It was reported that the Kennedy family intends to ask that Poor Peoples' Campaign leaders delegate an "honor guard" to accompany the body during the procession.

Arrangements for the procession are being co-ordinated thru a close friend of the family, Chief U.S. Marshal John P. McShane.

District police will handle movement of the procession thru city streets. Leaves and day-off time have been canceled and two-thirds of the District's 3000-man force is expected to be on duty. National Guardsmen are also expected to be on hand to help with traffic control.

Lookout for Woman in Polka Dots

Indictment Is Sought for Suspect

LOS ANGELES, June 7 (UPI) — A California grand jury assembled today to consider a request for a murder indictment against Sirhan Sirhan, the accused assassin of Sen. Robert F. Kennedy.

Sheriff's officers tightened security at the Los Angeles County jail in response to phoned threats to storm the jail and kill the 24-year-old Jordanian immigrant. They said the callers said they would risk anything — even death — to eliminate the man they believe killed Sen. Kennedy.

Sheriff Peter J. Pitchess said Sirhan, captured Wednesday morning at the Ambassador hotel after Sen. Kennedy was felled by a bullet in the brain, remained outwardly calm and unconcerned. The slight, swarthy race track exercise boy and health store stock clerk was confined to a 12-by-12 windowless cell in the remote hospital wing of the downtown jail.

CONSTANT WATCH

A dim ceiling light illuminated the gray walls of the cell and the prison bunk he slept upon. A wash basin and toilet were the only other furnishings. An unarmed, uniformed deputy sat on a stool outside the cell and watched Sirhan's every move. A second armed deputy outside kept his eyes glued on the suspect thru an unbreakable glass porthole.

Four guards paced up and down a narrow corridor outside. Other deputies patrolled every nook and cranny of the jail complex.

The extreme concern over keeping Sirhan alive convinced Dist. Atty. Evelle J. Younger to go to the grand jury for the indictment, rather than following the normal procedure of filing a formal murder complaint.

Filing a complaint necessitates a preliminary hearing, a courtroom proceeding that would have required Sirhan to be present. The grand jury method carries no such equipment.

No law enforcement official here wants to transfer Sirhan from his tightly guarded jail cell

and risk the possibility that, like Lee Harvey Oswald, Sirhan might himself fall victim to an assassin before coming to trial.

The grand jury hearing may shed some light on growing speculation that the man who shot Kennedy may not have gone to the Ambassador Hotel election party alone.

WOMAN SOUGHT

An all-points bulletin was in effect for a young woman in a polka dot dress who ran from the primary victory celebration shortly after Sen. Kennedy was killed.

"We shot him," a campaign worker said the woman told her.

"Prior to the shooting," according to the police report, "suspect (Sirhan) was observed with a female Caucasian described as 23 to 27 years, 5 feet 6 inches tall, wearing a white voile dress with three-quarter sleeves and with small black polka dots."

The woman wore dark shoes and "bouffant type hair."

"We don't think it was a conspiracy at this time," a police investigator said, "but we are not going to throw anything into the wastebasket."

Altho the grand jury proceedings are officially secret, it was learned the DA's office planned to call 17 witnesses, including Assembly Speaker Jesse Unruh, Sen. Kennedy's California campaign manager, and Olympic champion Rafer Johnson and football player Roosevelt Grier, the two men who disarmed and immobilized the suspect.

No members of Sen. Kennedy's immediate family were scheduled to appear.

Mr. Younger said the evidence should be presented by tonight, but he said it "might be a long day."

TRIAL IN 60 DAYS

After arraignment, Sirhan has 10 days in which to file a plea. California law requires the DA's office to bring the defendant to trial within 60

days of his pleading, but the defense frequently wins delays.

Sirhan, a few hours after the shooting, was arraigned on six counts of assault with the intent to commit murder and bail was set at \$250,000. But the Senator's death automatically made it a capital case, which is not bailable.

Strict precautions were taken to make certain that Sirhan's right to a fair trial would not be prejudiced by any misstep by the police or prosecutors. He was repeatedly warned that he was not required to make a statement, and that he did make a statement voluntarily, it would be used in evidence against him. Whether due to warnings or to a desire to protect other possible conspirators, Sirhan remained silent regarding the case, altho he is reported to have talked freely on other subjects.

MAYOR YORTY

The ironclad, multiple-eyewitnessed case against the Jordanian gunman might have become a model of restraint on the part of police district attorney and news media if it had not been for mayor Sam Yorty of Los Angeles, one of the nation's most volatile politicians.

