2. Did anyone with CIA connections work on the ^{LA police} investigation of the ^(En-reekay) assassination of Robert Kennedy. (Specifically did Sgt. Enrique ^(pen-ya) (Hank) Hernandez or Lt. Manuel Pena ever work for any agency connected with the CIA) ?
