NCIC files as yet.

REED, who is employed as a mailer by "The Washington Post" newspaper, advised that his apartment was broken into and a quantity of guns and other merchandise, estimated value \$2,500, was taken from his apartment on the evening of 4/11/68.

He stated he contacted the Mount Rainier Police Department and advised them of this loss and subsequently the Mount Rainier and Prince Georges County Police arrived on the scene. He said that the Prince Georges County Police made an effort to obtain latent fingerprints from several objects in his apartment.