Mr. Yorty, a man for whom TV cameras exercise a deadly fascination, appeared twice in press conferences after the shooting, and both times disclosed information that legal purists might hold transgressed the newly defined rights of accused criminals. Mr. Yorty's indiscretions, if that is what they were, hinged on the disclosure of some of the contents of a journal Sirhan had kept. Mr. Yorty also extrapolated the conclusion that Sirhan had been subject to communist influence because a car to which the suspect had access had been seen parked in front of a place where the communist-front W.E.B. DuBois club held meetings. Subsequently, Mr. Yorty admitted that he did not know whether Sirhan was using the car or not at the time, but insisted that contents of the man's notebook showed unmistakable communist influence.

The Attorney General of California rebuked Mr. Yorty for his comments on the case, and the California American Civil Liberties Union while applauding DA Younger and Police Chief Tom Reddin for their handling of the case — pointedly omitted Mr. Yorty from its praise.

In spite of what many Californians regard as the typical Yortyisms, however, the case against Sirhan seemed to be unshakable. Perhaps as many as a dozen eyewitnesses watched his rampage of murder and assault. His own writing (if it is admitted against him) shows he was determined to kill Sen. Kennedy, and the murder weapon was forcibly taken from his hand after the shooting. One of the bullets that struck Sen. Kennedy remained intact and was removed at the autopsy. It will undoubtedly be compared to test shots fired from Sirhan's .22, and thus will forge another link in the chain of evidence that may send him to California's gas chamber.

Sirhan Asks 'Big Name' Lawyer

LOS ANGELES, June 10 (UPD) — Sirhan Bishara Sirhan has asked the American Civil Liberties Union to help find a "big name" lawyer to defend him against the charge of assassinating Robert F. Kennedy.

A. L. Wirin, noted constitutional lawyer and chief counsel of the Southern California ACLU, has been visiting Sirhan daily in his cell and planned to do so today.

This week Mr. Wirin will ask presiding judge Richard Schauer of Los Angeles Superior Court to call on the Los Angeles Bar Association and other legal groups to obtain a defense attorney.

Superior Judge Arthur Alarcon rejected Mr. Wirin's motion at the arraignment for "one or more outstanding lawyers" to be appointed to defend Sirhan but indicated he would reconsider the request at a later time.

DELAYS PLEA

Sirhan presently is represented by Wilbur F. Littlefield, chief deputy trial lawyer in the public

defender's office. At his request, entering of a plea of guilt or innocence was continued until June 28.

Sirhan has indicated to Mr. Wirin he would prefer to be defended by a private lawyer, altho he is not opposed to Mr. Littlefield in particular. Mr. Wirin hopes that a lawyer of the caliber of Melvin Belli, who defended Jack Ruby in Dallas, would be sought by the court.

HEAVY GUARD

Meanwhile, Sirhan remained under heavy guard in the second floor hospital ward of Central Jail. Newspapers are distributed in the ward and deputies said Sirhan probably had seen photographs of the funeral of the man he is accused of killing June 5.

While legal efforts continued to find a defense attorney for the suspect, police and prosecution attorneys were busy seeking answers to several questions, including whether the slaying was the result of a lone assassin or of a conspiracy.

C., one Bassim Akkad. This latter individual, according to Anis, is acquainted with another employee of the Saudi Arabian Embassy, unidentified, who knows Sirhan Sirhan, the individual involved in captioned matter. According to Anis, this embassy employee describes Sirhan as a Palestinian Christian coming from Silvan Village, a suburb of Jerusalem on the Jordanian side of the 1948 armistice line. He states that Sirhan comes from a well-to-do family and has been in the United States for 5 years as a student.

On 6/10/68, WF 1573-S (protect identity, reliable in past) furnished the following information:

Some good friends of informant and spouse, THOMAS and THELMA KOUZES, 3524 Barkley Drive, Fairfax, Virginia, have had in the past several years foreign students living with them while they attended local colleges. One of these is HAMID ARWODI who is from Kuwait. ARWODI lived with the KOUZES family for about three years and left in about December, 1967.

Informant related that on Thanksgiving Day, ¹⁹⁶⁷ he and his family had dinner with the KOUZES family at the latter's residence. During the day ARWODI, accompanied by a number of other Arab students, spent some time with the dinner guests and entered into political discussions. ARWODI and others indicated deep hatred of Israel and expressed anti-U. S. sentiments because of our support of Israel. They also indicated they were opposed to ROBERT KENNEDY especially because he had backed Israel. Informant stated ARWODI and the other students at no time made any threatening statements in regard to KENNEDY but the comment was made that they hoped he would not be President.

Informant said ARWODI is a student at American University and apparently has his own apartment in Washington, D. C., is the head of an Arab student organization at American University. Informant has not seen him since the above incident. In addition, informant does not know the names of any of the other Arab students he met on Thanksgiving Day.

According to the informant, he realizes the above information is nonspecific and that these students did not make threatening statements but he felt it advisable to inform the FBI in view of the assassination of Senator KENNEDY.

