Jose Duarte, a former major in Fidel Castro's army, said in Miami that he had attended a pro-Castro meeting in Los Angeles May 21 and there met the accused slayer of Robert F. Kennedy, Sirhan Sirhan. Mr. Duarte said he asked permission to speak to the meeting in favor of the U.S., but Sirhan (whom Mr. Duarte didn't know by name at the time), violently objected, called him a CIA agent, shouted obscenities, and added "what this country needs is another Castro."
