For background, I am the case agent for the Robert F. Kennedy assassination which occurred in LA in 1968. For reference, the Sentinel case is **89A-LA-156** (Legacy Case LA-56-156). You may be able to take a look at the intriguing evidence from that day and investigation through Sentinel.

I am reaching out to you because I was given your name as a contact for the FBI Museum/Experience. The historical value of the evidence, which is housed in the LA Evidence Center, I think would be much better served on public display for posterity and education than boxed up in a dark warehouse just sitting.