On 6/13/68, EARL CLANDIA MURPHY, 5932 3rd Street, N.W., WDC, advised that a few days before the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, he attended a rally for Senator KENNEDY at 14th and Park Road, N.W., WDC.

He stated a white male approximately 35-40 years of age, 5'6", 200 pounds, of stocky build, wearing a dark top coat and hat stood next to him as the Senator was speaking. He said this man held up a round object gray in color, approximately 2' long and 3" in diameter with an electric cord extending from it.

MURPHY said he asked the man what the object was and the man replied it was a microphone. MURPHY said this man then moved around the outer circle of the crowd and moved in toward Senator KENNEDY. MURPHY said he followed the man a short distance, the man moving in a fairly rapid fashion; however, the man disappeared in the large crowd. MURPHY stated it was

possible this man was a technician from the press and moved into a better position. He said he could not describe this individual further as the light was poor; Senator KENNEDY was then speaking at a late evening hour. MURPHY said he doubted whether he could recognize this man if he should see him again due to the limited amount of light at the time.

MURPHY stated this man appeared to be alone and MURPHY stated he could furnish no additional information. He indicated he furnished this information as it might have had some connection to the shooting of Senator KENNEDY at Los Angeles.

Mr. MURPHY's interest and cooperation in this matter were acknowledged. WFO conducting no further investigation at this time.

Sirhan wants 'big name' attorney to defend him

LOS ANGELES (UPI) — Sirhan Bishara Sirhan has asked the American Civil Liberties Union to help find a "big name" lawyer to defend him against the charge of assassinating Robert F. Kennedy.

A. L. Wirin, noted constitutional lawyer and chief counsel of the Southern California ALCU, has been visiting Sirhan daily in his cell.

This week Wirin will ask presiding Judge Richard Schauer of Los Angeles Superior Court to call on the Los Angeles Bar Association and other legal groups to obtain a defense attorney.

Superior Judge Arthur Alarcon rejected Wirin's motion at the arraignment for "one or more outstanding lawyers" to be appointed to defend Sirhan but indicated he would reconsider the request at a later time.

WIRIN EMPHASIZES that the ALCU has not undertaken the defense of Sirhan and has commended the courts and prosecution for vigorously protecting the defendant's rights, rare praise from the ALCU.

Sirhan presently is represented by Wilbur F. Littlefield, chief deputy trial lawyer in the public defender's office. At his request entering of a plea of guilty or innocence was continued until June 28.

Sirhan has indicated to

Wirin he would prefer to be defended by a private lawyer, although he is not opposed to Littlefield in particular. Wirin hopes that a lawyer of the caliber of Melvin Belli, who defended Jack Ruby in Dallas, would be sought by the court.

'Gun Merchants' Plotted RFK Life

PARIS June 11 (UPI) — North Vietnamese diplomats charged today that "gun merchants" with financial interests in the Vietnam war may have conspired in "a plot" to eliminate Sen. Robert F. Kennedy because he was a peace candidate.

The communist envoys admitted to newsmen they had no proof for their assertions.

The Hanoi diplomats engaged in preliminary talks with the United States have refused public comment on the assassination, contending it was an "internal American matter." But in private they admitted shock.

"The United States has been exporting violence for years," a high-ranking North Vietnamese

delegate said. "Now it is reaping violence at home which has boomeranged."

North Vietnamese sources indicated their delegation would make no concessions in forthcoming meetings with W. Averell Harriman, President Johnson's special ambassador. They said their instructions were the same as at the first meeting May 13 — Demand an immediate and unconditional halt of U. S. bombing.

The North Vietnamese sources said they would refuse any concessions to start substantive bargaining even if President Johnson ordered a temporary halt to the bombing. The next negotiations session was scheduled tomorrow.

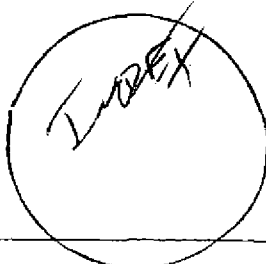

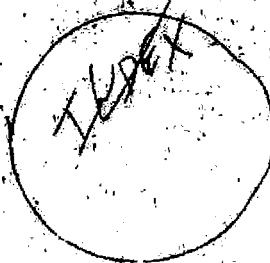

During the evening of 6/13/68 an individual who identified himself as MICHAEL H. SULLIVAN, 3636 16th St., N.W., Apt. B-412, telephone 332-5817, telephoned WFO and advised as follows:

He believes he may have seen SIRHAN SIRHAN, the accused assassin of Senator KENNEDY, three or three and one-half years ago at the Sheraton Park Hotel, WDC. SULLIVAN said he recalls an incident wherein a waiter with an explosive personality then working at the hotel ~~XXXX~~ became involved in an altercation with another waiter. At the time SULLIVAN was working as a security officer at the hotel.

