Dear Sir:
The information furnished herewith concerns an individual who is believed to be covered by the agreement between the FBI and Secret Service concerning Presidential protection, and to fall within the category or categories checked.
1. Has attempted or threatened bodily harm to any government official or employee, including foreign government officials residing in or planning an imminent visit to the U.S., because of his official status.
2. Has attempted or threatened to redress a grievance against any public official by other than legal means.
3. Because of background is potentially dangerous; or has been identified as member or participant in communist movement; or has been under active investigation as member of other group or organization inimical to U.S.
4. U.S. citizens or residents who defect from the U.S. to countries in the Soviet or Chinese Communist blocs and return.
5. Subversives, ultrarightists, racists and fascists who meet one or more of the following criteria:
 (a) Evidence of emotional instability (including unstable residence and employment record) or irrational or suicidal behavior: (b) Expressions of strong or violent anti-U. S. sentiment; (c) Prior acts (including arrests or convictions) or conduct or statements indicating a propensity for violence and antipathy toward good order and government.
6. X Individuals involved in illegal bombing or illegal bomb-making.

UNKNOWN SUBJECT; Bomb Hoax, Office of Senator ROBERT F, KENNEDY, Syracuse, New York, March 1, 1966

At 5:10 p.m. on March 1, 1966, the Onondaga County Sheriff's Office, Syracuse, New York, received an anonymous telephone call stating there was a bomb in Senator Kennedy's Syracuse, New York, office located in the Federal Building. This information was relayed by the Sheriff's Office to the Syracuse Police Department and Syracuse FBI office at 5:15 p.m. Senator Kennedy's office and adjacent offices were searched by the building guard and nothing significant was found.

Mr. Gerald Bruno, Administrative Assistant to the Senator, when notified at 5:20 p.m., said probably this call was connected with some other anonymous calls made to his home during the past few days, concerning which he had contacted the Sheriff's Office. Subsequently, the problem was reported on a local television newscast; consequently, Mr. Bruno suspects this bomb call probably was made by the same person or inspired by the publicity. He said Senator Kennedy was then in Washington, D.C.

Mr. George Peet, Special Agent, U. S. Secret Service, Syracuse, New York, was notified at 5:25 p.m. Mr. B. J. Cozzati, 108th Intelligence Corps Group, Syracuse, was notified at 5:55 p.m.
