



ADEL BISHARA SIRHAN IS - MIDDLE EAST

This to advise that at 9:30 a.m. 9/8/70, SE ROBERT LYNCH received the following information from Mr. CARROLL H. SEELEY, Assistant Chief, Legal Division, Passport Office, Department of State.

About 2:15 a.m. on 9/8/70, the Passport Office Duty Officer received a call from a <u>Mr. LUKE MCKISSOCK</u>, telephone 213-466-7331, a friend of ADEL BISHARA SIRHAN. McKISSOCK related that SIRHAN, born **Mathematical**, in Jerusalem, residing at 696 E. Howard St., Pasadena, California, has a 1963 passport which he wanted renewed urgently. McKISSOCK was told that such a passport cannot be renewed and SIRHAN must apply for a new passport.

McKISSOCK stated originally that SIRHAN was leaving Los Angeles at 8:30 a.m. arriving New York City 4:55 p.m. on 9/8/70. He then wanted to depart for Athens, Greece, at 6:20 p.m. (9/8/70) on TWA flight 880. McKISSOCK stated that this was an emergency passport situation and he wanted the passport agency to deliver the passport to SIRHAN at the airport in New York. The Duty Officer explained the procedure which requires physical appearance by the applicant for a passport before a State Department Passport Agent. The Duty Officer asked what the emergency was and McKISSOCK replied, "It is very complicated but he must make the '6:20' flight 880 tomorrow". (sic)

McKISSOCK was given the duty hours of the New York and Los Angeles Passport Agencies. He then stated that he would get SIRHAN to New York as soon after noon on 9/8/70 as possible. SIRHAN is to go to Station No. 1 at the New York Passport Agency after obtaining his photographs and filling SEARCHED INDEXED Y 10.5 01864-1 out the application. MCKISSOCK OROGINALLY STATED SIRHAN WOULD LEAVE LOS ANGELES EIGHT THIRTY A.M. AND ARRIVE NEW YORK FOUR FIFTY FIVE P.M. SEPTEMBER EIGHT. FURTHER, SIRHAN WANTED TO DEPART FOR ATHENS, GREECE, SIX TWENTY P.M. SEPTEMBER EIGHT ON TWA FLIGHT EIGHT EIGHT ZERO. MCKISSOCK REQUESTED PASSPORT BE DELIVERED TO SIRHAN AT AIRPORT IN NEW YORK BECAUSE OF EMERGENCY PASSPORT SITUATION, BUT WAS TOLD PROCEDURE REQUIRED PHYSICAL APPEARANCE OF APPLICANT BEFORE USDS PASSPORT AGENT. IN REPLY TO QUESTION AS TO NATURE OF EMERGENCY, MCKISSOCK REPLIED QUOTE IT IS VERY COMPLICATED, BUT HE MUST MAKE THE 'SIX TWENTY' FLIGHT EIGHT EIGHT ZERO TOMORROW PAREN SIC ENPAREN UNQUOTE. MCKISSOCK WAS FURNISHED DUTY HOURS OF NEW YORK AND LOS ANGELES PASSPORT AGENCIES. MCKISSOCK STATED HE WOULD GET SIRHAN TO NEW YORK AS SOON AFTER NOON ON SEPTEMBER EIGHT AS POSSIBLE. SIRHAN IS TO GO TO STATION NUMBER ONE, NEW YORK PASSPORT AGENCY, AFTER OBTAINING PHOTOGRAPHS AND COMPLETING APPLICATION.

ON NINE EIGHT SEVENTY, HARRY MEYERS, DETECTIVE, PORT OF NEW YORK AUTHORITY POLICE DEPARTMENT, ADVISED THAT MRS. MARY SIRHAN AND SUBJECT WERE TRAVELING WITH L. MC KISSICK AND M. MC COWAN, NOT FURTHER IDENTIFIED, ABOARD TWA FLIGHT ONE HUNDRED FROM LOS ANGELES TO NEW YORK, ON THIS DATE. THE PARTY IS TO TRANSFER TO TWA FLIGHT EIGHT EIGHT ZERO FROM NEW YORK TO ATHENS, SCHEDULED TO DEPART SIX TWENTY PM TODAY. MEYERS ADVISED THAT AS OF ONE THIRTY PM, TWA FLIGHT ONE HUNDRED WAS OVER ONE HOUR LATE AND WOULD NOT MEET ITS SCHEDULED ARRIVAL IN NEW YORK OF FOUR THIRTY PM. RE NYTEL SEPTEMBER EIGHT SEVENTY AND LOS ANGELES TELS SAME DATE

