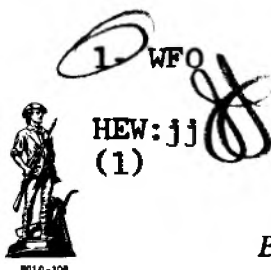

FBI Checks Canadian Lead In Search for King's Killer

The search for the suspected killer of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. now has branched into Canada.

This development came after the Federal Bureau of Investigation received information that James Earl Ray, sought as King's assassin visited Montreal last July and August during the Expo 67 fair. The FBI declined comment and provided no details as to whom the 40-year-old suspect might have seen in Canada or the purpose of his visit.

Ray escaped from the Missouri State Penitentiary at Jefferson City, Mo., in April 1967 and bought a 1966 white Mustang in Birmingham, Ala., in August. No information is available on his means of transportation between those dates.

Mexico and West Germany also are considered possible hiding places. Ray is known to have visited Mexico after purchasing the Mustang picked up by the FBI in Atlanta the day after the April 4 slaying in Memphis. Ray had a long tour of duty in West Germany when he was in the U. S. Army from 1946 to 1948.

More than three weeks after the assassination officials are indicating that the trail is cold. Investigators have been banking

heavily on the fact that more than \$150,000 in rewards has been offered for information leading to arrest of the fugitive. They also are working long hours to check out the hundreds of tips that have poured in from people who think they have seen the suspect.

The FBI has done a vacuum-sweeper job of collecting information about Ray, his habits, usual haunts and acquaintances. They are now in the position of knowing nearly everything about Ray except his whereabouts and whether he was working alone or as trigger-man for a conspiracy.

Some officials are leaning more and more to the theory that Ray was paid to shoot King—not on the basis of solid

information, but because it has been impossible to account for the amount of money he spent from the time of his escape from the Missouri prison on April 23, 1967, until last April 4.

KING'S MURDERER VIEWED AS LONER

ATLANTA, Ga. (AP) — Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark said yesterday there is no significant evidence that the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. "goes beyond the single actor" who fired the fatal shot.

Clark made the statement in reply to a question concerning reports of a possible conspiracy of Southern businessmen who might have been involved in the King slaying.

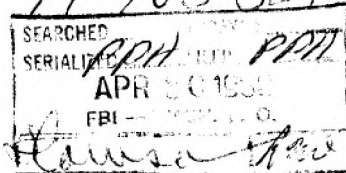

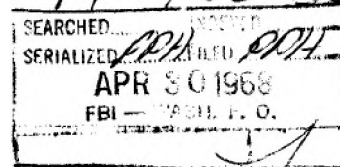

PRICE said he picked this man up at the Regency Motel which is in the 600 block of New York Ave NE and took him to Universal Parts to obtain a fan belt for his car which he pointed out as a 1958 or 1959 Chevrolet, Michigan license XA 9181, and after the person picked up the fan belt, PRICE took him to the capitol. PRICE said he called since the man closely resembled the killer and also because of the peculiar action of going to the capitol instead of back to his car after getting the part. He said he could add nothing else to the above information.

One money order passed in Kansas City, Missouri contained the full number [REDACTED] and these first six digits may be the same numbers attributable to the above mentioned money orders for which the last three digits only were furnished.

On 4/24/68 U. S. Postal Inspector, THOMAS E. He said that RAE had a child by THORNTON and that both were known at Herby's Restaurant, Alabama Avenue, S.E., WDC. MILWAUKEE, April 28—An American Civil Liberties Union official tonight called on FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover to remove himself from the investigation into the assassination of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

Charles M. Morgan Jr., Atlanta Southern Regional Director for the ACLU, spoke at a Wisconsin Civil Liberties dinner here.

Morgan noted that in November, 1964, Hoover had characterized Dr. King as "the most notorious liar in the country."

Morgan also noted that in 1964 Dr. King and Hoover publicly fought over the al-

leged lack of FBI protection for civil rights workers. "Now less than four years later," he said, "Hoover is called on to investigate the assassination of Dr. King."

Morgan said Hoover should be replaced by someone "in whom Negroes and all other Americans can have faith and confidence."

He also criticized the FBI's

handling of the assassination investigation. He said the FBI, by saying that Dr. King's suspected killer—James Earl Ray, alias Eric Starvo Galt—was armed and dangerous,

was almost the equivalent of saying that Galt was wanted dead or alive.

Morgan said he had asked Hoover and the attorney General's office to urge all law-enforcement agencies to take Dr. King's suspected killer alive even at the risk of the lives of the law officers involved.
