NO ADDRESS IN EITHER CITY WAS GIVEN, NOR REASONS FOR TRAVELLING TO THESE CITIES INDICATED. THE FOLLOWING IS A DESCRIPTION OF SMITH, WALTON AND MILLER:

WALTON, DOB , POB CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, MALE NEGRO, FIVE FEET EIGHT INCHES, ONE FORTY FIVE POUNDS, BROWN EYES, HAIR, NATURAL STYLE, BLACK. PII

MILLER, DOB , POB CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, FEMALE NEGRO, FIVE FEET SEVEN INCHES, ONE THREE FIVE POUNDS, HAIR NATURAL STYLE, ATTIRE USUALLY DRESSES AFRO-TYPE DRESS, DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS, EIGHT MONTHS PREGNANT. PII

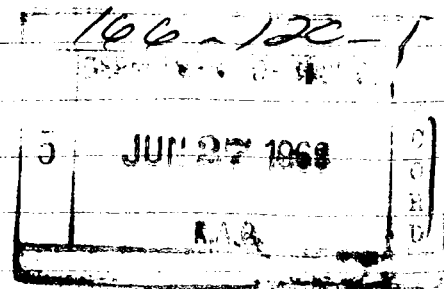
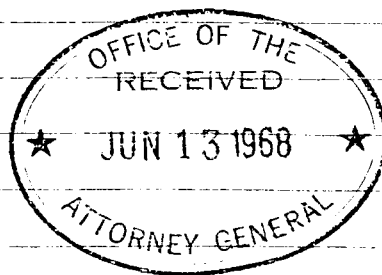

# Senator Robert Kennedy's Bitter End

JUNE 6, 1968