MRS. MARY BISHARA SALAMEH SIRHAN, ATTORNEY LUKE MC KISSACK AND MICHAEL MC COWAN ARRIVED AT JOHN F. KENNEDY (JFK) AIRPORT, NEW YORK, ABOARDTRANS WORLD AIRLINES (TWA) FLIGHT ONE HUNDRED, ON SEPTEMBER EIGHT SEVENTY AT SIX ZERO FIVE PM. THEY WERE MET BY ADEL BISHARA SIRHAN AND NUMEROUS MÉMBERS OF THE PRESS.

JOSEPH M. MC CORMICK, SECURITY REPRESENTATIVE, TWA, JFK, ADVISED THAT AT TIME FLIGHT ONE HUNDRED LANNED AT JFK, TWA HAD END PAGE ONE

BEEN INSTRUCTED BY U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT NOT TO PERMIT THE SIRHAN PARTY TO EXIT U.S. ABOARD TWA. MCORMICK STATED THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT WAS NOTIFYING U.S. IMMIGRATION AUTHORITIES NEW YORK, TO REMOVE THE U.S. PASSPORTS OF MEMBERS OF THE PARTY.

SUPERVISORY INSPECTOR D. E. FARRELL, U.S. CUSTOMS SERVICE, ADVISED THAT HE HAD BEEN INSTRUCTED TO REVOKE THE PASSPORTS OF MC COWAN AND MC KISSACK AND TO PREVENT THE DEPARTURE OF MARY AND ADEL SIRHAN. HE MET THE MEMBERS OF THE PARTY AT THE TWA BUILDING AT JFK.

THE FIRST PAGES OF THE PASSPORTS OF MC KISSACK AND MC COWAN WERE MARKED BY FARRELL " REVOKED PERSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF FRED SMITH, DEPUTY ADMINISTRATOR, BUREAU OF Consular SECURITY AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS, U.S. DEPARTMENT OF STATE". FARRELL ADVISED THAT HE TOOK NO ACTION CONCERNING THE PASSPORTS OF MARY SIRHAN AND ADEL SIRHAN, SINCE THEY ARE PERMANENT RESIDENT ALIENS AND NOT U.S. CITIZENS. FARRELL ALSO SERVED NOTICE ON TWA THAT MC KISSACK, MC COWAN AND THE SIRHANS ARE NOT TO BE TRANSPORTED TO FOREIGN DESTINATION FROM THE U.S., PERSUANT TO SECION TWO ONE FIVE OF THE IMMIGRATION END PAGE TWO PAGE THREE

AND NATIONALITY ACT (TITLE EIGHT, U.S. CODE, SECTION ONE ONE EIGHT FIVE) AND OTHER REGULATIONS. (INS FORM I-TWO EIGHT ONE) FARRELL SAID THAT COPIES OF THIS NOTICE WERE FURNISHED TO THE PARTIES CONCERNED AND THAT LIKE NOTICES WERE BEING SERVED ON ALL CARRIERS OF PASSENGERS TO FOREIGN DESTINATIONS.

MC KISSACK THEN HELD A PRESS CONFERENCE WITH MRS SIRHAN. HE DESCRIBED HIMSELF AS THE ATTORNEY FOR <u>SIRHAN B. SIRHAN</u>. HE STATED THAT IT WAS THE INTENTION OF MRS. SIRHAN TO PLEAD WITH ARAB FORCES FOR THE RELEASE OF PASSENGERS OF RECENTLY HI JACKED AIRCRAFT. HE STATED THAT HER SON SIRHAN B. SIRHAN IS CONSIDERED A HERO IN THE ARAB WORLD AND THERE FORE HER PLEA WOULD BE HEEDED. HE CONTENDED THAT THE REVOCATION OF THE SIRHAN PARTY' S PASSPORTS WAS A "DASTARDLY" DEED AND WAS PROBABLY ILLEGAL. MRS. SIRHAN STATED HER ONLY INTENTION END PAGE THREE PAGE FOUR