SULLIVAN stated it is his opinion the waiter with the explosive personality may have been SIRHAN. He did not know the waiter's name, but recalls he was a "rag head," which he explained is an individual from one of the near eastern countries.

III

It was noted during his call that SULLIVAN's conversation was rambling and occasionally incoherent. When he was asked to repeat facts he had already furnished, he gave different details. It was obvious that he had no specific information to indicate the individual he allegedly saw was SIRHAN SIRHAN.

WFO file 105-81551, captioned MICHAEL HARRY SULLIVAN, IS - R, appears ident with above-captioned complainant. A copy of a LHM setting out background info re SULLIVAN is attached to this memo. WFO file 62-0-21894 concerns a MICHAEL A. SULLIVAN, 3636 16th St., N.W., WDC, who called WFO to complain that someone broke into the apartment of his sister in Monterey, Calif. SULLIVAN claimed the burglar was a narcotics agent, and he wanted FBI assistance in obtaining evidence against him.

In view of the nonspecific nature of the information furnished by SULLIVAN it is recommended no further action be taken at this time.

In late January, 1968, a confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, learned that Michael Sullivan had been in contact with Viktor S. Evlanov of the Soviet Embassy, Washington, D. C. (WFO). Source described Sullivan as a cook in the Merchant Marine, age 50, residing 3633 - 16th Street, N. W., WDC.

According to source, Sullivan contacted Evlanov to make his views known concerning the seizure of the "USS Pueblo" off the coast of Korea. Sullivan indicated that he felt the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics (USSR) was not completely to blame for this incident and expounded on the need for peace in the world. Evlanov assured Sullivan that the USSR had nothing to do with the "USS Pueblo" affair.

The current "Diplomatic List," published by the United States Department of State, identifies Viktor S. Evlanov as a Second Secretary, Embassy of the USSR, WFO.

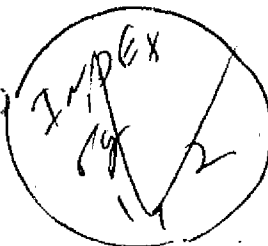
On January 25, 1968, Miss Arlene Butler, Rental Office, Woodner Hotel, 3633 - 16th Street, N. W., WFO, made available the following information from a rental application completed in April 1966:

She said Michael H. Sullivan occupied Apartment B209 with his wife Florence on June 1, 1966, and they continue to reside in the apartment. His age in April, 1966 was listed as 49. Prior to occupying Apartment B209, Sullivan indicated he resided for four years at 2881 Cathedral Avenue, N. W., WDC. He listed his nearest relative as James H. Sullivan, residence Lafayette Hotel, 16th and I Streets, N. W., WDC.

Miss Butler stated that Sullivan was employed at the Woodner Hotel as a steward prior to residing at the hotel.

On January 25, 1963, Miss Sarsfield, Bagmaster and Bookkeeper, Woodner Hotel, advised from her records that ~~Michael A. Sullivan~~ was employed by the Woodner Hotel as a steward from April 14, 1936 to June 20, 1936. She said his job included ordering food supplies and liquor and disbursing these items to the various departments. He also managed the coffee shop for a short period. She said he was laid off due to the dining room closing during the summer months.

Miss Sarsfield said her record reveals that Sullivan was previously employed at the National Naval Medical Center, Bethesda, Maryland, as a barman for an 18-month period. She was unable to state where Sullivan is currently employed.

On January 26, 1963, files of The Credit Bureau, Incorporated, WDC, were reviewed and found to contain the following information concerning Michael Sullivan:

Michael A. Sullivan, wife's name Florence C., is reported to have resided at 2231 Cathedral Avenue, N. W., in July, 1931. He is divorced from Helen Sullivan and his age in 1931 was listed as approximately 42. Employment is listed as bartender, Touchdown Club, 1414 I Street, N. W. Previous employments are listed with Goldie Aherns Charcoal Pit as a cook and baker, and prior to this with the Arva Hotel.

Credit file indicates five suits were filed against Sullivan between 1933-1936, totaling \$14,000.00, ranging from \$12.00 to \$350.00. In July, 1934, one account, in the amount of \$73.00, was written off to profit and loss.

On January 26, 1963, the following information was obtained from the files of the Records and Welfare Branch, Merchant Vessel Personnel Division, Headquarters, United States Coast Guard, WDC:

Michael Harry Sullivan, born March 21, 1917, at
Richmond, California, was issued United States Merchant Marine
Document Number 2233009 on December 22, 1944, as a second cook
and baker. His address at that time was listed as 1316 1/2
Malvern Avenue, Los Angeles, California, and his wife's name
as Mary Sullivan. He indicated his Social Security Number as
