



For the information of Dallas and WFO, referenced airtel enclosed a copy of the pre-sentence report for JAMES MARL RAY, dated 4/26/55 from the Western District of Missouri, Mansas City, Missouri.

This pre-sentence report indicated that JAMES BARL RAY, WALTER TERRY RIFE and an unknown woman companion, in March, 1955, engaged in passing numerous stolen U. S. Postal money orders in Missouri, Arkansas, Florida, Tennessee, and New Orleans, Louisiana.

In March, 1955, exact data unknown, RIFE passed a U. S. Postal money order, number 1000, (last 3 digits only) at Wright Tailors; that on 3/21/55 RIFE passed U. S. Postal money order number (last 3 digits only) at Schneiders; and on 3/16/55, RIFE passed U. S. Postal money order number (last 3 digits only) at Todd's Sportswear Shop. These three establishments are all located in New Orleans, La. The first two money orders passed were in the amount of \$75 and the last money order in the amount of \$50.