WAS TO SECURE RELASE OF THE HOSTAGES. MC KISSACK MADE FURTHER REMARKS CONDEMNING THE STATE DEPARTMENT AND EMPHASIZED HE HAD BEEN UNABLE TO REACH ANY RESPONSIBLE U.S. GOVERMENT OFFICIALS. HE SAID THAT THEY WOULD RETURN TO LOS ANGELES IF UNABLE TO CONTINUE TRAVEL AFTER THE CONFERENCE. MC CORMICK ADVISED THAT MC KISSACK HAS REQUESTED ACCOMMODATIONS IN NEW YORK FOR NIGHT OF SEPTEMBER EIGHT. MC KISSACK SAID FURTHER THAT HE PLANNED ANOTHER PRESS CONFERENCE AT TEN AM. SEPTEMBER NINE SEVENTY, AFTER WHICH THE PARTY WOULD PROBABLY RETURN TO LOS ANGELES. RESERVATIONS WERE MADE BY TWA FOR PARTY AT THE INTERNATIONAL HOTEL. JFK.

WILLIAM D. O'LEARY, ASSISTANT TO GENERAL MANAGER,. INTERNATIONAL HOTEL, ADVISED THAT THE SIRHAN PARTY HAD CHECKED IN AT ABOUT EIGHT THIRTY PM, WITH MC KISSACK IN ROOM FIVE NINE ZERO, MC COWAN IN ROOM FIVE EIGHT SEVEN AND MARY AND ADEL SIRHAN IN ROOM FIVE NINE TWO. MC KISSACK REQUESTED A ROOM FOR A PRESS CONFERENCE TO BE HELD AT THE HOTEL AT TEN AM. ON SEPTEMBER NINE. MC CORMICK ADVISED THAT THE PARTY HAS NOT MADE ARRANGEMENTS FOR RETURN TO LOS ANGELES WITH TWA.

ON NINE NINE SEVENTY, AT EIGHT AM, MARSHALL BAKER, SALES REPRESENTATIVE, INTERNATIONAL HOTEL, JFK AIRPORT, ADVISED THAT LUKE MC KISSICK MADE ARRANGEMENTS FOR A PRESS CONFERENCE TO BE HELD AT THE INTERNATIONAL HOTEL FROM TEN AM TO ELEVEN AM ON NINE NINE SEVENTY. THIRTY MEMBERS OF THE PRESS WERE ANTICIPATED BY MC KISSICK. WING ROOM A WAS DESIGNATED BY BAKER FOR THE CONFERENCE.

MC KISSICK, MC COWAN, MRS. SIRHAN AND ADEL SIRHAN ARRIVED AT PRESS CONFERENCE AT TEN ZERO EIGHT AM. ABOUT FORTY MEMBERS OF THE PRESS ARE PRESENT.

MC KISSICK OPENED UP THE CONFERENCE ABOUT TEN TEN AM STATING HE IS THE SPOKESMAN FOR MARY B. SIRHAN AND THE SIRHAN FAMILY. THE BASIC REASON THAT THEY WANTED TO GO WAS TO "SAVE LIVES", THEY WISH TO PERSUADE ARAB GUERRILLAS THAT THE TAKING OF HUMAN LIVES IS NOT BENEFICIAL TO ANYONE.

MCKISSICK ADVISED THAT DESPITE REPEATED ATTEMPTS TO CONTACT FRED B. SMITH, THE GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVE WHO CANCELLED HIS PASSPORT, HE HAS NOT BEEN SUCCESSFUL.

IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION PUT FORTH BY A NEWS REPORTER CONCERNING WHETHER OR NOT THE PURPOSE OF MRS. SIRHAN'S TRIP TO THE MIDDLE EAST WAS TO TRADE HER SON'S LIFE FOR THE LIVES OF THE HOSTAGES, MRS. SIRHAN REPLIED THAT THIS WAS NOT TRUE, THAT ALL HUMAN LIFE IS PRECIOUS TO HER. REPORTERS IN ATTENDANCE AT THE CONFENCE HAVE ASKED SEVERAL TIMES ABOUT THE EXACT PURPOSE OF THE SIRHAN FAMILY TRIP TO THE MIDDLE EAST AND EACH TIME THEY HAVE BEEN ADVISED BY MR. MC KISSICK THAT THE SOLE PURPOSE OF THEIR TRIP WAS TO SAVE THE LIVES OF THE HOSTAGES. MR. MC KISSICK POINTED OUT THAT ONE OF THE KEY FACTORS WAS THE TIME ELEMENT.

AT THE QPENING OF THE PRESS CONFERENCE, LUKE MC KISSICK EXPRESSED DISAPPOINTMENT AT THE PRESS COVERAGE HE HAD RECEIVED ON HIS PREVIOUS PRESS CONFERENCE ON NINE EIGHT SEVENTY. HE STATED THAT HE WAS DISAPPOINTED AT SECRETARY OF STATE ROGER'S COMMENT CONCERNING THE EFFORTS OF THE UNITED STATES TO SECURE THE RELEASE OF HOSTAGES IN JORDAN. HE STATED THAT HIS AND MRS. SIRHAN'S PRIME CONSIDERATION IN THEIR EFFORTS IS TO SAVE LIVES.

IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION CONCERNING WHY THE ARABS SHOULD LISTEN TO MRS. SIRHAN, MC KISSICK STATED THAT HE BELIEVES THAT SHE COULD BE PERSUASIVE WITH THEM. HE ADDED THAT HE DOES NOT KNOW IF THE RELEASE OF SIRHAN B. SIRHAN IS PRESENTLY ON THE LIST OF DEMANDS BEING MADE BY THE ARABS. HE DOES KNOW THAT IT WAS AT ONE TIME A DEMAND, BUT HE DOES NOT KNOWN IF IT CONTINUES TO BE ONE. HE AGAIN STATED THAT SIRHAN SIRHAN IS A HERO IN THE ARAB WORLD AND THAT MRS. SIRHAN WOULD BE LISTENED TO FOR THAT REASON AND WOULD BE ABLE TO SPEAK OUT AGAINST VIOLENCE.

MC KISSICK THEN STATED IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION THAT MRS. SIRHAN HAS A VALID JORDANIAN PASSPORT, BUT IS BEING PROHIBITED FROM LEAVING THE UNITED STATES BY GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY.

IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION CONCERNING WHY THE ARAB GUERRILLAS ARE HOLDING HOSTAGES, MRS. SIRHAN ANSWERED THAT THEY ARE PERSECUTED PEOPLE, THAT THEIR LIVES ARE LESS THAN HUMAN AND THAT THEY ARE FORCED TO TAKE THESE MEASURES EVEN IF THEY DO NOT WISH TO DO SO.

WHEN ASKED WHY THE ARAB GUERRILLAS WOULD REQUEST THE RELEASE OF SIRHAN SIRHAN, MRS. SIRHAN ANSWERED THAT HE IS A PALESTINIAN. SHE DID NOT ELABORATE.

IN RESPONSE TO THE QUESTION IS THERE ANY OTHER REASON WHY THE PASSPORTS OF THE PARTY WERE REVOKED, MC KISSICK ANSWERED THAT IT WAS HIS OPINION THAT MRS. SIRHAN MIGHT "UP-STAGE" THE STATE DEPARTMENT IN THE INTERNATIONAL SCENE AND THAT THE EGO OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OFFICIALS MIGHT BE HURT. HE CONTINUED THAT MRS. SIRHAN AND HE WOULD HAVE NO PROBLEM TALKING TO THE GUERRILLAS, WHERE THE STATE DEPARTMENT APPEARS TO HAVE PROBLEMS IN THIS DIRECTION.

HE STATED THAT IF THIS IS THE REASONING OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT IT IS NOT LEGITIMATE. END PAGE FOUR MC KISSICK STATED HE DOES NOT INTEND TO ENTER NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE US STATE DEPARTMENT CONCERNING THE RESTORING OF HIS PASSPORT SINCE HE BELIEVES SUCH NEGOTIATIONS WOULD BE FRUITLESS.

