DIRECTOR J. EDGAR HOOVER SAID THAT A SYSTEMATIC AND EXHAUSTIVE SEARCH OF LATENT FINGERPRINTS UNCOVERED IN THE DR. KING CASE AGAINST THE FINGERPRINTS OF THE OVER 53,000 PERSONS FROM WHOM "WANTED NOTICES" HAVE BEEN POSTED IN THE FILES OF THE FBI"S IDENTIFICATION DIVISION LED TO THE DETERMINATION THAT GALT AND RAY ARE IDENTICAL.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT RAY, WHO IS 40 YEARS OF AGE, WAS REPORTED MISSING FROM THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY AT JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, SINCE APRIL 23, 1967. HE HAD BEEN RECEIVED AT THAT INSTITUTION ON MARCH 17, 1960, TO SERVE A 20-YEAR SENTENCE FOLLOWING CONVICTION IN ST. LOUIS FOR ARMED ROBBERY AND FOR OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WITHOUT PERMISSION OF THE OWNER.

IN SEPTEMBER, 1966, WHILE SERVING THIS SENTENCE, HE WAS CONFINED FOR A TIME IN THE MAXIMUM SECURITY WARD AT THE STATE HOSPITAL AT FULTON, MISSOURI.

ACCORDING TO MR. HOOVER, RAY HAS A KNOWN ARREST RECORD DATING BACK TO 1949. PRIOR TO THE 1960 CONVICTION FOR WHICH HE RECEIVED THE 20-YEAR TERM, RAY HAD BEEN CONVICTED OF BURGLARY IN LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA, IN 1949; ARMED ROBBERY IN CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, IN 1952; AND FORGING UNITED STATES POSTAL MONEY ORDERS IN MISSOURI IN 1955.

HE HAS SERVED TERMS IN THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY JAIL IN 1949; IN STATE PRISONS AT JOLIET AND PONTIAC, ILLINOIS, IN 1952-54; AND IN THE FEDERAL PENITENTIARY AT LEAVENWORTH, KANSAS, IN 1955-58.

RAY WAS AN ENLISTED MAN IN THE UNITED STATES ARMY FROM FEBRUARY, 1946, TO DECEMBER, 1948, AT WHICH TIME HE WAS GIVEN A GENERAL DISCHARGE DUE TO INEPTNESS AND LACK OF ADAPTABILITY FOR MILITARY SERVICE. WHILE IN THE ARMY, HE RECEIVED A THREE-MONTH SENTENCE AT HARD LABOR FOR BEING DRUNK AND BREAKING ABREST.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT DURING HIS CRIMINAL CAREER, PAY

### B.I. ACCUSES GALT Sought by the F.B.I. OF A CONSPIRACY INDR.KING SLAYING

Alleges a Plot With Man He Said Was a Brother to Violate Victim's Rights

FUGITIVE WARRANT OUT

Hoover Places Suspect in Memphis at Time of Killing -Two Photes Released

Text of the F.B.I. statement is printed on Page 46.

### By EVERT CLARK

WASHINGTON, April 17 The Federal Bureau of Investigation issued a fugitive warrant today charging Eric Starvo Galt, described as a 36-year-old "loner," with conspiracy in the slaying of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

Dr. King's assassin has been sought since the civil rights leader was killed by a rifle bullet on the balcony of the Lorraine Motel in Memphis on April 4.

The F.B.I. Isaid Galt conspired beginning about March 29 with a man "whom he alleged to be his brother" to "injure, oppress, threaten or intimidate" Dr. King. The conspiracy continued until about April 5, the agency said.

Attorney General Ramsey Clark announced that Galt was being sought as a fugitive on the charge of having conspired to violate Dr. King's civil rights, in violation of Title 18, Section 241, of the United States Code.

The maximum penalty on conviction under this law is a \$5,000 fine and a 10-year prison sentence.

### Announcement by Hoover

An announcement by J. Edgar Hoover, F.B.I. director, placed Galt in Memphis at the time of the killing and said he then left for Atlanta.

It said that Galt, "who has used the names of John Willard and Harvey Lowmyer in the part," owned the white 1966 Mustang automobile bearing Alabama license plates that was found abandoned in Atlanta one week after the assassination.

"He is said to be a neat dresser and has a medium build," the F.B.I. said.

Those who have met him describe him as a loner and say his "language and diction have a 'rural' quality and suggest that he probably does not have a high degree of education," the agency said.

Galt should be considered tonight that they would file murder charges in the assassination of Dr. King.

"That will be our immediate consideration," Memphis Fire and Police Director Frank Holloman said in answer to a question of whether there were plans to issue a warrant for the arrest of Galt.

"We look forward to the apprehension of this individual and his ultimate return to Memphis for trial for the rurder of Dr. Martin Luther King aroup picture, such as one taken at a nightclub.

### FBI Charges Galt 'Brothers'

# s Death 'Conspiracy'

But in diling a warrant for Mr. Galt's arrest in Birmingham, Ala., the FBI left unanswered these key questions in the case:

Where is Mr. Galt7

Who is the mysterious suspected conspirator and what role did he play? The FBI complaint says only that Mr. Galt "and an individual whom he alleged to be his brother" entered into a conspiracy against Dr. King.