MC KISSICK THEN ALUDED TO FRED SMITH, THE STATE DEPARTMENT OFFICIAL UPON WHOSE AUTHORITY HIS AND MICHAEL MC COWAN'S PASSPORTS WERE REVOKED. HE STATED THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT IS IN HIDING, AND THAT HE WAS UNABLE TO REACH SMITH OR ANY OTHER RESPONSIBLE OFFICIAL BY TELEPHONE AT THE TIME OF THE PASSPORT REVOCATION. HE WISHES TO DEBATE SMITH OR ANOTHER OFFICIAL IN A PUBLIC FORUM.

CONCERNING HIS PRESENT PLANS, MC KISSICK STATED THAT HE, MC COWAN AND THE SIRHANS PLAN TO STAY IN NEW YORK THIS EVENING. THEY HOPE TO GET ON A TV TALK SHOW IN ORDER TO EXPRESS THEIR OPINIONS FREELY WITHOUT THE PRESSURE OF A PRESS CONFERENCE. MC KISSICK OPENLY INVITED STATE DEPARTMENT OFFICIALS TO BE PRESENT TO GET THEIR SIDE BUT COMMENTED THAT HE DOUBTED THAT THEY WOULD ACCEPT HIS INVITATION. HE COMMENTED THAT HE HAS NOT BEEN INVITED TO APPEAR ON ANY TV SHOW AS YET BUT POINTED OUT THAT HE HAS BEEN IN VIRTUAL SECLUSION SINCE ARRIVING IN NEW YORK.

MC KISSICK STATED THAT HE HAS TRIED REPEATEDLY TO CONTACT MR. GEORGE SHIBLEY (PHONETIC) IN BEIRUT WITHOUT SUCCESS. MRS. SIRHAN WAS AGAIN ASKED IF IN FACT THE PURPOSE OF HER TRIP WAS NOT TO OBTAIN AMNESTY FOR HOR SON. MRS. SIRHAN INDICATED THAT ANY MOTHER IN HER POSITION WOULD WANT TO GAIN FREEDOM FOR HER SON.

WHEN ASKED BY THE NEWS MEDIA IF SHE BELIEVED THE GUERRILLAS WOULD KILL THE HOSTAGES, SHE REPLIED, "I AM SORRY. I HOPE NOT."

NEWS MEDIA ASKED MR. MC KISSICK IF HE OR THE SIRHAN FAMILY HAD BEEN IN TOUCH WITH ANY OF THE FAMILIES OF THE HOSTAGES. HE REPLIED THAT THERE HAD BEEN NO COMMUNICATION ON THAT LEVEL. PAGE SEVEN

WHEN MC KISSICK WAS ASKED IF HE OR THE SIRHAN FAMILY HAD BEEN IN TOUCH WITH THE ARAB GUERRILLAS, HE ADVISED THAT THE SIRHAN FAMILY IN JORDAN HAD FRIENDS AMONG THE GUERRILLAS.

CONCERNING THE FINANCING OF THE TRIP, MC KISSICK STATED THAT HE IS FINANCING HIS OWN TRAVEL, THAT THE SIRHANS ARE TRAVELING ON HIS CREDIT CARD. HE HAS HOPES OF SOLICITING THE AID OF THE BRAODCASTING NETWORKS IN HOPES THAT THEY WILL SUBSIDIZE THIS TRAVEL IN PETURN FOR FIRST HAND COVERAGE.

Poster distributed in Arab countries by the Palestine Liberation Organization last year says, "Sirhan B. Sirhan-a guerrilla, not a murderer." Writing at bottom criticizes "Zionist circles" in the U.S. for allegedly trying to distort motives behind shooting of Senator Robert F. Kennedy.

Siphan Bishara Mrhan — whose release was mentioned in some accounts yesterday as an Arab commando demand in return for the free-dom of some 150 hijacked passengers—has said in interviews that he expected to be freed at some time in similar fashion.

The Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine, which held the hostages, officially denied, however, making such a demand. The slim, dark-haired Jor-

danian immigrant, convicted last year of the murder of Senator Robert F. Kennedy, is in a small cell on death row in California's San Quentin Prison. He is appeal-ing his death sentence.

During his four-month trial last year, Sirhan repeatedly told of his intense hatred of Senator Remedy for his es-pousal of the Israeli cause

and for his pledges to send additional United States war planes to Israel.

Although the trial never became a sounding board for the pros and cons of the Israeli-Arab conflict, there was testimony about Sirhan's un-happy boyhood in Jeru-salem's Palestinian Arab quarter where he witnessed a number of bloody clashes. "I did it for my country,"

a witness quoted Sirhan as saying shortly after the shooting of Senator Kennedy at the Ambassador Hotel in Los Angeles.

Reached by telephone yes-terday at her home in Pasa-dena Calif., Mrs. Mary Sir-han, the mother of the con-victed murderer, in a voice that sounded as if she was both laughing and crying, said "I can't believe it" when told of the reported bid for her son's freedom. 2025 RELEASE UNDER E.O. 14176





On September 8, 1970, Carroll H. Seeley, Assistant Chief, Legal Division, Passport Office, United States Department of State (USDS), furnished the following information:

About 2:15 a.m., September 8, 1970, the Duty Officer, Passport Office, USDS, received a call from Luke McKissock, telephone 213-466-7331, who claimed to be a friend of Adel Bishara Sirhan, who was born for the form Jerusalem and who was residing at 696 East Howard Street, Pasadena, California. McKissock stated that Sirhan wanted to renew urgently his 1963 passport. McKissock was told that such passport could not be renewed and that Sirhan would have to apply for a new passport.

McKissock orginally stated that Sirhan would leave Los Angeles at 8:30 a.m. and arrive New York at 4:55 p.m., September 8, 1970. Further, McKissock stated that Sirhan wanted to depart for Athens, Greece, at 6:20 p.m., September 8, 1970, on "TWA Flight 880." McKissock stated that this wam an emergency passport situation and he wanted the passport agency to deliver the passport to Sirhan at the airport in New York. The Duty Officer explained that the procedure required the physical appearance of the applicant for a passport before a USDS Passport Agent. In reply to the Duty Officer's question as to the nature of the emergency, McKissock replied "It is very complicated, but he must make the '6:20' flight 880 tomorrow (sic)." McKissock was furnished the duty

hours of the New York and Los Angeles Passport Agencies. McKissock then stated he would get Sirhan to New York as soon after noon on September 8, as possible. Sirhan was to go to Station Number 1, New York Passport Agency, after obtaining his photographs and completing his application.

Mrs. Mary Bishara Salameh Sirhan, Luke McKisseck, an attorney, and Michael McCowan arrived at John F. Kennedy (JFK) Airport, New York City, aboard Transverid Airlines (TWA) Flight 100 on September 8, 1970 at 6:05 p.m. They were met by Adel Bishara Sirhan and numerous members of the press.

Joseph M. McCormick, Security Representative, TWA, JFK, advised that at the time TWA Flight1100 landedaat JFK, TWA had been instructed by USDS not to permit the Sirhan party to exit the United States (US) aboard TWA. McCormick stated that USDS was notifying US immigration authomities in New York to remove the US passports of members of the party.

In a press conference held by McKissack and Mrs. Sirhan on September 8, 1970, McKissack described himself as the attorney for Sirhan B. Sirhan, the convicted assassin of Senator Robert F. Kennedy. McKissack statedtthat it was the intention of Mrs. Sirhan to plead with Arab forces for the release of passengers of recently hijacked aircraft. He stated that Mrs. Sirhan's son, Sirhan B. Sirhan, is considered a hero in the Arab world and therefore her plea would be heeded.

A USDS Report of Investigation dated August 23, 1956, under the Refugee Relief Program (IRP), reveals that Adel Bishara Salameh Ghattas Sirhan, who was born Jerusalem, Palestine, is the son of Bishara Salameh Ghattas Sirhan, who was born for the first in Palestine. USDS IRP Report of Investigation concerning Bishara Salameh Ghattas Sirhan, dated May 22, 1956, reveals that Adel Sirhan is the brother of Sirhan Sirhan.