### WHERE FROM?

Where did the FBI obtain its information about Mr. Galt and where did it get the pictures of him it released last night?

In what appeared to be the first big break in the murder, Attorney General Ramsey Clark described Mr. Galt as 36 years old, white, a neat dresser, a man of apparently limited education with a preference for vodka and beer, and Western and country music.

He has a nervous habit of occasionally pulling at an ear lobe with his hand, Mr. Clark reported, and persons who have met Mr. Galt described him is a loner.

He wears his brown hair in a brush cut, has a "straight and narrow" nose. He's said to be an avid dancer and took dancing lessons in New Orleans, Birmingham and Long Beach, Calif., at intervals between 1964 and February of this year.

### BOUGHT RIFLE

The FBI charges the conspiracy against Dr. King began in Birmingham March 29 and that the next day Mr. Galt purchased a rifle and a telescopic sighht there.

The complaint also says the conspiracy continued until "on or about" April 5 — the day after Dr. King was gunned down on a Memphis motel balcony. This appeared to suggest that Mr. Galt's unidentified "brother" may have assisted in his getaway by acting as a decoy or leaving false leads for police after Dr. King was shot.

While FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover said a rifle with telescopic sight was found near the rooming house from which Dr. King's assassin fired the fatal shot, the FBI did not specifically identify the rifle as the murder weapon.

Nr. Hoover did identify Mr. Galt as the owner of 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama license plates found abandoned in Atlanta April 11. A white Mustang was spotted leaving the murder

### 19,000 MILES

The Mustang found in Atlanta had been driven more than 19,000 miles since last August when Mr. Galt bought it in Birmingham, Mr. Hoover said. It had been to Los Angeles, New Orleans, Birmingham and Mexico, as well as Memphis and Atlanta, he said.

Viewed as the most intriguing aspect of the case now was the emergence of the suspected conspirator Mr. Galt obviously told someone was his brother.

Boon after Dr. King's murder, Mr. Clark said it peared to be the work of one man and virtually

ruled out a conspiracy.
The complaint against Mr. Galt specifically charges Mr. Galt and the "brother" with conspir-

ing to injure, oppress, threaten, or intimidate Dr Kills in his right to travel freely from state t stale.

### 10-YEAR TERM

Justice Department officials said this law carries only a 10-year prison sentence and \$5000 fine on conviction, but noted Mr. Clark has indicated that when Dr. King's slayer is found, he would be turned over to Tennessee authorities for trial on a murder charge.

The new civil rights law, had it been enacted before Dr. King's slaying, would have permitted the Justice Department to bring a Federal murder charge against the assassin. As it turned out, it was the King assassination that spurred Congress to pass the law.

The FBI said Mr. Galt has used the names of Harvey Lowmyer and John Willard - the name Dr. King's suspected killer used when he checked into the rooming house across from Dr. Kink's

Mr. Galt's birthplace was not revealed.

The letter did not have any date on it and had been at the radio station approximately a week. The handwriting appears to be that of a child.

Eccleston said he was furnishing this information to the FBI for whatever action deemed advisable since one of the aliases used by James Earl Ray, suspect in MURRIN was billiam John Willard.





He stated that he runs this limousine service out of his home, and at the time he called was working and did not have his records with him. He stated that he could be contacted at 270-3233 on a 24 hour basis. and would be glad to furnish any details or information that he has in his records.

RESNICK stated that approximately one week prior to the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. he received a call about midnight from MARIAN NEKEBA to make a reservation for the following date for a limousine to be at 1800 12th Street NW, WDC, at 10am. RESNICK did not personally chauffer the limousine the next day, however the driver picked up STOKELY CARMICHAEL at the 12th Street address and took him to Friendship airport where CARMICHREL was believed to catch a plane for California. MAKEBA accompanied CARMICHAEL to the airport.

RESNICK advised that he has read about the search for KINGS killer in the California area, and thought that possibly there might be some connection between the trip by CARMICHAEL and the killing.

RESNICK said the best time to contact him would be in the evening, and he should be called to make certain he is home and available if anyone would like to go to his home WFB





Writer received call at 9:40 a.m. this date from a sales clerk, Woodward and Lothrop, Mr. MELVIN B. ATKINSON who is in the Major Appliance Section, 2nd floor, North Building, 11th and G, S. W., Washington, D.C. ATKINSON said he noticed an individual who is similar in appearance to the newspaper photos of JAMES EARL RAY, suspect in instant matter. This person came through his area of the store and went to the men's room on two occasions, once in the late morning of 4/18/68, and again at the same time on 4/19/68. ATKINSON said the man acted suspiciously, appeared unkempt (as if he had been sleeping in his clothes) and was dressed on 4/19/68 in khaki trousers, white shirt with tie, and dirty shoes, although he was clean shaven. The man was about 6' tall, and fits the general description of RAY.

ATKINSON could furnish no information to further identify this individual, but stated that he (ATKINSON) is an ex-policeman and felt it was important enough to call the FBI. He was advised to immediately advise the FBI and his store police if the above described man returns. ATKINSON gave his phone number as 347-5300, X678 or 654.
